The following information is from the Arkansas 1911 Census of Confederate Veterans. Transcribed and edited by Bobbie J. McLane and Capitola Glazner, 1977. Sent to RFA by Ella R.

Emery from the TN Gen. Soc., Memphis TN, Mar 1992.

REYNOLDS, Archibald Hamilton of Camden AR, b 24 Mar 1845 at Starkville (Oktibbeha) MS, s/o Hugh Montgomery Reynolds born in Fairfield District SC who lived in (Troup) GA and served in Indian War in FL. He was the son of William Malcom Reynolds and his wife Mary Montgomery who lived in Fairfield Dist. SC. Maiden name of subject's mother was Martha Hamilton d/o Thompson and Susan Hamilton who lived at Stone Mtn (Gwinnett) GA. "My father, Hugh Montgomery Reynolds, enlisted in service from (Troup) GA and went to FL to and served in the Seminole and Creek Wars for which his wife is now drawing a pension. My great-grandfather on my mother's side was Archibald Hamilton and was a descendant and landed in this country in VA [sic]. Subject was a Democrat, Presbyterian, Odd Fellow until charter was surrendered. Served in Co. F, 19th Regt AR Volunteers, enlisted at Lisbon, Union Co. or Camden AR 10 Mar 1862 to about last of May or 1st of Jun 1865, 3 years, 3 months. Was in 11 major battles besides light engagements through MS & TN. Married Willie Clay Heath, d/o William A. Heath and his wife Carrie Elisabeth Beverly of Wesson MS on 9 Jul 1885 at Starkville MS. REYNOLDS, Daniel Houck Harris, D 14 Mar 1902 Lake Village AR, b 14 Dec 1832 near Centerburg (Knox) OH, s/o Amos Reynolds b (Loudon) VA, lived there from 26 Mar 1850 in Knox Co. He was son of William Reynolds and his wife Rebecca Harris who lived in (Loudon) VA. Maiden name of subject's mother was Sophia Houck, d/o James Houck and his wife Sarah Shadley who lived their last years in OH. Under "Remarks on Ancestry," the following: John Reynolds emigrated from England and settled in Loudon Co. VA. Daniel Harris emigrated from England and settled in Loudon Co. VA., time not known. Jacob Houck emigrated from Germany and settle din Baltimore Co. MD. Henry Foley emigrated from England and settled in Frederick Co. VA. Daniel Shadley emigrated from England and settled in Frederick Co. VA. William Reynolds, b 1771 (Loudon) VA, d 1824 (Knox) OH.

Subject attended school at the OH Wesleyan University in Delaware IA in 1854, thence to Somerville TN in 1857 he taught in OH, read law in IA and (Hardeman) TN, read law in office of Hon. John W. Harris, Somerville TN, was admitted to the bar there 13 May 1858. He came to AR in May 1858, was admitted to Bar 8 Jun 1858. On 15 Jun 1858 located to practice law at Lake Village (Chicot) AR and remained except time he was in the war. Was Brigadier General, 4th AR Bn AR Infantry; member os legislature in Little Rock in 1866-67. He was elected to AR Senate from the Counties of Ashley, Chicot and Drew in 1866, and served until the legislature was disbanded by Military Order in 1867 under the Reconstruction Act of Congress. The subject was mustered in as Captain 14 Jan 1861, elected Major 14 Apr 1862, elected Lieut. Col. 1 May 1862, appointed Colonel 17 Nov 1863, to take rank 20 Sep 1863, was appointed Brigadier General on 12 Mar 1864 to command the Brigade (McNairs) of which his regiment formed a part which was thereafter known as "Reynolds AR Brigade." Married Martha Jane Wallace, d/o Jeremiah Wallace and his wife Eleanor Waddell, 24 Nov 1868 at Lake Village (Chicot) AR. John Wallace emigrated from Scotland and settled in (Holmes) MS. Mary Coleman b GA, d (Holmes) MS in 1845. John Waddell emigrated from England and settled in LA, died Clinton LA 1846. John Waddell b LA 1794, d (Madison) MS 26 Dec 1844. Isaac Wells b GA 1859. Nancy Coleman b GA 186_. Caroline Matilda Wells b MS 1803, d Holly Springs MS 1847. Jeremiah Wallace born (Holmes) MS 25 Aug 1822, d 8 Nov 1848. Eleanor Waddell in Each [East?] Falician Parish LA 22 Nov 1826 - living. Martha Jane Wallace, subject's wife b (Holmes) MS 23 May 1845 and is now living in Lake Village AR. Children:

REYNOLDS REUNION, 1903
Providence [RI] Journal

The members of the Reynolds family, particularly the descendants of Robert and John Reynolds of Watertown MA; William and James of Providence; John of Weymouth; and Henry Reynolds of Chichester MA [sic] had a reunion yesterday at the De Wolf Inn, Bristol. The people, to the number of 65, came from the New England, Western and Middle States, and between the hours of 10 and 11 AM a reception was held in the hall. President Giles Reynolds

of Philadelphia called the family to order at 11 AM, and prayer was offered by Rev. W.R. Trotter of Bristol, and then the regular business meeting ensued and the president made an address of welcome.

Reports from the secretary and treasurer were read, and also from the historian, Mrs Mary Reynolds Fosdick. Miss Gertrude T. Reynolds read the latter, as the historian was indisposed. There was considerable discussion about the matter of publishing genealogies of the various branches of the Reynolds family, in which considerable interest was manifested. A vote of thanks was given to the historian.

