

DANIEL RENOLL, HUGUENOT AND SOME OF HIS DESCENDANTS

INTRODUCTION: This study of the Renoll family in York County, PA and Washington County MD, starting with David Renoll...many years of research...no clues of where Daniel entered the Colonies, or who his parents were have been uncovered. A search for his German and French Bibles has been fruitless to date....His will brings the man into focus...a real person with many admirable qualities especially in his endeavor to divide his property equally and assure that his wife Elizabeth is well taken care of.

Daniel's estate included lands and plantations in York County PA and Washington County MD. His private graveyard is in Codorus Township, York County PA, very close to Spring Grove. The gravestones are becoming so weathered that it is increasingly difficult to read them. The York County Historical Society, many years ago, made a listing of gravestones (with their inscriptions), in the County....

CHAPTER I, EARLY HISTORY OF THE RENOLL LINE: The early history of the Renoll line is of interest though, at this time, I have not been able to trace beyond Daniel. The first records of Renollet families are found in and around the province of Brittany in France in 1200 A.D. Today the name, under different spellings, is found in France, Holland, Switzerland, Germany, England, United States and South America...countries to which emigration had begun in 1685. As not fixed spelling existed until modern times, variations of the name include: Reneoi, Renolle, Renouile, Rennouille, Renoille, Rennol, Renol, Riniolet, Renolly, Renoilly, Renollet.

Ecclesiastical records are the first records we find in Brittany. The Cartularium Abbatathial de Angers records a gift of land to the church by Seanaye Renollete in 1206 A.D. Similarly in 1215 Jean Renollet gave land to the church at St. Brieuc; in 1253 Abelard Renollet of Vendee gave lands to the church at Evieux because such presents of land to the church were a pious custom of the Middle Ages. In a Records of Chateaux of Brittany in 1410 A.D. the following gave returns of land: Geffroi Renollet of Nantes; Thomas Renollet of Laval; Henri Renollet of Rennes; Jean Renollet of Ronan; Josephe Renollet of Montrichard; and Leon Renollet of Paul.

Coming from this area of Brittany the first Renollets were not of pure French blood, if such a thing exists; they came from a stock which was a mixture of British ancestors who had migrated from Devon and Cornwall in England in Roman times, and of Norman ancestors...who were of Norse ancestry...and who had conquered these Bretons (Britons) in 911 A.D. Up to 1200 A.D. the Renollet

families only had personal names (what we now call Christian) as a surname, then Renollet is 768 years old.

The Renollets helped to build the walled towns of Brittany, and behind them they worked as skilled members of many trade Guilds that then existed. In 1500 A.D. Charles Renollet was mayor of Pontivy. In 1510 A.D. Michel Renollet, an alderman of the town of Elven, resisted the taxes imposed by the French king and when forces of militia were sent to subdue the town Michel led a force of townsmen who put them to flight. Shortly after this period large numbers in the Brittany area began to resist the Church, following the preachings of Luther and Calvin, and opened their first Protestant church in France in 1538. In the Renollet area these Protestants were called Huguenots. In 1568 an ecclesiastical list states that at Nates Francois Rennollet, Hector Renollet, and Jacques Renollet were burned at the stake for refusing to denounce Protestantism. In 1564 it is recorded, in an Epinal history, that a Huguenot of high standing, Guillaume Renollet, was granted lands and given a position under the King on renouncing Protestantism. On his death bed, however, he told the priest who attended him that he had always remained a Huguenot in spirit; whereupon his body was ordered to be thrown down the town sewers. In 1598 A.D. toleration was granted to the Huguenots in the Edict of Nantes, and as a result they became prosperous but in 1685 Louis XIV revoked the Edict of Nantes and all Huguenots who would not renounce their faith were ordered to leave France in 15 days. Over 100,000 Huguenots left France and settled in other countries. (Archive No. B219, International Ancestry Guild, Dundrum, Ireland.)

CHAPTER II, DANIEL RENOLL LINE: We do not know when Daniel Renoll came to the Colony of PA although Ammon Stapelton in "A Memorial to the Huguenots", p. 155, places him in York PA in 1749. His daughter, Maria Elizabeth, was baptized by Jacob Lischy on 19 May 1752 at St. Peter's Lutheran and Reformed Church in Codorus Township, York County PA (a copy of the records of Jacob Lischy's Journal, 1743-1769, York County Historical Society).

Ammon Stapelton notes that a considerable number of Huguenots came to the headwaters of the Conestoga Creek, in the western limits of Adams County...among them Daniel Renolle, prior to 1751. He adds that Daniel Renolle does not appear on the lists as a foreign immigrant and that it is a fair assumption to conclude that he came hither from an older colony (Ammon Stapelton, A Memorial to the Huguenots, p. 130).

