JOSIAH REYNOLDS AND THE MAYFLOWER CONNECTION

This is from some research I have done on JOSIAH REYNOLDS (1766-1854). The Robert and Mary book leave him in VT with his wife, Mary. I have not attempted to trace the children

of ANN and NICHOLAS HOLT, but with all those boys there must be some other Reynolds descendants that would be interested in joining RFA. The question is, Where are they?

My gr-grandmother, JULIA ANN REYNOLDS MORRISON, was as far as I can determine, an only child of the marriage of Josiah and HARRIET. JULIA and ALEXANDER MORRISON had several children, but only their son Donald, had any children that lived to maturity and he had only one that lived and she was my mother, CAMILLE MORRISON.

JOSIAH REYNOLDS⁶ (THOMAS⁵, NATHANIEL⁴, NATHANIEL³, NATHANIEL², ROBERT¹) was born on 1 Jul 1766 at Bridgewater. Josiah married MARY PHILLIPS of Abington on 5 Feb 1785. The 1790 Census shows Josiah Reynolds in Plymouth MA. The 1800 Census says that Josiah was in Shutesbury (Hampshire) MA. In 1810 Josiah was in Chester (Windham) VT. In 1820 Josiah was still in Chester VT, but the county had changed to Windsor. Along with Josiah was a family of PHILLIPS (Mary's parents?) and a HOLT family (Josiah's future son-in-law's parents?)

In (Franklin) VT, ANN REYNOLDS married NICHOLAS HOLT on 1 Jan 1827. According to the City Directory of Buffalo NY, Josiah was there in 1828 and listed as a cordwainer. The directories of Buffalo show him as being there through 1838 after which he is not shown. In the 1840 census of Wales (near Buffalo), in the household of Nicholas Holt shows 1 male 5-10, 2 males 10-15, 1 male 30-40, and 1 male 70-80 years (could this be Josiah?), and 1 female 10-15 and 1 female 30-40.

The 1850 census shows in the household of NICHOLAS HOLT his wife ANN, both born VT, EDGAR 17, SUMAN 15, JOSIAH 12 and LORENZO 5, all born NY and JOSEPH 85. Undoubtedly this "Joseph" is JOSIAH.

JULIA ANN REYNOLDS was born in Buffalo NY on 21 Jan 1832. She married ALEXANDER H. MORRISON in (Elkhart) IN 17 Jan 1848.

At some time between the move from Chester VT to Buffalo NY, MARY, JOSIAH's first wife must have died and he married HARRIET CLIFFORD, although no marriage record has been found. Harriet Clifford was born in Canada.

The JOSIAH REYNOLDS line goes back to Robert and Mary of Boston and also through his mother, ELIZABETH TURNER, to the Mayflower lines of EDWARD DOTY, FRANCIS COOKE, and STEVEN HOPKINS.

I would like to find a cousin of my mother's side that isn't too far fetched. Maybe, if you publish this, someone will come forward that is a descendant of Josiah.

PISCATAQUA: A NEW HAMPSHIRE - NEW JERSEY CONNECTION

The Piscataqua Valley lies in Maine and New Hampshire, around the Piscataqua River. Dover and Portsmouth, New Hampshire were the important first settlements there, the latter being called "Strawberry Bank." When the migratory

movement to New Jersey took place, several of the prominent first settlers of New Hampshire and Maine removed to New Jersey, or representatives of their families or their descendants subsequently appeared there as permanent settlers.

This historical fact is the origin of the name Piscataway in New Jersey. It was first called "New Piscataqua," then "New Piscataway" and finally shortened to Piscataway. The major groups of these first settlers were recruited from three main lines of immigration: (1) direct from England, many of which were importations; (2) Piscataqua Country, New Hampshire - Dover, Portsmouth, Hampton, etc.; (3) Massachusetts - Haverhill, Newbury, Ipswich, a few from Boston and Plymouth Colony.

The earliest records of Reynolds settlers in Piscataqua, New Hampshire involve three families, although there is no known connection between these three Reynolds men who lived as contemporaries in the Piscataqua region:

WILLIAM REYNOLDS had originally settled in the Plymouth Colony town of Duxbury, where he married in 1638 ALICE KITSON. They were in Cape Porpoise, Maine as early as 1654. William died there between 1675 and 1681. He had three sons and probably three daughters.

