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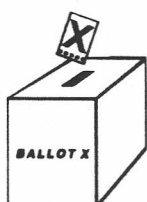

With the loss of a Board member during the year, the position may be filled on an interim basis by appointment and consensus of the remaining members of the Board, to serve for the remaining year.

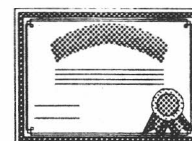
Election schedule:

HANDFASTING

From Piedmont Lineages, VA-NC Piedmont Genealogical Society, Danville VA, Vol XVII No. 2, May 1995: [In VA State Lib, Richmond VA]

Some early marriage records have "HF" or "H/F" annotated beside the names of the couple. This abbreviation stands for "Handfast."

Handfasting was a form of announcing the intention of a couple to marry without the formal blessing of a preacher. A couple would stand before a group of their peers, clasp their hands together over their heads and state their intentions. Handfasting was good for a year and a day, or until the preacher came to perform the marriage rites. Any child of handfasting was legitimate and would inherit. [Borrowed from the Paradise CA Gen. COURT APPOINTED GUARDIANS

Genealogical Helper Jan-Feb 1981:

...grandmother, Allen Tennessee Reynolds was born in AR in 1862. In 1876 (Ozark) MO, a 2d guardian was appointed for her, the former guardian removed as not qualified. I can't find any records as to why she was appointed guardians. Where should I look for these records? I can't find her living in any Reynolds household..." GH Answer: At age 14 in 1876, it was evident to the court that a 2d guardian be appointed. Minor children were often appointed guardians by the County Courts and also when they were older than a required-by-law minimum age. Poor health might have been a cause for a 2d appointed guardian.

Whenever there were guardianships within the court records, usually minor courts, be sure to search probate records for mention of parents, father and/or wife.

* **9 Sussannah² Reynolds:** Benjamin Rennolds used his sister, Sussanna Nelson, of King George Co. VA, as a witness on 22 Mar 1731 in Essex Co. VA.

* **10 Joseph² Rennolds:** There were two Joseph Rennolds in Essex and Caroline Cos. at the same time. I was unable to determine which was the son of James and Sussanna Rennolds. (The other Joseph Rennolds was the son of John and the grandson of Cornelius Reynolds.)

One James Reynolds shows up in Petsoe Parish, Gloucester Co. VA in 1675/6. It is not known where this James Reynolds came from.

There was a James Reynolds [bound] to Richard Dempster, 6 years, VA, 30 May 1662. (Bristol Registers of Servants Sent to Foreign Plantations 1654-1686, by Peter Wilson Coldham.)

One Ja. Reynolds and Tho. Reynolds are headrights of Wm Young in a 1000 acre grant to Young in Stafford Co. 6 Oct 1669.

William and Ann Reynolds of Northumberland Co. VA had a son, James, who registered his mark for cattle in 1653. Our James¹ Reynolds' first sons by each marriage named their first sons, William. It was a good possibility that William and Ann were our James¹ Rennolds' parents. After further research, James of Northumberland was found to have died Feb 1678.

From *Records of Colonial Gloucester Co. VA*, by Polly Mason we find:

p48, 1675, Adjoining lands of Mr Richard Booker (lately Mr Reynolds land).

p62, 1675/6, Mar 11, James Reynolds, Petsoe Parish, adjoining land of Walter Cant, son of David Cant deceased, formally called Knoxes land and also adjoining Thomas Dawkins, Samuel Partridge, and along Dragon Swank Runn. --H.R. Ja Clarke, Robert Dyer, Robert Carman.

p64 & 67, 1681, James Reynolds there in 1681.

p67, 1681 Augustine Warner land near James Reynolds.

p95, 1682 James Reynolds, a witness.

p96, 1685/6 Thomas Comer to James Reynolds. Comer of St John's Parish in New Kent Co assigns (2000 acres of) land to James Reynolds of Gloucester Co. Recorded (Old) Rappahannock Co 2 Feb 1685/6. Formerly bought of Mr Richard Whitehead, County of Gloucester, lying in the freshes Rappnnock Rv nere Monday (Muddy) Creek.

