Dorothy Congdon Jellinghaus, Dean of RFA members, died 1 Dec 1997 in Richmond MI. Dorothy was born 20 Jul 1904 in Philadelphia PA, a descendant of James Reynolds of North Kingston RI. From 1934 until the mid-1980s Dorothy was the Reynolds Family Association, holding it together until its reorganization in 1977, serving later as Secretary and finally as Archivist and Historian. A memorial service was held 5 Dec 1997 in Richmond MI; committal services will be in Wilmington DE in late spring 1998. Dorothy was the mother of RFA member Sandra Jellinghaus **McClellan** of Richmond MI.

Lydia B. Malone, 101, of Christiana PA, died Wednesday, 24 Dec 1998 of heart failure at Harrison House Healthcare Facility. She was buried at Oxford Cemetery, Oxford PA.

Nominations For 1999 RFA Officers

Each officer is elected for a term of one year, to serve until a successor is elected.

All officers begin terms on 1 January to serve for the calendar year. Outgoing officers serve in a non-voting capacity during Nov-Dec of each year. All positions are voluntary, as no officer of RFA receives salary or travel expenses related to attendance at the annual meeting (reunion).

Members may nominate themselves or others for any one of the elected positions of:

President - Serves as chief executive officer of corporation; has general supervision of the affairs of the corporation, as well as other officers of the corporation; when present, presides at all meetings of the Board and the membership meetings; performs all other duties incident to his office or properly required of him by the Board of Directors.

Vice President - in the absence of the president, performs the duties of the president, performs such

other duties as the Board of Directors shall prescribe.

Executive Secretary - issues all authorized notices for, and keeps minutes of, all meetings of the members and the Board of Directors; and has charge of the corporate books.

Treasurer - manages receipts for a tax exempt corporation, involving entering membership and donation payments in the membership ledger; preparing bank deposits as needed, verifying and paying corporation bills, reporting bank account balances at conference call meetings and the annual meeting, preparing annual financial statements, including IRS and State of Delaware tax filings; and arranges for an audit of the financial records at each annual reunion.

All nominations must include a short biography of the nominee, and indication that the nominee has agreed to serve if elected. Present officers are identified on the back cover (mail label side) of this issue of *Recollections*.

Joint Effort to Sort Families The Cornelius Reynolds Line of VA by William L. King, Montross VA

Prior to researching my mother's Reynolds' family I found that no one had previously documented this line. There was some minor information in **Tillman's** books; for the most part his information was either incorrect or misleading. After completing my research I have since found other RFA members that have the same family line. Some of these members are: **Betty Ellis Cole**, **Debra M. Lyddon**, **Ron Brown**, **Emma-Jo Davis**, **Robert Shippy** and **Margaret Staymates**. Others that may have the same line are **Sandra M. Boucher** and **Cindy Thomas**.

There is another large Reynolds family line that has never been documented. This family generally is from the middle part of Virginia. **Tillman** has some of the individuals in this line in his books, but basically they have incorrect data or are placed in the wrong places, e.g, family, generations, times.

The first person of this line is one **Cornelius Reynolds**. I can find no one earlier than he in this family line in the VA Colony.

Cornelius Reynolds was granted 640 acres in New Kent Co. VA on 5 Jun 1664; his transports included family members: **Cornelius Reynolds**, **Margaret Reynolds**, **Wm Reynolds**, **Ann Reynolds**, **Cornelius Reynolds** and **Susan Reynolds**.

By 1667 he was in Gloucester Co VA and shortly thereafter he was in Old Rappahannock Co VA (now Essex Co). **Cornelius Reynolds** died in Essex Co Nov 1685; wife **Margery Reynolds** and his sons **William** and **John Reynolds** were to receive his plantation. Son **William Reynolds** died in Richmond Co ca 1700, with children: **Cornelius**, **John**, **William** and **Elizabeth Reynolds**.

