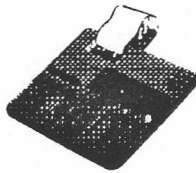
In Memoriam

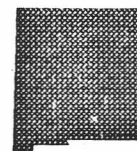

BIG SMALL-TOWN HISTORY

Mesilla, NM - If you plan to attend the Whole Enchilada Festival in Las Cruces today or Sunday, you might allow extra time to visit this community southwest of the City of the Crosses. Mesilla is like a page out of a history book.

The raising of the U.S. flag occurred on the town plaza 6 Nov 1854, after the Gadsden Purchase ended the quarrel over whether Mesilla was part of the U.S. or Mexico.

The plaza, restored in 1976, stands as a monument to Mesilla's history. Quaint gift shops, art galleries and restaurants surround the plaza and the streets leading to it. But underneath most modern versions of the structures lies another history lesson.

The Maurin Store, which houses two shops, Thunderbird de la Mesilla and La Ventana de Mesilla, hides the story of two murders. Augustine Maurin, the French merchant who had the building built in 1863, was murdered in the rear of the store in 1866. He is thought to have been killed for the money he had hidden in the back of the store.

The administrator of Maurin's estate, Pedro Duhalde, acquired the building in 1869. He, too, reportedly was murdered in the rear of the store.

This building is not only noteworthy because of the murders, but it also was the first brick structure built from native brick.

The rest of the block on the west side of the plaza also is of note. The JOSEPH REYNOLDS and J. Edgar Griggs store, as well as the Barela/REYNOLDS property, was built in the 1850s on that block.

San Albino Church has been the northern anchor of the plaza since the 1860s, although the appearance has changed over the years. Monsignor Jean Grange, a French priest known as Father Juan, ordered the brick building constructed and dedicated in 1906.

Grange also owned the western block of the plaza, after CHARLES REYNOLDS, JOSEPH REYNOLDS' son, declared bankruptcy in 1913. He used the property as a rectory and conducted catechism classes there.

The southern end of the plaza is now a restaurant, cantina and clothing store. It was known as the transportation block because of the San Antonio Mail offices it housed in 1857, and for the Butterfield Overland Mail and Stage Coach line from 1858 to 1861.

After the Civil War, the Butterfield Stage station was in what is now La Posta restaurant.

Buildings off the plaza also are of historical note. The REYNOLDS/Chavez/Fountain home on Calle de Picacho, now vacant, was built in the 1860s by JOSEPH REYNOLDS, and later passed to Demetrio Chavez, another important Mesilla businessman. Chavez passed it onto his daughter, Maria, who married Albert Fountain, a great-grandson of Col. Albert Jennings Fountain.

A walk through Mesilla can be a pleasant experience simply browsing through the shops. Store hours vary, but most shops are closed Mondays. But noting the buildings

and their histories brings an added dimension. A good resource for learning about Mesilla's history is "The Las Cruces Historic Buildings Survey," available at the Thomas Branigan Memorial Library in Las Cruces.

ABRAHAM REYNOLDS B. 3-20-1768, D. 11-3-1848, M. 1796 MARY LEAZER, d/o John Leazer (LeSeur-French) and Barbara Lobingier (d/o Christopher Lobingier who served in the Rev War and his wife Elizabeth Muller (German)). Mary Leazer, died 9-17-1813, three days after her daughter Barbara was born. In the 1880 census three of Abraham's children said he was born in MD. He and Mary were married in Rowan Co NC. Tillman states that the first two children, John and Catherine were born in Rowan Co NC. Abraham Reynolds received 7 land grants from the state of NC, totaling 1,525 acres - on Bent Creek in Buncombe Co NC. The first deed in 1800 went from his own corner - So he may have gotten land prior to 1800 when Buncombe Co was Burke or Rutherford Co. His land on Bent Creek 4 miles from the French Broad River. Quite a few pioneer families obtained land grants for homesteads on Bent Creek. They built log houses and a log church, school, etc. In 1900 George Vanderbilt bought land from the Abraham Reynolds heirs, as well as other homesteads and wiped out a thriving little community of homes, farms, churches, schools, cemeteries, etc. He wanted to make it like the hunting parks in England. later Mrs. Vanderbilt sold the Bent Creek land to the National Park. The Vanderbilt deed was signed by many of Abraham Reynolds' heirs (92 names). Abraham Reynolds and Mary Leazer Reynolds are buried in a little church cemetery near his farm at Bent Creek.