p100 1699/1700 9 Jan Harry Beverley and Elizabeth his wife of Middlesex Co to James Reynolds of Gloucester Co 1070 acres in Essex Co 9 Jan 1699, land formerly granted to Robert Beverley, land adjacent to Reynolds and Upshaw land.

p101 1703/4 Deed of gift, James Reynolds to James and Thomas Reynolds: "I James Reynolds and Sussanna my wife in the County of Gloucester and Parish of Petsoe doth hereby for diver considerations me and my wife here unto moving and for good will that I bear unto my two sons, give 1000 acres of land to be equally divided 500 acres for my son James where he now dwelleth and 500 acres for my

son Thomas at the other end where my quarters is now - to them and their heirs forever. In case either or both of them should die without issue lawfully begotten of their bodies then to the next heir." 10 Mar 1703/4

Essex County Court 10 Mar 1703/4: James Rennolds

Sussanna X Reynolds

(NOTE: Dragon Swamp (Great Swamp), the Plankatank River eventually becomes small and was known as Dragon Run and more especially Dragon Swamp.)

Old Rappahannock Co VA W/D Book #7, pp539-540: James Rennolds assigns over Bill of Sale to Thomas Comer, 24 Feb 1687/8. Signed James Rennolds.

Sarah Reynolds, wife of James Rennolds acknowledges her dowers right to 2000 acres, near Muddy Creek, formerly bought of Comer of New Kent, 30 Jul 1688; Records 17 8bers 1688.

Witnesses: W. Waller

NOTE: Muddy Creek is on north side of the Rappahannock River and is part of the western boundary of King George Co VA.

James Rennolds, Jr is of age to sign as witness in 1688.

Sarah Rennolds, 1st wife of James Rennolds, Sr probably died between 1688 and 1695.

1704 Rent Rolls: James Reynolds, Gloucester Co., Petsoe Parish, 200 acres. NOTE: Apparently when James and Sussannah Rennolds gave his sons, James and Thomas, the 1000 acres he retained this 200 acres. The Gloucester Co., Petsoe Parish Vestry Books lists James Rannalds there on 13 Apr 1709 and 1 Jan 1712.

Essex Co. VA 1704 Rent Rolls: James Reynolds, Essex Co., 500 plus acres. NOTE: This may be 1000 acres for James R. Sr. or 500 acres for James R. Sr and 500 acres for James R. Jr.

Essex Co VA: James Reynolds sells cow to Henry Dower 9 July 1677. (Must have been recorded after the fact.)

Essex Co. VA Book 4, p58: In his will 8 Feb 1723/4, James Rennolds Sr left his wife 1/3 of his estate; son James Jr 1/2 of 500 acres; son Benjamin and grandson William Rennolds the other half; daughters Violetta Rennolds, Hannah Rennolds and Susanna Rennolds 2 negros each; son Joseph land in Gloster; daughter Elizabeth Banes one gold ring she having her part before; godson Andrew Rennolds 1 negro at age 21; sons, James, Benjamin and Joseph also received negros; son Benjamin also got "that land up at my negro Quarters where Jane and Lt Coll dwelleth"; and all his other movables to be equally divided among three girls and two boys; sons James and Benjamin to be sole Executors.

NOTE: The way his will is written it is clear that his

children of his marriage to Sussannah were Benjamin, Violetta, Hannah, Susanna and Joseph; they were probably born in the order shown. At the time of the writing of his will Benjamin at least had son William; Violetta, Hannah and Susanna were not married; and Joseph was under age of 21.

NOTE: Was the Divident of land 500 acres or was half the Divident 500 acres? At any rate at that time (Feb 1723/4) son James Jr was living on his part.

NOTE: Son Thomas died in 1712 and apparently daughter Sarah had died before 1723 or else he considered she had already received her part.

NOTE: Who was godson Andrew Rennolds? One of the witnesses of James Rennolds' will was a William Rennolds. Could he have been the father of Andrew Rennolds? If so, then who was this William Rennolds?

James Reynolds used "Rennolds" as the spelling of his name as early as 1687. It appears that around 1703 James Rennolds Sr quit using the "Reynolds" spelling and from then on used Rennolds. All of his descendants used "Rennolds" and those who remained in Essex Co. VA still do so today. Those family members that departed Essex Co., in general, went back to "Reynolds" around 1800.

