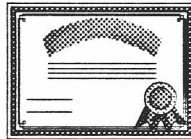
STATE AND/OR COUNTY REPS

Reynolds**

Page 447, Item 588. Hamilton (Hambleton) Reynolds and his wife Sarah lived for nearly 30 years in Hillsborough (St Lawrence Dist.), Caswell Co, from 1777 until 1805. Their children, reared there, were: Elijah married Judith Malone; Nancy; George married Lucy, [maiden] name unknown; Elizabeth married Richard Eskridge, son of Richard and Elizabeth Read Eskridge; Eunice married Jesse Evans Sr; Thomas married Phebe Harrill; John married Catherine Magness; and Jesse married Frances Willis, daughter of Peter and Frances Tate Willis.

Hamilton Reynolds was born about 1745 and about 1767 he and his Sarah were married. Her maiden name is unknown. The young couple established their home before 1777 in Caswell Co, on their land on both sides of Cobbs Creek. He received a land grant for this land, signed by George Lea and Elijah Reynolds as Sureties. His land bordered that of William Johnson, Thomas Nealey, Samuel Johnston, Thomas Douglass, and David Vanhook. The Reynolds' were active members of the Baptist church.

Hamilton Reynolds may have been related to Sarah Runnels, daughter of Mary Lea, but no relationship has been proved. Mary Lea named her daughter Sarah Runnels and son George Lea in her Caswell Co will in 1784. Executors were James Lea and her son George Lea, and witnesses were Richard Eskridge, James Lea, George Lea, and Walter Brown. The Widow Lea's land in 1783 adjourned that of Richard Eskridge on Cobbs Creek.

He was kin or close friend of Henry Dixon, whose will he witnessed in 1778 in Caswell Co, along with N. Dickerson and Sarah Sartain. Executors were wife Martha Dixon, her brother Thomas Wynne, and Charles Dixon, and land adjoining the province line in Pittsylvania Co VA, was mentioned in the will.

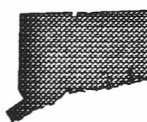
After 1792, when St. Laurence Dist became part of Person Co, Hamilton Reynolds appeared on Person Co tax lists even though he had not moved. This area began at the VA line and included the land of Thomas Burgess, Widow Allen, John Moore, Widow Lea, William Johnston, Hamilton Reynolds, Thomas Douglass, Esq, Frederick Brock, Thomas McNeill, Lawrence Vanhook, Dr Payn, Ambrose Long, Benjamin Long, Hugh Barnett, Ezekiel

Harrelson, and John Smith. These neighbors and other related names appeared on the 1792 ledger of John McNeill's store near Leesburg and the Caswell-Person Co border. In 1802 Hamilton Reynolds was one of the buyers at the estate sale of Thomas Evans in Caswell Co, and in 1803 he was again on the Caswell Co tax list.

In 1805 Hamilton and Sarah Reynolds, their sons, and their daughters Elizabeth and husband Richard Eskridge and Eunice and husband Jesse Evans Sr, moved to Rutherford Co, along with others of the Evans and Eskridge families. Soon after moving, Hamilton Reynolds, his family, and his Negro Julian joined by letter the Sandy Run Baptist Church at Mooresboro, Rutherford Co. His son Elijah Reynolds served in the War of 1812 in the NC militia.

Less than 10 years after leaving Caswell Co, both Hamilton Reynolds and his wife Sarah died in 1814 in Rutherford Co. After their parents deaths, sons Elijah and Jesse Reynolds and Jesse's father-in-law Peter Willis, together with their families, migrated to Franklin Co TN. There, they settled and prospered. Jesse Reynolds' land was in the part of Franklin Co that in 1836 became part of Coffee Co TN. His home was at Hillsboro TN, named for Hillsborough NC. These men and their wives brought with them a heritage of high standards for an educated, cultured, and Christian society. They were a credit to their Caswell Co roots in their distinguished services to state and country, and they contributed greatly to the development of that area of Middle TN. Today their descendants are substantial citizens living mostly in the southern states.

West Virginia by Sybil R. Taylor

When VA seceded from the Union, in 1861 50 counties seceded from VA; in 1863 those counties became the State of West VA by an Act of Congress.

Some of the WV counties were created long before WV was organized: Brooke, 1744; Pendleton, 1747; Randolph 1753; Monroe, 1760; Monongalia 1767; Greenbrier and Ohio, 1769; Harrison, Marion & Preston 1774; Kanawha, 1773; Mason and Tucker, 1774; Cabell and Mercer, 1775; Hancock, 1776; Marshall 1777, Barbour and Wetzel, 1780; Jackson and Wirt, 1796; Wood, 1797; Boone, 1798; Lincoln, 1799; Putnam and Roan, 1800.

Although most state records were destroyed in a 1921 fire, most counties have records from 1853. Some counties also have marriage records from 1870.

If records cannot be located in WV, examine records in VA State Archives & Library in Richmond, or the parent

county. Some present VA counties were parents for some WV counties, e.g.: Berkeley in 1772 from Frederick VA; Hampshire 1753 from Frederick VA; Greenbrier 1777 from Montgomery VA; Kanawha 1788 from Greenbrier (now WV) & Montgomery VA; McDowell 1858 from Tazewell VA; Mercer 1837 from Giles & Tazewell VA; Monongalia 1776 from Augusta District; Ohio 1776 from Augusta District; Pendleton 1787 from Augusta, Hardy, Rockingham and Bath VA; and Pocahontas 1821 from Pendleton, Randolph and Bath VA.

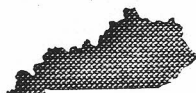

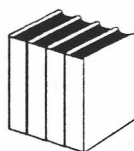
