Project William Sub-project of Project Tillman by William L. King

The Tillman Project is RFA's effort to collect documentation for the Tillman Books, the two Reynolds Family books published by Stephen F. Tillman, referred to by RFA as T1 (published in 1948) and T2 (published in 1949).

It seems that many of our family lines go back to an individual beyond which we cannot prove our lineage (beyond a reasonable doubt). Sometimes we have a tendency to accept someone else's research to create our family line. Having done so, we still want to find the evidence and continue to work on resolving the *Stonewall*. This effort to prove someone else's hypothesis may lead us away from our ancestor if we can't take a new look at the situation.

I notice that many times the stonewall is named *William Rennolds/Reynolds*. I would like to start, as one of our millennium efforts, Project William. Those who share these ancestors, by working together and sharing information, can resolve these problem areas.

From Tillman's 1959 book (T2), among the subjects for *Project William* and their spouses are:

- T2-5752 William Archelius **Reynolds** m ?
- T2-5908 William **Reynolds** m ?
- T2-6002 William **Reynolds** m Henrietta **Hamilton**.
- T2-6094 William **Reynolds** m Mary **Perrine**.
- T2-6295 William **Reynolds** m Elizabeth **Mossum**.
- T2-7078 William **Reynolds** m Margaret **Harris**.

The above William **Reynolds**ses represent large families with their descendants spread throughout the Southeastern, Mid-Western and Western States. A number of RFA members already claim these individuals as ancestors. They are also representative of our family stonewall problems. Each, with the possible exception of William and Elizabeth (**Mossom**) **Reynolds**, appears to have major lineage flaws and erroneous support for the claimed ascending lineages.

We need to resolve these matters and I believe we can if we work together in doing the research. If we can solve these problems and better represent and document the individual's family group sheet we will eventually identify many more descendants of these William **Reynolds**ses.

Tillman states that three and maybe four of these William **Reynolds**ses have origins in the Rappahannock River area, and two have their origins in Southside VA.

The results of my research and/or my comments on these Williams follow:

T2-5752. William Archelius Reynolds, of (5747) [Robert **Reynolds**], b 1743, m -, and settled Richmond Co VA. Issue: Bartemous b 25 Aug 1769 [T2-5753]; Abel Archelius (T2-5758); and others.

T2-5272 William Archelius **Reynolds'** lineage is not as shown by Tillman. He may eventually be shown as being of the Thomas and Susan (**Snead**) **Reynolds** line (RFA Line 29).

T2-5908 William Reynolds, of (5905) [James and Sarah **Reynolds**], b 24 Sep 1760 Caroline Co VA, and d 1832. He served with the VA State Line in the Rev War (pension application S-5982). M. -, and settled Caroline Co VA. Issue: (Andrew b 1783 [T2-5909]; Daniel b 1786 [T2-5910]; Sidney who m 12 Jan 1813 Philip **Reynolds**; William who m [1st] 23 Dec 1805 Mary **Leman** and 2d 18 Jul 1835 Frances **Beazley** and settled Louisa Co VA; Philip b 1814 who m Sarah Jane -, b 1831; Charles who m 21 Mar 1803 Dolly **Dickason**; Austin who m 12 Oct 1801 Anne **Fulcher**; Nelson w m 3 Jun 1837 Jane **Carnall**; and Cornelius b 1800 [T2-5929].

T2-5908 William **Reynolds**, as shown above by Tillman, is not the son of 5905 James and Sara Catherine (**Carber**) **Rennolds**. My guess is that he is a son of a Cornelius **Reynolds** of Caroline Co VA who died ca 1793. I cannot comment on the accuracy of the children listed for this William **Reynolds**.

T2-6002 William Reynolds, of (5672) [Robert **Reynolds**], b 10 Feb 1725 Nansemond Co VA, m Henrietta **Hamilton** and settled Anson Co NC. Issue: James b 1757 [T2-6003]; Jacob [T2-6012]; Richard; Thomas L. b 1762; William [T2-6060]; and Hamilton b 3 Oct 1761 [T2-6061].

T2-6002 is not is not the son of 5672 Robert **Reynolds** as shown by **Tillman**. Who his parents are remains to be determined.