Tillman calls this James Rennolds, William Reynolds, son of Thomas Reynolds of Isle of Wight Co. VA. Tillman also has William Reynolds' children mixed up between at least two different families. This James Rennolds appears to have no relationship with Thomas Reynolds of Isle of Wight.

Tillman did not include any of the children of James Rennolds and his second wife Sussanna in either of his books, unless possibly placed in the wrong family.

Sussannah (?) married James Rennolds Sr probably between 1695 and 1698. It is not known who she was or where she was from or if she had been married before. She most likely was from either Gloucester or Essex Cos. She and her husband moved to Essex Co. abt 1703. In his will (1723/4) James Rennolds Sr gave his wife her dower 1/3 "according to law and the best of draws." Sussannah Rennolds remarried to a __ Holland. In Essex Co., 20 Sep 1737, Benjamin Rennolds and Sarah his wife and Sussanna Holland his mother of Caroline Co. sold 230 acres to James Rennolds Jr. This may have been Sussanna Holland's dower land from her previous husband, James Rennolds Sr. Sussanna Holland was probably with her son Benjamin Rennolds at this time. I saw no evidence that she or her husband (Holland) died.

[Ed. Note: Old Rappahannock County VA was abolished in 1692 when Essex Co. was formed. Gloucester Co. was created in 1651 from York Co.]

SECOND GENERATION

2 JAMES² RENNOLDS (James¹) was apparently of age to sign as witness to a deed in 1688.

Records of Colonial Gloucester Co. VA, Vol. II, by Polly Mason:

p101 1703: James and sarah Reynolds witnesses.

p102-11 Mar 1705/6: James Rennolds, Jr., a witness, Essex Co.

p105 1719: Wm Brookings of Parish of Petsoe in County of Gloucester and Sussanna his wife sold to James Rennolds of Parish of South Farnham Co. of Essex that part of 920 acres in Essex on Occupace Run, 10 Apr 1719 (230 acres).

NOTE: Was the buyer James Rennolds Sr or James Rennolds Jr? Benjamin Rennolds and Sussanna (Rennolds) Holland, widow of James Rennolds Sr, was in possession of this land and sold it to James Rennolds (III) on 19 Sep 1737.

Essex Co. VA Records:

7 Aug 1703: James and Sarah Reynolds, Witnesses.

18 Jun 1716: James Rennolds Jr, South Farnham Parish from Leonard Tarrant, 460 acres, part of tract granted to Wm Smith by Patten dtd 26 Apr 1712; larger tract divided between Thomas Hipkins, Wm Brookings and James Rennolds.

15 Sep 1719: James Reynolds Jr, Church Warden, South Farnham Parish.

16 Sep 1743: James Rennolds Jr, St. Ann Parish, on one Part to James Rennolds Sr of South Farnham Parish on the other Part, Plantation in St Ann's, 500, That which James Jr bought of Edwin Conway on 30 Aug 1743 for 600 acres. Witnessed by W. Rennolds. Catherine the wife of James Rennolds Jr examined.

Caroline County VA, by Campbell:

Ca 1634, Negros, Sarah Rennolds, 1 ea; James Rennolds 2 ea. NOTE: Are this James and Sarah Rennolds the same persons as the above?

Essex County VA Records:

15 Oct 1751, Will Book 9, p89: James Rennolds' will.

To son William, plantation where he now dwells (devised by Capt. Wood to him). NOTE: Who is Capt. Wood? Could he be John Gatewood?

To son James, plantation where he now dwells.

To son John, right to land in Culpeper Co

To son Robert, plantation and tract of land I bought of my son James which was Col Edwin Conway's.

After wife's dec', son William to have the choice of plantation where I now live and that where he now lives; that which he not chuse shall be sold--half of sale to go to my [sic] two daughters and half to his [sic] four sons.

If either son should dye without heirs then their lands to

go to the surviving brothers; reserving Dower's rights for widow hereby given.

Son Robert, Negrows Bille and George.

Son James, Negrow Sue but not her child Sue.

Son William, Negrow Sambow and 2/3 of what Geo. and Will Sawyer earned after my decease if one should die the other to be have(?) by son Williams.

Dau Elizabeth, Negrow Day, and a girl Suke and Sue Befries(?) child.