Cornelius' son **John Reynolds** died in Essex Co 4 Nov 1716 and names his three eldest sons: **John**, **Joseph**, and **Thomas Reynolds**, and his youngest sons (underage): **Richard** and **Cornelius Reynolds**. Descendants of these individuals generally moved westward in VA through **Caroline**, **Spottsylvania**, **Orange** and **Culpeper Counties**.

I believe that RFA members sharing this **Cornelius Reynolds** family line include: **John F. Roach**, **Joseph B. Reynolds** and **Evelyn Johnson**; and probably **Sandra M. Boucher**, **Sharon Hohimer** and **Cindy Thomas**.

I would like to extend a challenge to the above RFA members to research, either individually or jointly, to document this family line.

May 1780: A deed of gift from Elizabeth **Beazley** to Benjamin **Beazley** proved by the oaths of Thos. and Benjamin **Reynolds** & ordered to be recorded. The same to Augustine **Beazley** proved as aforesaid & ordered to be recorded.

Caroline County VA Court Records:

10 Feb Court 1780.

On proof being made to the court that Benjamin **Rennolds** served as a soldier till properly discharged in 1760 in a Regiment raised for the immediate defence of this state not being militia, and that he had never received his bounty of land under the King of Great Brittain's proclamation. Ordered that the same be certified to the Register of land office.

Appointed to divided that part of the estate of James **Rennolds** dec'd devised to Benjamin **Rennolds**, Thomas **Rennolds**, William **Reynolds** and the children of John **Rennolds** dec'd agreeable to the will of said James **Rennolds** dec'd and report to the Court.

March 1780 Court.

A division of slaves belonging to estate of James **Rennolds** dec'd ret'n'd and ordered to be recorded.

Will of Mary **Rennolds** dec'd exhibited in Court for proof, but it appearing from testimony of sundry witnesses that said Mary **Rennolds** was an idiot and not capable of making any will, the same is rejected.

April 1780 Court.

Benjamin **Rennolds**, Thomas **Rennolds**, William **Rennolds**, and Robert **Rennolds**, Jacob **Rennolds**,

Bernard **Rennolds** & Lucy **Rennolds**, Children of John **Rennolds** dec'd by William **Rennolds** their guardian, complt against Elizabeth **Rennolds** widow of James **Rennolds**, decd. Defendant Dismissed agreed.

Reuben and Martha Ann (Adams) Reynolds of KY From Jay Kimmel, Endicott NY

Reuben **Reynolds** was born abt 1815 in KY. (Marriage bonds of daughters variously state Breckenridge Co KY, Jefferson Co KY, or Washington KY either city or Co. He gave his age as 35 at the time of 1850 census. Reuben's parents are not known. (Family accounts say Reuben's father was a tobacco farmer in VA and later a tobacco farmer in KY, who bought land with script issued for service in Washington's army, -- dates suggest the soldier might be Reuben's grandfather, not father. Family accounts also say the **Reynolds** family came to CT in colonial times from Ipswich (Suffolk) ENG.

Reuben first appears on the Breckinridge Co KY tax rolls in 1838. In 1839 he was living and working on a farm belonging to David R. **Murray**. Reuben was a farmer (according to both the 1840 and 1850 censuses) in Breckenridge Co KY. The marriage bond of his 1st dau Julia to Albert **Leichhardt** in 1863, issued in Breckinridge Co, states the marriage was held at Reuben **Reynolds'** home. But whether Reuben owned

property at the time of the wedding is not known. A deed shows Reuben **Reynolds** purchased land in Breckinridge Co near the town of Cloverport, on 18 Jan 1866. This property was located between Town Creek & Bull Creek, both of which enter the OH river about 4 miles upstream from Cloverport. Family accounts say the locality was called **Reynolds Landing**. Reuben was counted in the 1850 census in Breckinridge Co.