A report from the committee on chronology showed that there were two deaths of members during the year. F.B. Reynolds read a report in regard to the work done in arranging material for the general publication of histories of the Reynolds family throughout the United States.

Judge J.T. Reynolds of Bristol stated that the story of his branch of the family would soon be ready to be printed, and in addition to his Mrs. Mary Fosdick, the historian of the association, announced that the history of John Reynolds of Weymouth was nearly ready for publication also.

Rev. F.B. Cole of Wickford announced that Hon. J.J. Reynolds of Wickford is at work on the material for the historian of his branch of the family.

The officers elected were: President, Giles Reynolds of Philadelphia; vice presidents, John P. Reynolds of Bristol, George W. Guard of New London CT; H.C. Reynolds of Scranton PA; Edwin Reynolds of Milwaukee WI; Wilson P Reynolds of East Haddam CT; chaplain, George W. Guard of New London CT; secretary and treasurer, Mary Reynolds Fosdick of Middletown CT; assistant secretary and treasurer, Howard I. Reynolds of Philadelphia; historian, Mary Reynolds Fosdick of Middletown CT.

All about the rooms were arranged pictures of the Reynolds coat of arms and each of the guests wore a pin of the same pattern, consisting of three gold crosses on a blue enamel field, with a gilt edge, four spots surmounting the design. [NO, today RFA doesn't have such pins in stock! -- Editor]

After business was completed the party went to the home of Judge John P. Reynolds, where Lafayette was a guest on his way through the town, and at 2 o'clock the annual banquet of the association was served.

During the post prandial exercises Judge George Greenwood Reynolds of Brooklyn acted as toastmaster, and was introduced by President Giles Reynolds of Philadelphia. Those who responded to the toast were Hon. H.C. Reynolds of Scranton PA; Rev W.J. Reynolds of Auburn RI; Judge John P. Reynolds of Bristol; W.T. Reynolds of Hadmore PA and Rev F.B. Cole of Wickford RI.

We are puzzled about the origins of Simeon Reynolds, who is my wife Jan's great-great grandfather.

According to T1-410, Simeon Reynolds was born in (Bedford) TN, and moved to MS, where he married and became the father of several children, including Seabourn (Seaborn is correct spelling) Grove Reynolds (T1-410), who was father of Ralph, who was father of Roland, who was Jan's father. We have been able to verify Seaborn Reynolds' background, as described by Tillman, in most particulars. What puzzles us is that there seems to be an indication that Simeon came from New England, rather than TN. A book on the history of Los Angeles published in 1889 states that Simeon was of Irish descent and was born in RI. Also, when Seaborn Reynolds died in 1907, his son Ralph reported to the State Board of Health that his grandfather Simeon came from MA. We do not know when Simeon was born or when he died, but we do have a record of his marriage to Florinda Sullivant in 1823 in MS.

Ezekiel Reynolds, according to T1-407, was father of Simeon. Nobody seems to know who the mother was. Ezekiel was born in NC, lived in VA for a while, and then went to TN. He lived his later years with his son Michael (Simeon's brother or half-brother) in (Bedford) TN. He died sometime after 1840, over 80 years old. Ezekiel's application for a Rev War pension, filed in 1832, shows that he never traveled north of VA or TN. If son Simeon came from RI or MA, it would possibly have been that his mother was from that area, but we do not know her name. Or, it may be that Tillman is in error, and that Simeon's father was not Ezekiel Reynolds of NC and TN.

In any case, we are having trouble reconciling the

suggestion of a New England origin for Simeon, when other indications point to a birthplace in the south. Simeon appears to have been born around 1800 (Michael, according to Tillman, was born in 1802), which could be consistent for him to be married in 1823. We note, however, that Ezekiel was still in NC in 1800 and did not move to (Bedford) TN until 1811; but this is the place where Tillman says Simeon was born (but Michael was born in NC).

Death of Mrs. Reynolds. Mrs. Mary E. Reynolds, wife of Mr. Y.P. Reynolds, died this morning, at half past seven o'clock, at the family residence, four miles from the city, on the Blandville road, in the fifty eighth year of her life, after a lingering illness of many months with malarial fever.

Mrs. Reynolds was the daughter of Thomas Anderson, born in Greene County, Ky., January 13, 1829, married Mr. Reynolds in 1845, and has been a resident of this county for thirty three years. She leaves beside her husband, six children -- Mrs. Thomas L. Jones, Emma, Lewin, and Yeatman Reynolds, of the county, Mrs. H.M. Beauchamp, of this city, and Mr. Robert R. Reynolds of Fayette, Mo., and was a sister of the late Edward L. Anderson of this county. She was a faithful and consistent member of the Methodist Church since childhood, and in all the relations of life, good, kind wife and mother, with unostentatious piety, was much respected and loved by all who knew her.

Gr-Gr-grandfather Seaborn Reynolds (son of Simeon) b 1834 (Yalobusha) MS, d 1907 Los Angeles. Simeon m Florinda SULLIVANT in (Monroe) MS. Know Seaborn had sister Mary b abt 1832 who m William MELTON in MS. Believe Seaborn had older brothers, because the 1830 (Monroe) MS census indicated 3 boys under age of 10 in household. In 1840 census, there were 7 boys, and a 1889 census of Los Angeles indicates Seaborn was the 5th of 8 children, but, except for Mary we do not know the names of any of the other siblings. Seaborn left home as a teenager, after his mother died (abt 1842). So, seems likely that there are other Reynolds out there who can trace their ancestry back to Simeon. Will appreciate hearing from any of them.