DR. JOHN REYNOLDS was one of the earliest settlers of Piscataqua, witnessing a deed in 1639, and he appears frequently in the records until 1650, when he removed from the area. His wife's name was SARAH, perhaps the daughter of ALEXANDER JONES. There is no record of children, but one record indicates that he and his family were absent from meeting in 1648. It is unknown where John settled after leaving Piscataqua.

CAPT. NICHOLAS REYNOLDS was in Kennebec by 1661, when he purchased land from the Indian, Robin Hood. His wife's name was DOROTHY. Nicholas was living in 1671 when he witnessed a deed, but in a document in 1696, he is called "the late Capt. Reynolds, dec." Two daughters are known, REBECCA and SEABORN. Seaborn was adopted by RICHARD and MARGARET TUCKER.

In Piscataway, New Jersey, the earliest record of a Reynolds settler is that of MARGARET REYNOLDS, daughter of NICHOLAS REYNOLDS. She married BENJAMIN MARTIN in 1680 in Piscataway. Margaret died in childbirth, 12 Jan 1687/88. The death of her father, NICOLAS RENNALS, is recorded in Piscataway, on 15 Sep 1688. There is nothing else known of Nicholas Reynolds.

A SARAH RENNOLS was a member of the church at Woodbridge, New Jersey [near Piscataway] in Oct 1710. WILLIAM RENOLDS was on the list of the Militia Regiment of Piacataway and Woodbridge men in 1715. This is probably the WILLIAM RUNALLS of Woodbridge who died intestate, and for whom the administration of his estate was granted to his widow SARAH RUNALLS on 18 Jan 1749.

Although there is no documentation of a direct connection between these early New Hampshire and New Jersey Reynolds settlers, the circumstances surrounding them leads to some speculation. Families known to have

been associated with the Reynoldses in New Hampshire later appear in lists of New Jersey settlers, e.g. ADAMS, COFFIN, JONES, MARTIN, RAYNES. (A FRANCIS RAYNES was a very early settler of Piscataqua, and his descendant, JOHN RAYNO later appeared in Elizabethtown, New Jersey) The similarity of the names of NICHOLAS and WILLIAM, as well as the historical migration from Piscataqua to Piscataway, indicates a need for further research into the possibility of this New Hampshire/New Jersey Reynolds connection.

THE TILLMAN PROJECT

The Tillman Project, aimed at collecting sources for the information contained in Colonel Tillman's two Reynolds Family books, was begun in the Jan-Feb 1992 issue of RR. His first book (T1-) was published in 1948, and contained 1742 paragraphs (family group sheets). In 1959, he published a second book (T2-), containing the info from T1 and additional info, totaling 8561 paragraphs. Some errors in the 1948 book were corrected in the 1959 book. We need all the help we can get with this project. If you have source material please let RFA know.

HENRY REYNOLDS OF KENTUCKY

I did not know there were two books by Col. Tillman. The members I am writing about are the only members of my family that I found in the 1959 book. Except for a few minor

errors, the large error was in having 6016 HENRY REYNOLDS be the son of 6012 JACOB. I could not find his father Henry who was the son of THOMAS of NC. There are plenty of records and verifications back to Thomas, but nothing back any farther. I think he may have come to NC from MD.

In the 1850 census of (Jessamine) KY, the following family is listed: HENRY REYNOLDS, 78, M, b NC; ELIZABETH 76 F b VA; POLLY 53 F b KY; GUY 17 M b KY; and MORTEN 12 M b KY.

Henry Reynolds m ELIZABETH WILLIS, dau of SHEROD or SHERWOOD and MARY ANN WILLIS of VA. Her death is recorded in State Archives KY Vital Statistics 1852-1904: Reynolds, Elizabeth Age 78 b. Alberene VA d. 27 Aug 1852. of old age Parent Sherod Willis.

Their children were: MARY (POLLY) (listed as idiot in 1860 census. From later deeds we think GUY and MORTEN were her illegitimate children. They never married.) HENRY A., ELIZABETH, WILLIAM, MOSES M., JOHN W., and NANCY.

6016 HENRY REYNOLDS was the son of HENRY REYNOLDS, and he and his father were born in NC. His father was the son of THOMAS and MARY REYNOLDS of (Lincoln) NC. 6016 had brothers DAVID, THOMAS, and MOSES; sisters, MARY, RACHEL, NANCY, ELIZABETH. There may have been a son WILLIAM.