Page 309, No. 539, The Abraham Reynolds Family: Abraham Reynolds, of English descent, was born March 20, 1768 in Maryland, but the family moved on to Rowan Co. NC where he met and married Mary Leazer in 1796. She was the daughter of John and Barbara Lobingier Leazer, of French and German descent. Abraham Reynolds received seven land grants from the State of NC totalling 1,525 acres on Bent Creek in Buncombe Co where they lived until their deaths. There were 12 children born to this family:

JOHN REYNOLDS, born 4 Jun 1797, d 11 Apr 1876, married Mrs. Anna O'Hara, and lived in Buncombe Co. He was a minister, hotel operator and large land owner. They had four sons.

CATHERINE REYNOLDS, b 31 Oct 1798. No further record.

ABRAHAM REYNOLDS, b 1799, d 1804.

ANN REYNOLDS, b 31 Jul 1801, died 1862, married John W. McAfee. They went to GA and their family included four sons.

AARON REYNOLDS, b 20 Sep 1807, m 1st Sarah Ledford; m 2d Mary Cody. There were 10 ch in htis fam and they lived in Buncombe Co NC.

DANIEL REYNOLDS, b 10 Mar 1809, d 2 Jan 1878, m Susan Adelia Baird, and they had 12 ch. He was a merchant and large land owner in Buncombe Co.

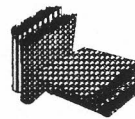

Reynolds. The family Bible of son Nash gives his father's name, but not his mother's. Some relatives believe her name was Nancy Clayton, but I have no proof.

NY, d 5 Jun 1848 Burton, Allegany (Cattaraugus) NY, will dtd 24 Apr 1848; m bef 1806 Mary ?_ (perhaps Hill) b abt 1785 Washington Co. NY, d aft 1855 when she was in 1855 Allegany (Burton) census liv with dau Mary Ann, wife of Freeman Kenyon. Family records indicate Mary's father (Hill?) b in US and her mother in Germany. Benjamin's will probated 29 May 1850 names wife Mary, ch William L., ae 42, res Olean; Elvira Thorpe, 41, res Burton; Merritt, 39, res Burton; Caroline Woodruff, 35, res Humphrey; Roina Howard, 31, res Humphrey; Mary Ann Kinyon, 28, res Burton; Ann Collister, 22, res Concord (Erie) NY; Ormus, 20, res Burton. Benjamin also appears in the 1834 Cattaraugus Co. census, res Burton.

In the 1830 Fed Cns a Benjamin Reynolds liv Springwater (Livingston) NY, with family of similar ages: 1m ae 50-60, 1m 20-30, 1m 15-20, 1m 10-15, 1m 0-5; 1fe 40-50, 1fe 15-20, 1fe 10-15, 2f 5-10, and 1 fe age 0-5. In the *History of Springwater*, by Orson Walbridge, at p60-61, Chapter VIII, "North of the Reynolds Gull, by D.B. Waite, "In about 1816 Benjamin Reynolds and his brother-in-law Hill took possession of the farm now owned by Clarke W. Stuart. From old school rolls in my possession, he must have sold in 1884 or '5 to Seth Sylvester. While Reynolds and Hill owned the place they built a grist and sawmill in the gull southwest of the house. The grist mill was a small affair, but was a great accomodatin to the neighborhood, and the sawmill was used for a long term of years...Reynolds also had a grocery where he kept the common necessities of life." Early in the book it says Reynolds lived there for many years. Benjamin and his son, Merritt are also found in Springwater post office records in 1829 and 1830. *History* also shows Benjamin and his family to be in the 1820 Ontario, Springwater Census.

Nicholas & Patty had 5 dau: Laura b 1802, Rosella b 1804 (my grandmother's - grandmother), Patty b 1807, Eunice b 1809, Emily b 1811, an unknown child, one son named Joseph Norton Reynolds,

and dau Amanda b 1821. family reported to have moved to Plainfield IL after his father died. Moved from whence? He was administrator of his father's estate. Rennolds-Reynolds Family Roster states Nicholas & Patty settled in St. Lawrence Co NY shortly after marrying. However, other info indicates 1st 5 ch prob b VT. Who were Patty's parents? Would 'Patty' have been a nickname? Could her sons have been named for a father, a brother, Joseph Norton? One report indicated the 'unknown child' was Almos H. Reynolds b 6 months bef sister Eunice. I love a mystery but this is too perplexing for my feeble mind. I have the info that Patty was b Wethersfield, but which state? VT or CT?

Their ch: Elizabeth Pauline Reynolds b 24 Jan 1871, bur Old Bethel Cem; Bateman Lee (Aunt Battie) Reynolds b 3 Apr 1872 m Samuel P.