Reuben m Martha Ann **Adams** b abt 1817 in IN, according to the 1850 census, but perhaps in NY according to the marriage bond of a dau. Martha was 33 at time of 1850 census. According to family accounts she was the dau of Peter **Adams**. Family accounts say Peter had come from MA, but this has not been verified. If Martha was the dau of the Peter **Adams** of Perry Co IN, then her mother was Nancy **Rains**. An account attributed to dau Julia claims that Martha often rowed back and forth across the OH River. Martha was counted in the 1880 census of Breckinridge Co KY.

Reuben and Martha Ann were m 26 Oct 1837 in Perry Co IN (license issued 23 Oct). From the information about place of birth of children from 1850 and 1860 censuses, it would appear that they lived first in KY, then in IN from abt 1840 till about 1845 and then in KY again. Their ch:

Reynolds, Mary and Betsy (**Reynolds**) **Fletcher** vs Catherine Volinda and John Armistead **Reynolds**, Mary **Reynolds**, widow of John **Reynolds**, and Betsey **Fletcher** formerly Betsey **Reynolds** stated that in 1814 John **Reynolds** died intestate leaving a widow and ch viz Betsey **Fletcher**, Catherine Volinda **Reynolds** and John Armistead **Reynolds**, the latter two still being infants today. Court orders dower share to the widow and the rest of the estate to be divided into three parts for the ch. 11 Sep 1820.

Rennolds, Warner and Elizabeth, and Wiley and Verlinda **Wright** vs Mary **Rennolds**, widow and administratrix of John **Reynolds** and John **Rennolds**, infant. Elizabeth **Rennolds** and Verlinda **Wright**, daughters of John **Rennolds**, dec'd., stated that their father died intestate about 12 years ago leaving a widow, Mary **Rennolds**, and ch viz Elizabeth **Rennolds**, Verlinda **Rennolds**, and three infants Thomas **Rennolds**, Billy (?) **Rennolds** and Eliza **Rennolds** who died soon after their father and John **Rennolds**, an infant who survives. 15 Nov 1826.

Preponderance of Evidence Gen. Soc. of Northern Neck of VA from William L. King

In the past, the preponderance of evidence has been used by genealogists to describe cases in which there is no direct evidence but when the weight of the indirect evidence (following an exhaustive search) is sufficient to prove the case. There are those who have held that a true preponderance of evidence case must include the refutation of negative evidence. In addition in the genealogical world, the preponderance must weigh heavily in favor of the argument, a 51% to 49% weight, although sufficient under the law, is not considered sufficient by the genealogical community. Because these differing standards and definitions have at times created confusion, the Board for Certification of Genealogists, which tests and certifies researchers, has announced that it will no longer use the phrase "preponderance of evidence" to describe how genealogists analyze and weigh evidence. The Board is revising its description of its certification requirements to reflect this change. The requirement will be reworded to describe specifically how applicants are to show their ability to handle complex evidence problems.

These rules also apply to family histories written by other than certified genealogists.

Remembering always that they are engaged in a quest for truth, family history researchers consistently—

