hereby give and devise unto her sister Elizabeth Field solely and alone, all that my Personal Estate which I had before given and bequeathed unto them both jointly; I say, I now give the same wholly to my wife's sister Elizabeth Field only: But limited with ye same condition and with ye same exceptions as in my said will mentioned and I do declare that these presents shall be a Codicil to my said Will." Dated 17 Feb 1733/4.

The portrait of Elizabeth Field, known as "M^{rs} Field", painted in 1748 by Sir J. Reynolds, is in my possession. It is interesting as being one of the few portraits known to have been painted by him before his visit to Italy in 1749, after which date he completely changed the stiff style of painting he acquired from his master, Hudson. See Taylor's "Life of Reynolds," vol. i, p.30.

His silver-handled dinner knives and other plate, all engraved with his crest, "out of a mural crown, a demi talbot." A volume containing 28 original drawings by Barbieri (Guerchino). Sir Joshua's copy of Claude's "Liber Veritatis." Some of Sir Joshua's discourses (printed), corrected in his own handwriting. Rasselas and other volumes with his autograph. Some sketches by him and numerous proof engravings from his portfolios. Sir Joshua's favourite pocket snuff-box, his spectacles, etc. Mrs. Pearce of Somerleigh Gate has a remarkably fine pair of old point lace ruffles belonging to him.

THE S.M. REYNOLDS FAMILY CONTINUED FROM LAST ISSUE

After the Goodspeed account of his life in Phillip;s Co AR, Mr. Reynolds moved to Frisco (Denton) TX, and applied for a Pension from the State of TX for his service in the Confederacy. Below follows answers to questions on his application #26146, approved 1 Dec 1913, Filed 4 Feb 1914 and paid from 1 Mar 1914. State of Texas. County of Denton.

I, Stephen M. Reynolds do hereby make application to the Commissions for a pension to be granted me under the act passed by the 33rd Legislature of the State of Texas, and approved April 7, 1913. I was honoarably surrendered in Phillips Co. Ark. I was at home on furlough when war closed.

Age, 68. Born Green Co TN. Resided in TX 22 yrs. Reside Denton Co. Reside in Denton Co. 10 years, post office address Frisco Texas. Applied for pension and rejected? No. Occupation, farmer. Not able to work. The command in which served was from State of Arkansas. Served 2 years, from July 1862 to close of war. Served in R.D. Anderson Co., Roberts Regt., Walkers Brigade, 2nd Ark. Cavalry. Transferred? No. What branch? Cavalry. Not commissioned. Not detailed. Assessed value of home? No home. Assessed value of other property? No property. Have you transferred property to someone one else? No. Sign: S.M. Reynolds. Sworn & Subscribed 20 Dec 1913. S.H. Hoskins, Co. Judge, Denton Co. Affidavit of Witnesses to application signed by R.P.Miles and W.L. Buster.

Cert of State & Co. Assessor J.M. Gary states S.M. Reynolds has no property on the tax rolls of Denton Co. Texas.

Interrogatories to Witnesses in Pension Claim: George Slaughter of Lee Co. AR who states that he is age 70 and resides in Marianna, Lee Co., Ark, states: 1. I personally knew S.M. Reynolds in Phillips Co. Arkansas and have known him all of his life. 2. I know that S.M. Reynolds enlisted as a soldier in the Confederacy. He enlisted in Dobbins Reg., Anderson's Co., Phillips Co., Arkansas about 1863 or 1864 and served until the close of the war and that he served as a private soldier from date of enlistment to the close of the war. Dated 14 Jan 1914 in Lee Co., Ark.

M.H. McGrew of Phillips Co., Ark. States: 1. Has known S.M. Reynolds more than 50 years. He was a private soldier who served about 4 years. Wm. H. McGrew states he is 75 years old and resides in Papean Grove, Phillips Co., Ark., and that he served in the army with S.M. Reynolds. Served in Anderson's Compnay of Dobbins Reg. Does not know date of enlistement but served until war was over. S.M. Reynolds served as a private during the entire time of service with the same company. McGrew states he served in the same company and regiment the entire time and after the close of the war lived for several years as his next door neighbor. McGrew states he knows no other S.M. Reynolds and is positively certain this is the same Reynolds he served with and said Reynolds served honorably as a soldier and did not desert.