Henry Reynolds Jr and Sr appeared in (Madison) KY tax lists in 1789. Henry Sr sold his property in NC to Phillip ANTHONY and HENRY HOKE. Part of (Madison) KY later became (Gerrard) and Old HENRY and his sons DAVID and MOSES remained there. His son THOMAS was in (Madison) and his son 6011 HENRY moved across the KY River to (Jessamine) KY.

Deeds, estate settlements, wills in KY and NC prove that 6016 HENRY was the son of HENRY REYNOLDS 1737-1826, buried in family cemetery near the home in (Gerrard) KY. HENRY JR is buried on Kissing Ridge in the southeastern part of (Jessamine) KY with his wife and other relatives.

Uncles of 6016 HENRY are believed to be HENRY, THOMAS, JOHN, RICHARD, WILLIAM and ALEXANDER according to info from deeds in NC.

Many descendants of this family still reside here. Many went West. Quite a few of them return here to research their ancestry each year. The county court house at Nicholasville KY has all the old records in original form. All old records are at Lancaster (Gerrard) KY and Richmond (Madison) Ky.

We have not found a JACOB connected to this family. Many deed abstracts are in Mecklinburg Co. NC Deed Abstracts 1763-1779 by Brent Holcomb, C.A.L.S., and Elmer O. Parker, L 84-03885 Book in (Lincoln) Library, Lincolnton NC. This portion of this county having our Reynolds ancestors has had several names.

6020 JOHN W. REYNOLDS, of (6016), b 1813 (Jessamine) KY, ■ CAROLINE PILANT, dau of JAMES PILANT and SARAH VINCENT. Issue: SARAH ELIZABETH b 1840, JAMES P. b 1842, MOSES b 1844, WILLIAM and LUCINDA b 1847 (twins), and THERSY b 1849.

Could 6021 RICHARD REYNOLDS be related to the HENRY that came to (Madison) KY?

The Bible of THOMAS REYNOLDS (From LEONARDO ANDREA 1950

Files to CHARLES FELDER REYNOLDS JR): This Bible is owned by Mrs. EUNICE TOLER HINTON and came to her from her grandfather, the Rev. SILAS H. THOMPSON...Mrs. HINTON lent Mr. JOHN T. CUPIT the bible and he made this copy and sent it to me from his home at Rosepine LA.... THOMAS REYNOLDS was born in SC in either Marion or Darlington Co... He was married in Fairfield Co. SC to Miss MARY MEREDITH and they settled in Edgefield SC and where the older children were born. Ca 1815 THOMAS REYNOLDS removed to Amite Co. MS...If there was a wedding list in the Bible Mr. Cupit did not send it to [Andrea]:

THOMAS REYNOLDS was born May 28th 1776 and died Sept. 6th 1854

His wife

MARY MEREDITH was born Nov. 5th 1782 and died Dec. 16th 1873.

THOMAS REYNOLDS was married to Miss MARY MEREDITH in Fairfield Co. SC on July 9th 1804.

Their children

MARTHA REYNOLDS born 25 Mar 1805 died 21 Feb 1833

ABIGAIL REYNOLDS born 14 Sep 1806 died 4 Mar 1845

I have substantiated through public records and Bibles my lineage from my birth in 1918 in (Bolivar) MS back to 6094.1 THOMAS REYNOLDS b 1776 (Fairfield) SC. I have not been able to effect the link between 6094.1 THOMAS and 6094 WILLIAM. I have copies of WILLIAM REYNOLDS' will recorded in (York) VA. The will of WILLIAM REYNOLDS in (York) VA does not indicate heirs. I have copies of his pension claim from the National Archives; have done research at the SC Historical Society in Charleston. Neither his will nor the pension claim make reference to his having been in SC. I also have copies of THOMAS REYNOLDS (6092?) will in (Essex) VA. With the help of a genealogist in SC, I have established considerable migration of the family from (Caroline) VA, spun off from (Essex), to (Edgefield) and (Fairfield) SC. The names WILLIAM and THOMAS recur frequently in that research. However, none of that research indicated that 6094.1 THOMAS' father WILLIAM returned to the (York) area.

