ABOUT THE REYNOLDS FAMILY ASSOCIATION (RFA)

Because RFA has so many new members, it seems a good time to review RFA's history and purpose.

The Reynolds family in America dates from the year 1622. Coming mainly from the British Isles, several branches of Reynolds families settled along the Eastern Coast in early colonial times. RFA was organized 23 Aug 1892 by some of the descendants of one of the early Connecticut families. Within a few years, membership had grown substantially and eligibility was broadened to include the several lines of the Reynolds families that settled in colonial New England. Today membership is open to all individuals who are interested in any Reynolds family who settled in America at any time. The name Reynolds was (and is) spelled in a variety of ways throughout history, including Raynolds, Rennels, Runnels, and about 34 others.

PURPOSE - The purpose of RFA was and is to share genealogical information, promote recognition of a common ancestry, develop acquaintance among Reynolds kindred, and collect and maintain a permanent record of Reynolds family history.

The RFA Archives, the RFA Newsletter, Reynolds Recollections, and reunions fulfill the purpose of RFA. The RFA functions and endures on volunteer time and commitment of individual members to the Reynolds family and its history.

RFA ARCHIVES - A goal of the original organizers was to publish a complete volume covering all known branches of their Reynolds families. In the 1920s Marion H. Reynolds published two books on Robert of Boston, one on John of Watertown, and one on John of Norwich CT. It was also in the 1920s that the decision was made to begin using the annuals as a vehicle for continuing publication of the family records. Since the 1920s the records always have been in the custody of the Executive Secretary, who historically has held this position for a significant length of time, thereby providing care and continuity for the later records. A year ago all records which had been in the care of Mrs. Dorothy Jellinghaus, were turned over to Susan Clement, the present RFA Executive Secretary. Much of the information is in a form similar to a query, little of the data is supported by evidence, and through the years members have not provided information on their descendants. Sue and Lee Taylor each have been spending a minimum of 24 hours a week entering these records into the RFA computer.

RFA Annuals have been published over the years, though not annually. In most instances, RFA has only one copy of each, except for the 1982 edition. There will not be another Annual until the centennial edition, which will be a compilation of genealogical data in previous annuals plus new information.

Copies of the 1982 Annual are available from the Editor for \$6, including postage.

Reynolds Recollections (RR), begun in 1983, is the primary vehicle for dissemination of Reynolds family information. It is through RR that we get to know each other, past, present, and future, on a regular basis. Also, RR is sent to a number of libraries throughout the USA.

REUNIONS/ANNUAL MEETINGS - Annual Reynolds family reunions, a day of getting to know Reynolds "cousins", sharing family information, and participating in RFA business give life to RFA. Reunions were held annually from 1892 until 1941, when WW II interrupted its activities. Reunions were held again in 1947, 1948, and 1950. Then, meetings ceased until 1977 when members reunited to reorganize RFA. Reunions have been held from 1979 through 1990, except for 1982. In its 98-year history, there have been a total of 65 reunions/annual meetings, with the 66th planned for 12 Oct 1991 in Atlanta, Georgia. In 1992, RFA will return to Old Lyme, Connecticut for its centennial anniversary.

It is good to know that the same dedication will keep you active members of RFA.

FROM THE EDITOR

As mentioned in other sections of this issue, Sue Clement and I are automating the RFA records. It is a large and slow job - typing and proofing, etc. Nevertheless, going through all these records has been enlightening and educational. It is a bit overwhelming to think that RFA has been going for almost 100 years; to know that some families have well documented family histories for four centuries. It gives hope to me that somewhere, someday I will find all of my Reynolds ancestors. When I see what RFA has done, I feel such confidence that there is no limit to what RFA can do. Please know that "RFA" translates into "member", each of whom over the years has contributed significantly of their time and energies to provide a record of the Reynolds families in America. Each piece of paper in the files presents another piece of the puzzle, or at least a clue.

