Cemetery Records, Centerville, Maine #2

Marion Harding of 28 Kernwood Hgts., Beverly, MA 01915 found the following in her search of the Columbia-Addison-Jonesport area (originally called Pleasant River area). Reynolds was in Spring Township, Centre Co., PA both in the 1840 and 1850 Censuses. He married Sarah Whitney and had Ann, Mary, Benjamin, Margery, Martha, Edward, and John Walter. Also need date and place of death.

* Editors notes: If you have tried will and estate records in Centre Co., PA, I would try DEED Records next. The deed records could tell where Israel came from, who sold or gave him land, when and where he moved, and/or about the time he died.

John Howard Smith, P.O.Box 532, Newton, NC 28658 is searching for information on Fergus Harvey Reynolds. F. Harvey Reynolds married Mary Grice in 1842. The 1850 Catawba Co., NC census shows Harvey Runnells 35, Mary 38 and have the following children: Ann, Alexander, William, Elizabeth and John. Any information you might have on the Reynolds families in North Carolina would be greatly appreciated.

Emalene Reynolds Rohrer, 112 Willow Dr., Nicholasville, KY 40356 needs info on Thomas Reynolds who married Catherine Willis at Lancaster, Garrard Co., KY in 1800. He served in the Revolutionary War as a private in the 7th VA Regt. of foot soldiers under Thomas Posey and Alexander McClanachen in the Fall and Winter of 1777 and 1778. Information on his birth states he was born 1762 and was from Culpepper Co., VA. WHO WERE HIS PARENTS AND SIBLINGS? I have data on the Reynolds, Fains, Stinnetts, etc. that came to KY as soon as the Rev. War was over and will be glad to help those researching in Garrard Co., KY.

She married Henry Strang of Rye, Westchester, NY by 1817 and she died 1860 in Rye, NY and is buried there.