"When settlements extended beyond the Susquehanna into the present county of York, a number of Huguenots found their way into that region. Included among these were: Franz Ludwig, Berrot, Jean Votrin, Jacob Noel, and Jean Moreau. Beginning about 1700, Huguenots entered the present Adams County...prominent among them were James Pettit, Abraham Larve and Daniel Renolle ("The French Racial Strain in PA," (The Huguenot Society of PA Publication Vol. IX, p. 71, 1929).

The earliest land record we have to date of Daniel Renoll's ownership of land in Codorus Township is the following document dated 16 Oct 1751:

Whereas Daniel Renolle of the County of York hath requested that we would grant him to take up One hundred Acres of Land more or less between Jacob Heany and Jacob Christman including an Improvement made by John Winger in Codorus Township in the said County of York for which he agrees to pay to our Use at the rate of Fifteen Pounds Ten Shillings, current Money of this Province, for One Hundred Acres with Lawful Interest for the same and yearly Quit-rent of One Half-penny Sterling for every Acre thereof both to commence from the time of Improvement. These are therefore to authorize and require you to survey, or cause to be surveyed, unto the said Daniel Renolle at the Place aforesaid, according to the Method of Townships appointed, the said Quantity of One hundred Acres, if not already surveyed or appropriated, and make Return thereof in to the Secretary's office, in order for further Confirmation, for which this shall be your sufficient Warrant: Which Survey, in Case the said Daniel Renolle fulfil the above Agreement, within Six Months from the date hereof, shall be valid, otherwise void. Given under my Hand, and Seal of the Land-Office, by Virtue of certain Powers from the said Proprietaries, at Philadelphia, this 16th Day of October Anno Domini, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty-one

The Rev. Lischy, who was the pastor of the church, kept a private Journal of baptisms and marriages

during his pastorate there (1743-1769). I have visited the site of this colonial Reformed Church and there is now a small colonial type church that was built at a later date. It is called Lischy's Reformed Church or St. Peter's Lutheran and Reformed Church and is in North Codorus Township with many graves of old settlers in the graveyard beside the church. Jacob Lischy's Private Journal is now in the Reformed Church Library of Franklin and Marshall College, Lancaster PA. Jacob Lischy wrote all German names in German script, but others in Roman script; all the Renoll records are in Roman script. The two syllable pronunciation indicated by Lischy also points to a French origin. The following are the recorded baptisms of the children of Daniel Renolly and his wife Maria Elisabeth:

CHAPTER III - RENOLL RECORDS IN MARYLAND

The Renoll Plantations in Maryland were in the South Mountain, Cavetown vicinity of Washington County MD.

There were no land records before 1776 and our earliest record of land owned by Daniel Renoll is 1779.

From the church and land records of Washington County MD the following information has been gathered:

Daniel Renoll's eldest son [Johann Daniel] and his wife Annamarie lived in MD and the Records of Zion Reformed Church (1770) at Hagerstown MD record the following births:

1 Anna Maria and Margretha (twins) born 11 Jul 1788; baptized 2 21 Aug 1788; Sponsors for Anna Maria were Peter Renol and housewife; for Margretha sponsors were Ludwig Huiett and housewife Margretha.

Charles Galwic was guardian of all five children under 21 years except Daniel and John. (NOTE: In this deed is the interesting note that Daniel was the only heir of Daniel, Sr. who was still living in Washington County, MD. The deed doesn't elaborate and tell where the minor

children were though Charles Galwic, their guardian, was still a resident of Washignton Co., MD.)

Washington Co., MD., has no land records prior to 1776 and no marriage records other than those in churches and in Family Bibles prior to 1800 (The above records were reserached by Mrs. Frank S. Schwartz, Chairman of Church Records. She is a researcher for the Washington Co. Historical Society of Hagerstown MD. The many different spellings of the name Renol include Reynolds. Mrs. Schwartz noted that there was a Reynolds family near Sharpsburg MD. It was the family of Capt. John Reynolds who was killed by Indians while moving to KY in 1779. ...[Capt. John Reynolds] family has a proven English ancestry and before coming to MD they lived in Dublin, Ireland. It has, to date, not been proved whether there was any connection with Daniel Renoll.)

