GARY WILLIAM REYNOLDS **December 23, 1943 - May 30, 2017**



It is with utmost sadness that I am reporting the passing of our Cousin and Friend, LCDR(R) Gary William Reynolds of Seattle, Washington. Gary was born December 23, 1943, and went to his maker at 1:20 a.m. on May 30, 2017. He fought a long and hard battle with cancer, but finally it took its toll. Gary was the past Vice-President of The RFA, in charge of Line Coordination and he also ran the Reynolds yDNA Project for a number of years, taking over from the originator. Gary was directly responsible for me taking on the role of President of this wonderful organization and for that I will forever be in his debt. I will miss our talks and chats and know that at last his pain and suffering is no more.

Mercer "Mercede" Reynolds III **born 17 June 1945, Chattanooga, TN**

Mercer Reynolds was confirmed by the United States Senate on August 1, 2001 as U.S. Ambassador to Switzerland and Liechtenstein. He was sworn in by

Secretary of State Colin Powell on August 14. Ambassador Reynolds presented his credentials to the Swiss Government on September 11, 2001. Ambassador Reynolds was born in Chattanooga, Tennessee on June 17, 1945. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, and a Masters of Business Administration degree from the University of Tennessee.

After serving in the U.S. Army from 1968 to 1969, Ambassador Reynolds took a position with the Coca-Cola Bottling Company in Chattanooga. In 1979, together with his friend and business partner, William DeWitt, he founded Reynolds, DeWitt & Co., an investment firm based in Cincinnati, Ohio. Ambassador Reynolds was co-chairman of the company from 1979 until August 2001, at which time the requirements of U.S. government service led him to step down from that position.

From 1980 to 1985, Ambassador Reynolds was co-chairman of Spectrum 7 Energy Corporation, which was active in the oil and gas exploration business. He also served from 1985 to 2001 as Chairman and CEO of Reynolds Plantation, an 8000-acre lake and golf community on Lake Oconee, east of Atlanta, Georgia.

During the 2000 Presidential election campaign, Ambassador Reynolds was co-finance chair in Ohio for the Bush/Cheney campaign and was a member of the Bush/Cheney national executive finance committee. After the election, he was asked by President-elect George W. Bush to be co-chairman of the Presidential Inauguration Committee.

Ambassador Reynolds' interest in foreign affairs led him to serve on the advisory board of the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) in Washington, D.C. He has also been actively involved in the board of the Bridging the Rift Foundation,

located on the Jordan/Israel border. The foundation seeks to build bridges between people through programs involving economic development, cutting-edge research, and advanced educational opportunities.

A strong believer in volunteer community service work, Ambassador Reynolds has participated in Summerbridge, a civic organization devoted to tutoring inner-city youth in Cincinnati. He has also been campaign chairman for the National Coalition for the Protection of Children and Families, a group focused on fighting pornography and child abuse. He has been a fundraiser for the United Way charity and the Fine Arts Funds. In addition, he has served on the University of North Carolina Educational Foundation and the University of Cincinnati executive committee.

Ambassador Reynolds is married to Gabrielle Reynolds. The Reynolds have five children.

MAJOR GENERAL JOHN FULTON REYNOLDS

Major General (M.G. - 2 stars) John F. Reynolds entered the U.S. Military Academy at West Point NY from Lancaster PA in 1836 and graduated with the class of 1841. His classmates and friends during the four years at West Point included Generals Grant, Doubleday, Buckner, Buell, Bragg, Longstreet, Rosecrans, Pope, Thomas, Hooker, D.H. Hill, Jubal Early, Hancock, Thomas, P.G.T. Beauregard and W.T. Sherman. His graduation number was 1084, which means he was the 1,084th cadet to graduate from the academy.

There is a hero's place at West Point overlooking the Hudson River known as Battle Monument which was dedicated on 31 May 1897. General Reynolds' name is inscribed on this monument erected to the men and officers killed in the Civil War. The stone shaft atop the monument is the largest piece of turned granite in the world. It also contains the names of 2,230 brave fallen soldiers.

M.G. Reynolds served as an artillery officer in the Mexican War and was the Commandant of Cadets at West Point when the Civil War broke out in 1861. This was, and is a very prestigious position in the Army. He was appointed brigadier general of U.S. volunteers in 1861. He served with distinction in the Peninsular Campaign.

In his first principal engagement in the Civil War, he defeated Robert E. Lee at Cheat Mountain in western Virginia near Elkwater. Reynolds' losses were 21 while Lee lost almost 100. This action secured that portion of Virginia for the North in the early part of the war.

General Reynolds was shot dead by a Confederate rifleman as he rode forward disposing his troops on the first day of the battle at Gettysburg. His death occurred at 10:15 a.m., 1 July 1863, along a woodline adjacent to McPherson's Ridge a few miles south of the town. There is a large equestrian statue of him where he fell.

General Reynolds was at the time of his death the Commanding General of the Union's I Corps or 1st Corps, and was ironically replaced by a classmate, M.G. Abner Doubleday, later to become famous as the founder of baseball.

His body was brought back to be buried with his kindred in Lancaster PA by two of his aides, Capt. Ridle and Major Rosegarten. At his burial, Napier's eulogy was quoted, "no man died on that field with more glory than he, yet many died, and there was much glory."

General Reynolds was born in Lancaster 20 Sep 1820. He had a brother named James L. Reynolds, a prominent democrat who served on Governor Curtin's draft commission during the Civil War.

From many memoirs of that era it is clear that General Reynolds was highly respected. Perhaps representing the best of that said of him is the statement by General Robert E. Lee in his memoirs: "Among the officers killed at Gettysburg was Major General John F. Reynolds, whose gentlemanly bearing and soldierly qualities were unsurpassed in any other officer of either army."

My WHITLOCK FTDNA test shows a strong connection to the Archelaus Woody REYNOLDS line. In looking at the census records, I have some questions. I have seen no records of any legal marriages for him, but it is believed that he married Sarah "Sallie" Miller and they had three children after 1800. In the 1800 Peneleton, SC census, he is shown with 2 males under 10, two females under 10 and a female 26-44. Who are these people? In 1810 Buncombe NC census, he is shown with 1 male under 10, 1 male 10-15, 8 females under 10, 1 female 10-15, 1 female 16-25 and 1 female (probably wife Sarah) 26-44 It suggests there there was a death in the family leaving several children. There is no record of his marriage to Mary ADAMS but they have several children who have the surname ADAMS, so I assume that they never married. I am wondering if the four children in 1800 could also be out-of-wedlock. It is possible that my g-g-g-grandfather Lancelot "Lot" Whitlock b. abt 1792 - d. 1864 could be one of the males under 10 in 1800. If

anyone has any information about this, I would really appreciate their sharing it.