End of aplication.

I did not find when he died or where he was buried. He may have been buried in Collin County, Texas, as Frisco is right on the county line.

MORE ABOUT

JAMES REYNOLDS & BETSEY PENOYER

I can add a bit more to the article in the May/June 1995 issue, page 47-48. In the "American Genealogist," Vol 36:1, p19, is listed the 'Burials of Pound Cemetery, Neversink NY'. This cemetery is located east of the village of Neversink on the slopes of Mutton Hill. Listed among the burials is:

Henry Reynolds born at Peekskill NY 1742, died at Neversink NY 1827. His wife Mary Fowler is also listed in the burials born 1743, died 1825. Their monument reads: For loyalty to freedom he was attacked by a tory band and left for dead in his own home. Monument erected by descendants of Henry Reynolds in 1902.

Also buried there is his daughter, Phebe Reynolds, widow of Jeremiah Drake who d 21 Nov 1853, aged 83 years 3 mos 7 days. Jeremiah Drake is also buried there, died June 22, 1845, aged 84 years 22 days.

Another monument in the cemetery lists Alvan Hall, born on Mutton Hill 1809, d 1872 s/o John Hall who emigrated from Litchfield CT 1789. Phebe his wife born on Neversink Flat 1812 died 1897 d/o Jeremiah Drake and Phebe Reynolds. Alvan Hall and Phebe's ch are buried there - Mary J 1841-1913; Louise born Oct 22, 1843 died Feb 6 1848; Celia born Oct 22, 1843 died Feb 19 1848.

Also my records show that Daniel Reynolds s/o Henry Reynolds, married Rebecca French b 1781 and died 1822 not 1882 as article states. This data is taken from a DAR paper. [Ed. note: Could discrepancy have been this editor's typographical error? The file copy has already gone to MA for storage.]

Also at the end of the article in the "American Genealogist" it states the Henry Reynolds is the s/o David Reynolds of Stamford CT, later of Peekskill NY and still later of Cornwall, Orange Co. NY.

My interest comes from my ancestor David Reynolds b 1739 d 1789 with wife Mary. His will was probated in Orange Co NY 1790, listing ch: James, Joseph, Henry, Reuben,

Elizabeth and Sarah. From The History and Descendants of John and Sarah Reynolds, by Marion H. Reynolds, pp53, 54, 54 [sic], and 78 it records information on this Reynolds family as having been in CT, Peekskill and later Cornwall (where my ancestor lived - he served as a minute-man in Rev. - my supplemental papers accepted by DAR several years ago). I believe the David and Mary Reynolds listed on p78 with only James listed as son but stating there were three others...Could it be my David b 1739 and Henry born 1742? More research is needed.

Ancestor Services, Pension File W5683: My ancestor's services in assisting the establishment of American Independence during the War of the Revolution were as follows: That he enlisted in the Regular Army of the U.S. in the Year 1776 under one Scruggs, and served in the 5th Virginia Reg. of the Continental line. That he enlisted in the county of Bedford and State of Virginia, and marched from to Norfolk, and after remaining there some short time, proceeded to join the Northern Army under the command of General Gates. That he was attached to Col. Morgan's command, and was engaged with the Regular Army at Saratoga when General Burgonne was taken, and received a bad wound in the hand and had his gun broken. That he entered the Army as a Private soldier, but in some short time thereafter was promoted to a Sargent [sic], in which capacity he continued to act until he returned home. That he was also in the battles of Princetown and Trentown and aided in capturing about 400 Hessians, and was commanded by our [sic] Capt. Henderson and Ensign Washington. That after he returned to the County of Bedford, he served in the Militia six months at one time, and three at another time, and that he served in the Regular Army upwards of two years.

REYNOLDS-AVERY-BELL -- Joan Huot, 53 Hadley St, Lowell MA 01851: Death Cert says grandfather Francis Bennett Reynolds b 4 Sep 1865 in Aurora IL, s/o Sylvester H. Reynolds and Emily Clementine Averill. I have not yet been able to find anything to connect him to this family. He is not with them on any census that I have been able to find. He is not listed in "The Averell-Averill-Avery Family," by Clara Avery...My Uncle Francis remembers his father talking about Sylvester & Emily as parents and his father having a brother named William.