While we are extremely interested in documenting your ancestors, we are also interested in your immediate family. It seems especially important that our youngsters be involved in RFA. To this end, I want to highlight a few of them in each issue. Think about it: In the year 2050, your

descendant finds his/her name in an old, old issue of RR and knows the trail is warm! It is especially sad that RFA files do not contain records of descendants of many of the members over the years. Please keep us updated on your family.

Protection of Your Records. Many people do not wish to share information they have so arduously obtained because the hope is always alive that someday a book can be written about the family. RFA does not wish to do anything to lessen the possibility and RFA has no intention of becoming a publishing house. Over the years many books and manuscripts have been donated to RFA to use as it sees fit and for this we are grateful. However, please don't fear providing RFA with information. If you do not want any part of the information released, write the word "copyright" on the pages and tell us the extent to which we may use the information. As a minimum, we want to notify others seeking the same family to contact you. But please provide your family information to RFA for posterity. And please let us know when your Reynolds book is ready for publishing -- we will buy a copy and do a book review in RR.

Sue and I each have IBM AT-compatible computers, MS-DOS 3.3, WordPerfect 5.0/5.1, PC-File, and Personal Ancestry File (Church of Latter Day Saints). Sue's equipment is owned by RFA.

You will note that RR is no longer sent by first class mail. Two reasons: Increased cost of postage and printing, and we now have enough members to qualify for Bulk Mixed States rates. I was assured the issues will reach you within ten days of mailing. The six issues will be mailed by the end of the first month in the pair, e.g., March for the Mar-Apr issue. Please let me know if they are unduly delayed.

HELP WANTED! HELP NEEDED!

RFA will publish for its Centennial in 1992, a collection of genealogical and historical material found in the RFA Annuals from 1899-1937. The Executive Secretary, Sue Clement, will be the Editor. Since the cost of reprinting the annuals individually is prohibitive, the intention is to reprint in one volume, all genealogical and source material previously published by RFA, including

genealogies of the lines of several early colonial progenitors and compilations of a variety of source records from various locations.

We hope to have a volume that RFA members will find useful in their own research, as well as an affordable addition to their own family history collection. In order to allow sufficient time for compiling the material into manuscript form and for printing, Sue has set a deadline for a draft to be completed by March 1, 1992. This may seem like a long time, but really isn't when you consider the size of the task Sue has taken upon herself: typing 30 volumes and approximately 1500 pages of material. Sue needs assistance from members in two areas.

DOCUMENTED CORRECTIONS. Anyone having documented corrections to, or additional evidence for, material in any of these annuals may submit it for consideration and inclusion. We do not want to perpetuate erroneous information! Submission of such corrections should be made quickly so they can be included in the text at the time of transcription of the article.

WORD PROCESSING AND PROOFREADING. Anyone who is willing to assist in the task of entry into a word processor or proofreading will find their assistance greatly appreciated. Volunteers for data entry should have an IBM AT-compatible (DOS 3.3) system. Sue will be using Word Perfect 5.0 but other word processing programs that can convert to the Word Perfect format (or to an ASCII text) will be acceptable. Photocopies of the material to be entered/proofed will be provided.

Hernando de Soto's 1540 expedition was the first European incursion into the part of the Cherokees' and Creeks' lands that would become Georgia. By 1566 Spain had established Franciscan missions on St. Simons and Jekyll Islands and the adjacent mainland. The British granted James Oglethorpe a charter for a colony at Savannah comprised of English, Scottish, Swiss and German Protestants and Portugese Jews.

The largest state east of the Mississippi River, Georgia ranges from the high Appalachians to the Atlantic shore. Atlanta, the land of Margaret Mitchell, Scarlett O'Hara and Rhett Butler, began in 1837 as a railroad stake named Terminus, then it became Marthasville in honor of Martha Lumpkin, daughter of the Georgia governor, then Atlanta. Peachtree Street began as a trail linking Terminus with the Indian trading post of Standing Peachtree. Warning: There are more than 30 thoroughfares which contain the word "peachtree" in their names. There is only one Peachtree Street. The Cyclorama, Stone Mountain, Grant Park, fresh-water fishing, boating, golf, Six Flags Over Georgia. More information to follow in future issues.
