JERRY C. HILL HONORED

Pilot Jerry C. Hill, former Glendale man, has been posthumously honored by both the United States and Puerto Rican governments.

Hill was killed Dec. 31 [1972] along with baseball player Roberto Clemente and four others in the crash of a plane Hill was piloting from Puerto Rico to earthquake-stricken Managua Nicaragua. Hill's humane actions toward

the victims of the Dec. 23 [1972] earthquake typified his concern for others, according to his sister Mrs Dorothy Dery of Glendale.

Hill, an alumnus of Glendale High School and Glendale College, had flown clothes and food to Biafran orphans after the war in Biafra, she recalls.

A divorced father of four, Hill was a commercial pilot who had been residing in Minnesota before his death. President Nixon has issued a certificate stating that the "United States of America honors the memory of Jerry C. Hill.

"This certificate is awarded by a grateful nation in recognition of devoted and selfless consecration to the service of our country in the Armed Forces of the United States," it reads.

The Puerto Rican government presented a plaque and Bible to the family of Hill, who was also the brother of Napa resident of Orion A. Hill. The inscription on the plaque, in Spanish, reads: "Greater love hath no man than he who would lay down his life for his friends." It was signed by Puerto Rican Governor Rafael Hernandez Colon. The shape of the plaque is an outline of the island of Puerto Rico. The Bible is inscribed with a verse from Psalms. [From a series of news stories in January 1993.]

Jerry and her brothers descend from William Peyton Reynolds who died in TX and who married Angeline Rice born in Texas.

REYNOLDS, BENJAMIN, Senator from Parish of St. John, Colleton. - Born 4 Jan 1750 in St. Helena's Parish, the son of William Reynolds and Jane Reynolds, his cousin. Large planter of St. Helena's and of Wadmalaw Island, Charleston District. Married 1st Mrs. Sarah (Chaplin) Smilie, widow of Edward Smilie, 1 Apr 1775; 2d Anne Smilie, after 1785. During Rev War, 1st lieutenant, 20 Oct 1775; survived attack by British on Wadmalaw Island. Tax collector, St. Helena's 1782, 1783. Commissioner to sell Pollawahna Island in St. Helena's Parish, 1784. Justice of Peace. SC House of Representatives, St. Helena's 1778-80, 1782-84, 1786-92; St. John's, Colleton, 1794-96, 1812-14. SC Senate, St. John's, Colleton, 1818-26; died. Member of St. John's Episcopal Church, John's Island; vestryman 1812-26. Died at "Fenwick Castle," John's Island, 28 Jun 1826, in office as Senator; buried in St. John's Churchyard, John's Island.

REYNOLDS, THOMAS JOHN, Senator from Beaufort County. -

Born 28 mar 1854 on St. Helena Island, Beaufort District, the son of John Reynolds and Leila _____, of the Negro race. Apprenticed in carpenter trade under his father. Attended school on St. Helena Island; in Beaufort; Atlanta University GA Feb 1871-1874; SC University Mar 1875-1877. Taught school in Beaufort County and in GA while attending college. Clerk to auditor of Beaufort in summer, 1875. Returned to Beaufort in 1877; bought small vessel and entered coasting trade between Beaufort and Savannah; successful business. Admitted to SC Board 16 Dec 1885. SC Senate, Beaufort, 1884-88.

1820 US CENSUS INDEX FOR GEORGIA

The 1790, 1800, and 1810 GA censuses were destroyed in the War of 1812 when the British burned Washington in 1814. Some of the records used for this compilation were so poor that names could not be deciphered. This is not a complete list of all residents of Georgia in 1820. Made from microfilm copy of original record in Washington, except for Morgan county, which was copied from the original. The worst copies were for Chatham, Laurens, Pulaski, Hancock, Richmond, and Wilkes counties.

The last word at the end of the each name is the county. Number in parentheses, e.g., (2), is the number of times that given name was found in the records for that county. Read across, two columns within this column. Ind=Individual