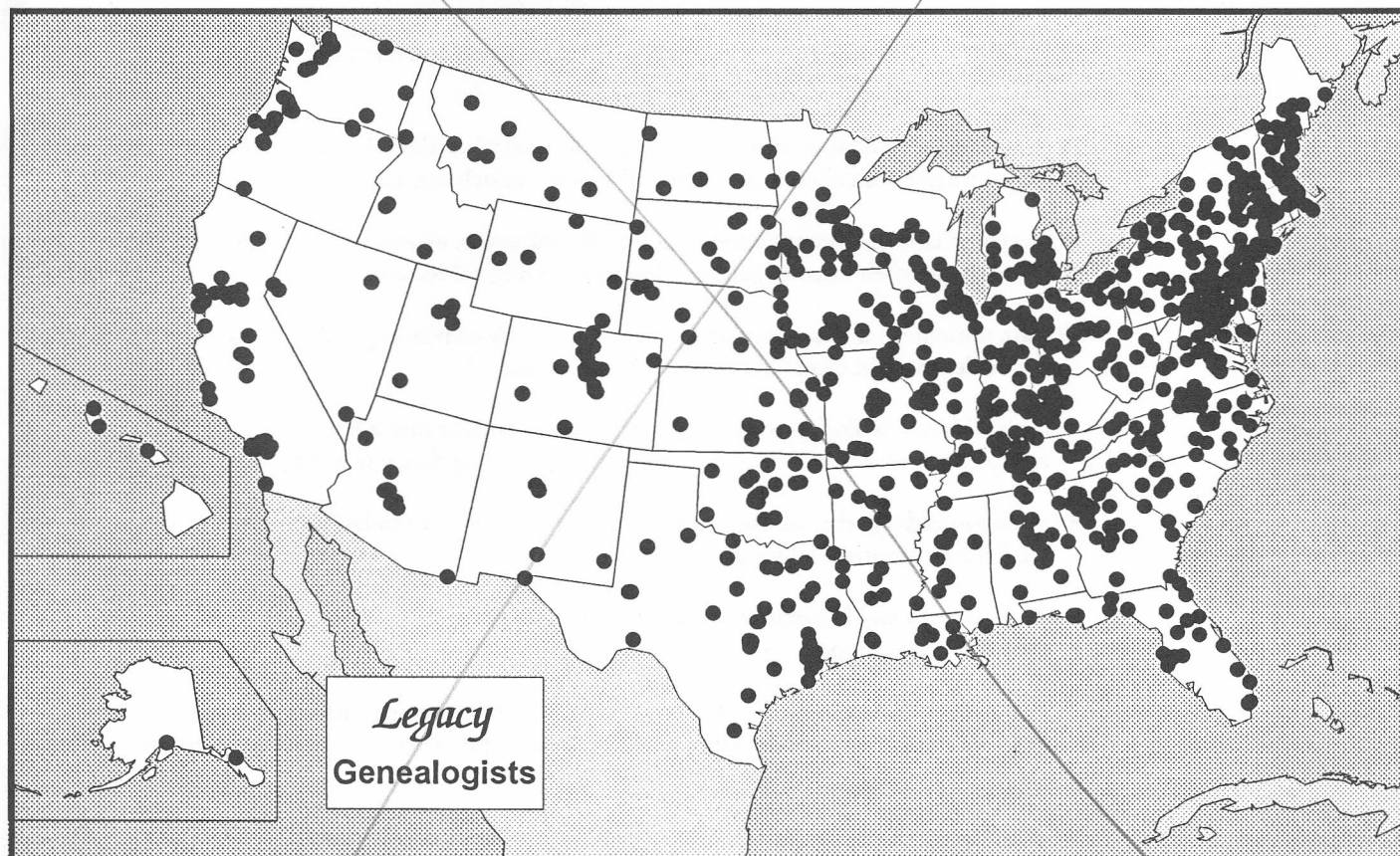
- ◆ record the source for each item of information they collect.
- ◆ test every hypothesis or theory against credible evidence, and reject those that are not supported by the evidence.
- ◆ seek original records, or reproduced images of them when there is reasonable assurance they have not been altered, as the basis for their research conclusions.
- ◆ use compilations, communications and published works, whether paper or electronic, primarily for their value as guides to locating the original records.
- ◆ state something as a fact only when it is supported by convincing evidence, and identify the evidence when communicating the fact to others.
- ◆ limit with words like "probable" or "possible" any statement that is based on less than convincing evidence, and state the reasons for concluding that it is probable or possible.
- ◆ avoid misleading other researchers by either intentionally or carelessly distributing or publishing inaccurate information.
- ◆ state carefully and honestly the results of their own research, and acknowledge all use of other researchers' work.
- ◆ recognize the collegial nature of genealogical research by making their work available to others through publication, or by placing copies in appropriate libraries or repositories, and by welcoming critical comment.
- ◆ consider with open minds new evidence or the comments of others on their work and the conclusions they have reached.