The possible linkage to (Caroline) is substantiated by the fact that during the mid 1700's when the migration

took place from (Caroline) to SC an often found name is PICKETT in (Caroline). Both the Reynolds and Pickett families migrated together to (Edgefield) SC., and then there was movement back and forth between (Edgefield) and (Fairfield) bef the migration to MS c1815. My great grandfather's name was LITTLETON PICKETT REYNOLDS. But my somewhat exhaustive research has not established an absolute provable line between the Caroline group and THOMAS REYNOLDS of Fairfield. It is unfortunate that (Caroline) records appear to have been destroyed for that era. I have not been to the courthouse in Bowling Green but I have searched to quite an extent in the VA Archives and in the VA State Library, without much success, other than Tillman's reference.

The MEREDITH family also appears to have been in the same migration, although the Meredith linkage appears to have been more from (Isle of Wight)/Norfolk VA area. The Meredith family migrated with the REYNOLDS to MS.

One of SC's outstanding genealogists, Leonardo Andrea, did considerable research before his death on the Reynolds family. His research is now part of the South Caroliniana Room at the University of SC. His records verify my records on THOMAS REYNOLDS of Fairfield, but not beyond Thomas. Andrea does mention the possible linkage between the Edgefield/Fairfield SC and the (Caroline) VA but he did not continue. His client was able to establish suitable evidence on the Reynolds/Meredith families participation in the Rev War and did not want to continue.

THOMAS REYNOLDS OF NC

According to the Journal of NC Genealogy, Winter 1966, THOMAS REYNOLDS and his brother RICHARD REYNOLDS, age 18 and 19, respectively, were members of Capt. SAMUEL COBURN's Company of the militia of 1747 and 1748. They were issued grants between 1749 and 1762 to land in Lincoln and Gaston Cos. NC.

In Abstracts of Deeds of Tryon, Lincoln, and Rutherford Cos. NC 1769-1786, there are numerous deeds between THOMAS REYNOLDS and his sons: Pp 450-451, THOMAS REYNOLDS to THOS. REYNOLDS JR for 50pds NC money, land on both sides of Indian Creek, adj: JOHN REYNOLDS, HENRY REYNOLDS, granted to THOMAS REYNOLDS SR 20 Aug 1753...3d Jul 1771 THOS REYNOLDS (seal) Jurate recorded July term 1771.

Bk 1, pp 565-566 Jan 1772, A deed of maintenance from THOS. REYNOLDS SR to HENRY REYNOLDS for caring for him for the rest of his life, two tracts of land in (Tryon) NC, being on both sides of Indian Creek. The same as was granted to THOMAS REYNOLDS 20 Aug 1753.

NC Genealogy, Fall 1957, p1928, states that CHARLES MCPHEETERS lived on the west bank of the Catawba River abt 3 miles N. of SAMUEL COBURN, prob from (Cecil) MD THOMAS and RICHARD REYNOLDS, also from (Cecil) MD (91) were granted

land on Indian Creek some 6 miles SW of the modern town of Lincolnton (92). Same issue, p 1932, more verification.

Recap from deeds: THOMAS REYNOLDS SR d before 1794, wife Mary. Ch: HENRY REYNOLDS b ca 1737, wife ELIZABETH (McLAIN?). THOMAS REYNOLDS JR, wife MARTHA __. RICHARD REYNOLDS, wife ELIZABETH __. JOHN I. REYNOLDS d abt 1828 (Lincoln) NC. ALEXANDER REYNOLDS, wife MARYANN "W". WILLIAM REYNOLDS, wife HANNAH __.

THOMAS REYNOLDS Sr's son HENRY REYNOLDS sold land in NC to PHILLIP ANTHONY and HENRY HOKE and appeared on tax lists of (Madison) KY in 1789, one year later. Most of his ch were mar in NC bef coming to KY with their parents. Ch: HENRY REYNOLDS JR (see Tillman Project); THOMAS, MOSES, DAVID, RACHEL m JOSEPH JONES; MARY m JOHN SUFFRETT; ELIZABETH m 1st THOS. WILLIAMSON, 2d DANIEL ANTHONY; NANCY m HENRY BARLOW. There may have been a son WILLIAM who died rather young.

HENRY REYNOLDS' property in Ky was located in (Gerrard) KY, as it was formed from (Madison). Some of Henry's children later moved to (Jessamine) which had been formed from (Fayette) KY.

