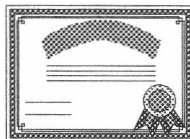

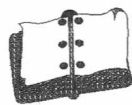

Will Book B, Page 173, Will Book B, Bibb Co. GA 1812-1855, page 173, by Willard Rocker:

Reynolds, Olmstead. May 14, 1855. Sep. Term 1855:

...of sound and disposing mind and memory though weak in body...Request my remains be buried in Laurel Grove cemetery in city of Savannah--that a plain substantial iron railing shall inclose the lot--that a granite obelisk [sic] be erected over my grave. My lot of land in East Hartford CT containing about 5 acres on which my Aunt Mary **Reynolds** now lives to go to said Aunt. The same unto my brother Daniel [**Reynolds**] of Springfield MA, my brother Henry W. [**Reynolds**] of New Orleans and my sister Charlotte (**Reynolds**) [**Veader**] widow of the late David **Veader**. Also to Aunt Mary **Reynolds**, \$100 annually during her life. To Daniel **Reynolds**, the sum of \$3000 for benefit of my brother James [**Reynolds**] as follows. Said sum to be securely invested in some safe stock and interest thereto be paid to said brother James [**Reynolds**] annually proved he shall abandon forever the society or community to which he has united himself in Oneida County, New York, and also provided he does not unite with any similar society. To friend Richard **Cuyler** as token of my esteem, whatever may remain of my wines & liquors, my Statuette of Danl **Webster**, sum \$500 in trust for benefit of his grandchild Richard Cuyler **Churchill**. To friend William W. **Wadley** \$500 in trust for his youngest child Loving **Wadley**. Should my deceased hour [sic] before my young friend Charles [**Olmstead**] son of late Jonathan **Olmstead** shall have completed his course of Education at Georgia Military Institute, I direct that his tuition and expenses at the Institute be paid out of my estate. Also to said Charles H. **Olmstead**, all books relating to Profession of Engineering and kindred subjects. To my two slaves, Billy & Jerry, their freedom provided they leave State of Georgia and go to some State or Country where the law [sic] allow their residing in freedom. Remainder of my estate as follows--1/3 to Daniel **Reynolds**, 1/3 to brother Henry W. **Reynolds**, 1/3 to sister Charlotte [**Reynolds**] widow of the late David **Veader**. Executors: friend Wm. M. **Wadley** of Savannah and my brother Daniel **Reynolds** of Springfield MA. Wit: John F. **Boifeuillet**, W.S. **Brantley**, C. **Hanse**, Geo. W. **Reynolds**, (p.58).

**Emus Get a Taste of Being Free As Birds**

Swansea [MA]--A quiet summer morning on Inverness Road turned into a spectator event yesterday thanks to a 6-foot-tall emu wandering around the neighborhood. The emu, which looks like an ostrich, was one of two big birds that escaped from their fenced-in pen at Tom **Reynolds'** farm at 400 Cedar Ave.

At 6:30 a.m., Swansea police received a call from the Cyr family at 734 Wilbur Ave., at the corner of Inverness Road, reporting that a feathery friend was hanging out in their backyard.



Police arrived to find the emu strutting around the premises. Thanks to a fence, a row of shrubs and the Cyrs' black Labrador retriever, Maggie, police managed to corner the bird on the property until 10 a.m. when help arrived.

Damase **Giguere**, of Westport, who raises emus, flamingos, camels, kangaroos and other animals on a farm there, and his assistant brought a tranquilizer gun to shoot the emu.

But it wasn't in the mood for a nap.

"They shot him a second time and he didn't get sleepy that time either," said Police Chief Raymond **Jacome**. "We ended up getting a net and pouncing on him."

There was a good reason for caution, **Reynolds** said--the bird's powerful kick.

"They can tear your stomach up with just one blow," said **Reynolds**, adding it was the first time any of his emus got loose.

After the first bird was caught, tied and loaded onto a truck, the second emu was found in a field behind Reynolds's farm and netted. **Jacome** said police put handcuffs on its legs to keep it from kicking.

By 11:30 a.m., **Jacome** said, both birds were safely back in their pen. [By Christian D. Berg, Providence RI *Journal Bulletin*, Wed., 24 Jul 1996.]

Family Group Update

Samuel S. Reynolds, Sr.

Research up to the present time does not reflect origins of Samuel S. **Reynolds, Sr.** or his wife Catherine. They first show up in Monmouth Co., NJ, where he was involved in numerous land transactions, many of them involving other men with the Reynolds surname, some of whom must be close relatives, possibly sons, brothers, nephews, etc., but this has not been firmly established. The only known

relative was his son Samuel S. **Reynolds, Jr.**

Samuel S. **Reynolds, Sr.**, born after 1748, died intestate early in 1815. His wife Catherine and a friend, Samuel S. **Forman**, were named as Co-Administrators. After Forman's death, Catherine continued as Administratrix, even after her marriage to Joseph **Fowler** in 1820. Probate records showing final settlement of the estate have not been located. If found, these could, no doubt, name any other heirs which he may have had. Continuing efforts are being made to locate such records.

Samuel S. **Reynolds, Jr.**, born 18 Sep 1776, of Freehold Twp., Monmouth Co., NJ, married Deborah **Jeffrey**, born 14 Feb 1782, of Dover Twp. (now in Ocean Co.) on 14 Nov 1799 in Dover Twp. Published marriage records do not show that this Samuel was Jr., however, the official Monmouth Co. Marriage Record does reflect this. Samuel and Deborah had a large family, all born in Monmouth Co., as follows:

In 1821, young Samuel, born 1802, accompanied a William S. **Brown** and some others from Monmouth Co., NJ in a wagon train to the "far west." They stopped in Wayne Co., IN, and Samuel stayed there. Apparently, Samuel persuaded his parents, his siblings (except for Elizabeth), and their growing families to also migrate to Wayne Co., which they did in the 1830s. They remained in Wayne County the rest of their lives.

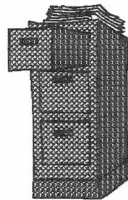

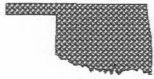