Dau Mary, Negrow Sarah and Lidesy and a boy George.

To loving wife All the rest of my Negrows, old and young, and personnal estate for life (or a child's part if she remarries); except 30 lbs to each dau when they marry.

To son John, all of estate in Culpeper.

To son Robert, Has rec'd personnal estate about 20 lbs; must account for.

To sons William and James, Must account for 30 lbs each after my wife's decease when my estate is to be equally divided.

Appoints Loving Wife and son William and son James his Executors; 20 Oct 1750. Signed James Reynolds. Sarah, William and James Rennolds, Simon Miller and Francis Waring bonded. Sarah made her mark and her sons signed the document.

Book 9, p132, James Rennolds, Jr Inventory.

Wife Sarah and sons William and James Rennolds are Executors, 21 Jan 1752.

Book 12, p596, Sarah Rennolds Will, 23 Aug 1774.

To dau Mary Sale, 1/2 of Estate.

To sons John and Robert Rennolds, each 1/4 of Estate.

Executors: John and Robert Rennolds, and son-in-law Leonard Sales.

NOTE: Tillman has many errors in this James Rennolds family. See T2-5904 thru T2-5930.

3 SARAH² RENNOLDS (James¹). Found no evidence that she married, so assume she died between 1712 and 1723 without heirs.

4 THOMAS² RENNOLDS (James¹). See also Father's section, above.

Gloucester Co. VA 1698: Thomas Reynolds a witness.

Essex Co. VA 7 Apr 1707: Thomas Rennolds' land adjoins John Parker.

26 Oct 1707: Thomas Reynolds, Agt, Edmund Tilly, debt.

25 Sep 1712: Thomas Rennolds Will: He gives items to Brother James and Sisters Sarah and Elizabeth.

NOTE: From his will one would assume that Thomas Rennolds: 1) probably was not married, 2) had no children, or 3) was a child of the marriage of James and Sarah Rennolds and that James, Sarah and Elizabeth were the only

living brother and sisters of that marriage.

5 ELIZABETH² RENNOLDS (James¹). Apparently Elizabeth Rennolds, the dau of James Rennolds Sr, married Banes, but could find no evidence of any Banes in Essex Co. VA.

6 BENJAMIN² RENNOLDS (James¹ and Sussanna) born abt 1698 VA, m abt 1720 VA to Sarah (?), d 742/1743 Caroline Co. VA.

James Rennolds, Jr and Benjamin Rennolds were co-executors of James Rennolds Sr's will.

Essex Co. Order Book 1725-29, p256: James Rennolds and Benjamin Rennolds on jury duty 22 Aug 1728.

NOTE: This may be the last official action by Benjamin as a resident of Essex Co. Caroline Co. VA was formed in 1727; in 1729 Benjamin was Deputy Sheriff of Caroline Co. However, Benjamin did have court dealings in Essex Co. after this time.

Essex Co. Order Book 1731, p222: Benjamin Rennolds agt Abner gray, 22 Mar 1731.

Essex Co. Order Book 1731, p224. In Chancery, Benjamin Rennolds agt James Rennolds (Jr), both executors of James Rennolds (Sr) deceased; Benjamin awarded 6 lbs money, being Benjamin's proportionable part of the balance of the personnal estate of the said James Rennolds (Sr) deceased, 22 Mar 1731. Benjamin to pay Hannah PICKETT and Susanna NELSON for being witnesses; both from King George Co. and used Johnson's Ferry. (Hannah Pickett and Susanna Nelson were sisters of Benjamin.)

Essex Co. Deeds, 19 Sep 1737: Benjamin Rennolds and Sarah his wife, Sussanna Holland his mother, of Caroline on one part and James Rennolds Junr (carpenter) of the Parish of St. Anne, Essex (on the other part), part of patent granted to Leonard Tarent, 920 acres, 8 May 1716; tract contains 230 acres, the division line between Benjamin Rennolds & Cordelia Hipkins. 20 Sep 1737: Also says Benjamin Rennolds is of Caroline Co.

NOTE: Sussanna Holland, was the widow of James Rennolds Sr; it is possible that Mr. Holland had died by this time. I could not determine if or why Benjamin and his mother, Sussanna owned this property jointly.