Chapter IV - DANIEL RENOLL'S WILL

In the name of God Amen I Daniel Renoll of Codorus Township in the County of York and State of PA being old and weak in body but of Good Health and of a Sound and Disposing Mind and Memory belssed by Almighty God for the same Do make and submit this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following First I Will and Order that in the first place all my just Debts and funeral expenses shall be paid and Satisfied. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife MARY ELIZABETH my two beds and bedsteads her chest and spinning wheel my table two chairs one Iron Pot and two Iron pans two Pails and the Washing Tub and the coffee kettle and Tea tankard andour coffee dishes and teh Iron stove in my room with the pipe thereunto and to have the full use and privilege of that Room wherein we now live and to have one cow her chaise her side saddle and bridle and my Dutch Bible and the Zollekoffern book and all our line things and cloth and also sixty pounds in good and lawful moneys to be paid to her soon after my decease and one hoe and one shover her choice and her...which shall be in full of her share...and all the remainder of my Personal Estate shall be sold at Public Sale and after Cost paid it shall then be equally divided among and between all my children share and share alike and Concerning my Lands and Plantation that is to say the Lands whereon I and my son Henry doth live and the Lands whereon my Son Christian doth live Situate in Codorus Township York County along and adjoining Lands of Henry Strickhouser and Christian Merkel and Conrad Meyer and Michael Miller and others containing in the whole about six hundred acres more or less my Will is that this same shall be equully divided between my son Henry and my son Christian as equal as it can well be done and the place and part whereon I live I give and devise to Henry Renoll to hold to him his Heirs and assigns forever his share being allowed him in the Same and believe thatr he shall pay and give out for use of my Daughters as hereafter shall be saith the Sum of Four hundred and eighteen pounds of good and lawful moneys to be paid in the manner following Two hundred pounds immediately after my decease and the Remainder in Six yearly payments Fiver there of each for the sum of thirty-six pounds and the last for the sum of thirty-eight pounds the firs due and paid inone year of my

decease...and then yearly until paid; and the other part of that my said land and Plantation I give and devise unto my son Christian Renoll ssold to his, his heirs and assigns forever his share being to him allowed in the same and besides that he shall also pay and give out for the use of my Daughters as here after shall be best saith the Same sum of Four hundred and Eighteen pounds of like lawful money aforesaid to be paid even in the monies as my son Henry is to pay his as aforesaid Item I give and devise unto my eldest son Daniel Renoll all that Plantation and tract of land whereon he now dwelleth situate in Washington County in the State of MD adjoining lands of Jacob Mony and others containing Two hundred acres by the same to hold to him his Heirs and assigns forever his share being allowed in the same and belief that she shall pay and give out for the use of my Daughters as here after shall be paid the sum of Two hundred and eighteen pounds Sixty-eight pounds in hand by the time of my decease and the remainder in Six equal twenty-five pound payments the first one due one year after my decease. Item I give and devise unto my son Peter Renoll all the Plantation and Tract of Land whereon he now dwelleth situate in Washington County and in state of MD adjoining lands of Ladawick Huiert and others containing one hundred and fifty-four acres To hold to him and his heirs and assigns forever, His share being to him allowed the same and besides that he shall pay and give out for the use of my Daughters Fifty-seven Pounds money of or paid in one year after my Decease the sum of Thirty Pounds and in one year further the sum of twenty-seven Pounds and to my son Jacob Renoll I have also given and paid the sum of Five hundred pounds out of which he will in one years time after my decease pay and give out for the use of my Daughters the sum of Eighteen Pounds the other being allowed to him to make him equal with one of the other of my Sons what I have allowed them in their Lands and after my said Sons have made the above payments for their lands they shall be entitled to the same in an as full and ample manner as I in my Lifetime have been Entitled to the same, and the Money so to be paid and given out as aforesaid shall be equally Divided among and between my Four Daughters Namely Mary Elizabeth intermarried with Felix Clatfelder Barbara intermarried with Peter Lau Susanna intermarried with Adam Ernst and Magdalen intermarried with Corad Meyer and that yearly so that it comes in it shall always be equally divided between them, but then in my movable Estate each of all of my children shall have his equal share as aforesaid, and Concerning the Maintenance of my said Wife or Widow my will is that she shall have Liberty in the kitchen and on the fire and in the Cellar and Spring House along with my son Henry in an equal manner and further she shall have yearly during her Widowhood Twelve bushels of good Merchantable Wheat Four bushels of Rye Four gallons of Rye Liqueur, Two hundred Pounds of Good Pork with the fat thereon. Twelve Pounds of clean Hatched flax, Two pair of new shoes in a year and two pair of soling and yearly a barrel of Good Cider and Apples and Peaches as much as she doth want for her use, one cow kept in the Stables Fodder and Pasture as good as their own and a Horse for Riding whenever she doth want it fine wood ready for use in her Stove and brought to her door as much as she has need of, her grain to be brought to the mill and the meal home again whenever she doth want it and further yearly a bushel of fine salt and the third part of the Planting Garden yearly dug as...and four