Who were the parents of THOMAS REYNOLDS SR of NC, who was his wife and where did they come from to NC? His property has been in several counties due to land division in western NC.

Is anyone else in the Family descended from some of this family. There is much more information available on the ones I have named, if I can be of help to someone.

JOSEPH L. REYNOLDS

My gr-grandfather was JOSEPH L. REYNOLDS, b abt 1800 prob in or near Lexington KY. Mother and father's names unknown; mother may have been of Cherokee ancestry. Joseph L. moved to (White) IL and began work as carpenter at local salt works; 1823 m LEAH FOLEY, also being searched; printed sources show her also as native of KY, no county given. After mar, prob in Equality area of (Gallatin) IL, Joseph L. and Leah located in Equality where two sons were born: THOMAS YOUNG REYNOLDS b 29 May 1825; and ISAAC H. REYNOLDS b 1827/1828. LEAH FOLEY REYNOLDS d 1832, bur in Equality Village Cem, where her gravestones gives birth as 1794. In a number of sources, including Lawler's Gallatin County, Gateway to IL, JOSEPH L. is mentioned in regard to positions held in Equality town government and on petitions for improved roads, etc. He served in the Black Hawk Campaign of 1832, Company of Capt. JAMES CALDWELL; and in Mar 1839 was allowed 80 acres in (Gallatin) IL in remuneration for his service and use of his horse in "Sac War of 1832" (abstract from Il state 11th Assembly session). No record of JOSEPH L. remarrying after Leah's death in 1832. Older son, THOMAS Y. settled in the Harrisburg area, while son ISAAC moved to OR. Joseph L. d

in 1867, bur (though transcript of gravesite is a little jumbled) probably near Leah in Equality. KY 1840 census lists only a JEREMIAH REYNOLDS in (Fayette). Who are the parents of Joseph L?

MOSES NELSON REYNOLDS

Moses Nelson REYNOLDS, b 17 Aug 1813, m 26 Sep 1847 Rebecca TEATER, dau of Claiborne C. Teater and Eleanor DAVIS who was dau of John and Rachel WEST Davis.

Moses Nelson REYNOLDS was named as sole heir to the farm of his Uncle and Aunt John and Mary SUFFRET of (Jessamine) KY (Will Bk E, p 117, 10 Feb 1835. He came into the inheritance upon the death of his Aunt Mary in 1840. Moses Nelson then traded the farm for 10,000 lbs of hemp (Deed Bk D, 18 Mar 1846). Later he left for IA.

Moses was son of David REYNOLDS and Jane MOORE (1783-1822). David and Jane are bur in fam cem in (Garrard) KY, 37°45'56"N at mouth of Pain Lick Ferry.

David REYNOLDS b ca 1784 NC d 1855; first sheriff of (Gerrard) KY. Forest Calico in History of Gerrard Co. KY identified Moses' siblings as: John M. m 1st Susan ANTHONY, 2d Fatima TOTTEN; David W. m Rebecca TOTTEN; James P. m Zulina TOTTEN; Oliver Perry m Mary Ann ANDERSON; Mary Jane m Eli CRANE; Elizabeth A. m Alfred Coleman DAVIS; Sophronia m Edward A. MARTIN; Harvey M. --; and Henry Lee? These ch were born and mar in (Garrard) KY. They are named as heirs in the deeds of land sold to settle the estate of their uncle Moses REYNOLDS. Deeds are filed at the county clerk's office in Lancaster KY.

Moses Nelson REYNOLDS was the grandson of Henry L. REYNOLDS and Elizabeth (McLAIN?) of NC. Henry was b 1837. In his will of 1826, probated in the Oct term of court in (Gerrard) KY, he mentions sons Henry, Thomas, Moses, and David REYNOLDS. He left his slaves to David for love and care of him and his wife until their deaths.

Henry REYNOLDS was the son of Thomas REYNOLDS and his wife Mary ___ of NC. On 30 Aug 1753 Thomas REYNOLDS was

granted a patent of 2000 acres of land on both sides of Indian Creek near Catawba River in (Tryon) NC. Land is near what is now the town of Lincolnton NC.

Thomas REYNOLDS, son of Henry, came to (Madison) KY in 1789. There are deeds in NC where he sold land to Phillip ANTHONY, among others. In (Garrard) KY Deed Book A, Henry REYNOLDS bought 100 acres of land from George TETER.