Essex Co. Order Book 1736-1738, p240, 21 March 1738: James Rennolds agt Benjamin Rennolds for trespass; case decided for the defendant. James R. got nothing.

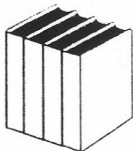

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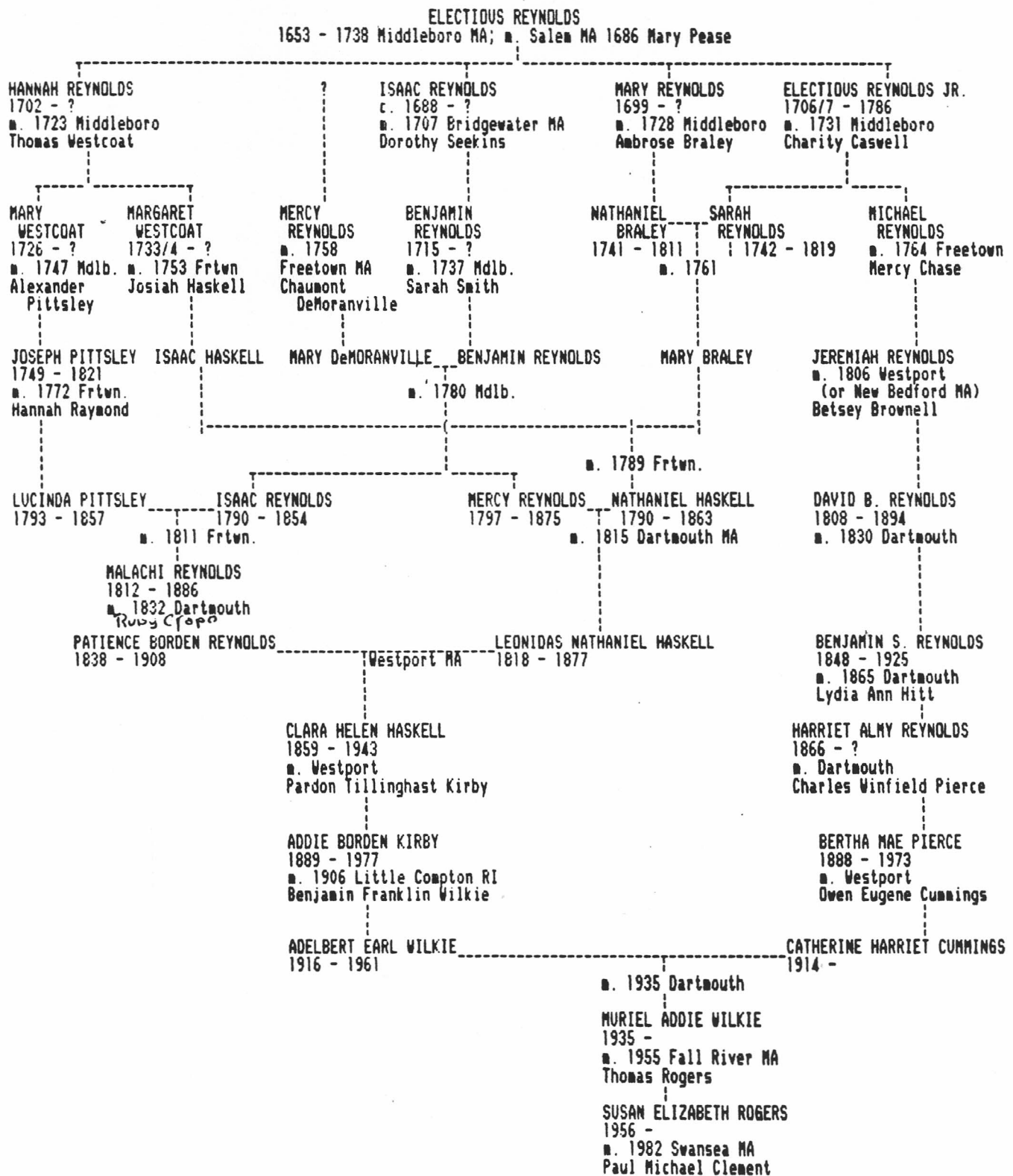
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