Pounds of good clean wool in each year and each month two dozen of eggs only the three hardest months being excepted and a yearly gallon of fish oil of all which several articles my son Henry and my son Christian their Heirs or assigns each of them shall find, Provide, Deliver and give the one feels equal moiety [sicv] or half part of all the aforesaid articles and things of maintenance to my said wife yearly and every year during her Widowhood and in Time of her infirmity or sickness my said two sons shall be liable to Tend her in a Soft and Christian manner and to milk her cow and Lastly I do have to appoint and nominate my Trusty sons Christian Renoll and Henry Renoll Executors of my last Will and Testament, Herby revoking all former Wills by me made Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand.

....CHAPTER VIII - AIDS IN PROVING RENOLL LINES

Several years ago my husband and I visited York County and searched for the private graveyard of Daniel Renoll. We drove through a cornfield and found a graveyard with a handsome stone marker with the history of another family of early settlers, the Hamme's. We kept stopping along the county roads asking for information and at one old farmhouse we talked with a genial older man named Daniel Renoll. He was not aware that the first settler of that name was a Huguenot and he did not know where the private burying ground was. He directed us to Lischy's Church, just down the road and there we saw many graves of later Renoll's.

We did find the private graveyard with the help of two young boys and I hope that someday it will have a marker and be fenced in. It is well cared for now but the stones are becoming almost illegible. It is on the Spring Grove-Jefferson Road, situated on the left in a field just before a big red barn at Pine Tree Farm; next sign Beefeater Farm on Route #516 where it branches off from #116 about one-half mile. Fourteen slabs are standing but only five are legible:

The York County Historical Society has made a valuable study of all the graveyards in York County and from their work we have a record of most of the settlers who were buried long ago. The descendants of Daniel Renoll were prolific and merged with their fellow Pennsylvanians and Marylanders. They were predominately rural settlers, devoted to church and family.

There has not been a study of the Huguenot settlers in the county of York. In the publication commemorating the 225th year of the founding of York, PA published in 1966 no mention is made of the Huguenot settlers. The English Quaker, the German and Scotch-Irish are discussed in detail. Renoll was not an isolated Huguenot. LaRue, Petti, Larve, Berrot, Noel, Lau, Le Fever, and De Granche are other French names that come to mind. It has been said that the Huguenot emigrants blended with other nationalities and adopted the customs and language of the dominant groups. It was only in predominately French Huguenot settlements like New Rochelle NY that they nurtured their French culture and form of worship.

To facilitate tracing of ancestry to Daniel Renoll the Court records assembled by Miss Nell Reeser are given below:

RENOLL - LIST I: Members of the Renoll clan whose marriages October 1, 1885 - July 31, 1959, are shown in the Court records of York County, PA:

[NO DATES OF MARRIAGE WERE GIVEN In the book,

LIST I list contained only the first name in alphabetical order, vol., page. no; with these footnotes: "(1) *An asterisk indicates that the name starred is a surname; any other name that looks like a surname (e.g. Shue, as in Billy Conrad Shue) is really part of the given name of someone surnamed Renoll. (2) ?A question mark before a name indicates that the person named may have been a member of a British clan Reynolds; therefore, not of the Renoll clan. From the evidence, I couldn't decide his ancestry."

NOTE: With the exception of one name, Israel H. Reynolds, the list did not contain another surname, presumably the names were spelled RENOLL or Ms. Reeser thought they were indeed of the RENOLL family; Lists II and III show different spellings for names that appear to be identical.

LIST II contained name of parent and applicant, in alphabetical order by parent's first name, giving full name of applicants;

LIST III contained names of persons [in alphabetical order] whose marriage was to members of the Renoll clan.

LIST IV contains Land Deeds in York County with the following statements: "Land deeds in York County yield the following RENOLLS who were either grantors or Grantees [sic]. The grantor indexes contain many by the name of Reynold but in only one instance is this name included when there is assurance that the individuals involved are listed several times as RENNOLL [sic]. There were settlers in York County by the name of REYNOLDS, of English extraction and with the multiple spellings of surnames. Every effort has been made to limit this listing to RENOLLS."

I attempted to combine all three lists to have a list showing the Renoll person, the parent and the spouse. All entries with vol, page, and no. and no surname are as in List I. All entries without vol. page, no. were taken from the 2d chart when there was a deviation in spelling, + indicates a spelling other than "Renoll" in the parent or spouse list; a given name varied in any manner from List I, it was entered as a separate entry.]