T2-6094 William Reynolds, of (6093), d 25 Oct 1798 Richmond VA, m Mary **Perrine**. His will is filed in York Co. He served in Rev War as a Captain of Artillery (See Pension Claim R-17380). Issue: Thomas b 28 May 1776 [T2-6094.1]; Harriet who m Southey Little **Savage** of par. [T2] 6113. George Norton; Lewis; and Elizabeth [T2-6117].

T2-6094 William **Reynolds** does not descend from Thomas and Mary **Reynolds** of Isle of Wight and others as suggested by **Tillman**. Who he is and who his ancestors and earliest descendants are remains to be developed. Somewhere I have seen, maybe in pension records, that is said that 6094 William **Reynolds** enlisted in VA but was from a "Maryland line."

T2-6295 William Reynolds, of (6294) [Richard **Reynolds**], b Surry Co VA, m Elizabeth **Mossom**, b 1722, and settled Albemarle Co VA. Issue: James b 1750 [T2-6296]; Thomas b 1752 [T2-6311]; Aaron b 1 Dec 1753 [T2-6374]; Isaac b 1760 [T2-6407]; Nathaniel b 25 Nov 1762 [T2-6414]; William b 1763 [T2-6475]; John; Elizabeth Mossom b 13 Feb 1757 [T2-6495]; and Susannah [T2-6507].

T2-6295 William **Reynolds** appears to need fine tuning based on the questions raised in *Recollections* over the years.

T2-7078 William Reynolds, of (7077) [Thomas **Reynolds**], b 1740 Caroline Co VA, and d 1805 Edgefield District SC, m Margaret **Harris**. Issue: Fielding b 1 Jun 1763 [T2-7079]; Francis [T2-7116]; Catherine who m - **Burton**; Sally who m - **Dixon**; James [T2-7217]; Abraham b 1770; Margaret who m Joseph **Jennings**; Benjamin [T2-7137]; William Lewis b 1782 [T2-7118]; John; and Larkin [T2-7152].

T2-7078 William **Reynolds**, according to Tillman, was son of 7077 Thomas and Hannah (**Lewis**) **Reynolds** who settled in Caroline Co VA. I can find no Thomas **Reynolds** married to a Hannah in Caroline Co at that time. Ron **Brown** wrote that a *Margaret Pickett* married a William **Reynolds** in Caroline Co. They appear to be of the right time and place. Is this a possibility for 7078 William **Reynolds**? Also, there appears to be a mix-up with some of the children that **Tillman** shows for 7078 William **Reynolds**. The children of this couple need to be verified.

Note: It is interesting that this is **Tillman's** line.
Note: I think I have a possibility for this William, i.e., William **Rennolds**, son of Benjamin **Rennolds** of the James **Rennolds** line (RFA Line 35).

Caroline County VA

I believe it is necessary at this time to address the issue of the William **Rennolds/Reynolds** that may have been in Caroline Co VA in an adult status during the period 1760 to 1810. Since Caroline Co is a

partially burned county with no will and deed books, and with some of the Order Books in disarray it is very difficult to collect meaningful data as it relates to individual and family relationships. The detailed analyses of the personal property tax list and the land tax list for the county I found most helpful in sorting out who's who in the county for a given period of time.

I found that there were three identifiable William **Rennolds/Reynolds** in Caroline Co in the time looked at. However, supporting data was very much lacking and the documentation we want is limited, as shown

1) William **Rennolds**, son of Benjamin **Rennolds**, grandson of James and Sussannah **Rennolds** (RFA Line 35):

- He would have been born ca 1728 to 1740.
- He was in evidence in family matters and court records up to 1780.
- He appears to have been in the Army (1758) in the French and Indian War.
- He may have received a commission in the Army in 1777.
- County Tax Lists starting in 1783 do not show him.

I saw nothing to support that he was married or that he had children; but I assume that he was and did. I saw nothing to indicate that he died. Thus, the facts support that he departed Caroline Co for parts unknown ca 1780/1781. If I am correct, this William **Rennolds** is a candidate for one of these William **Reynoldses** that we have not been able to identify correctly.

2) William **Rennolds** b ca 1640-50, m Sallie ___, was from Essex Co VA and settled in Caroline Co. He is the son of James and Catherine **Rennolds** and the great-grandson of James and Sarah **Rennolds** (Line 35).

- He *may* have had a commission in the Army in the Revolutionary War, 1777.
- He sold property in Essex Co in 1783, saying that he was moving. At that time he had four children: James, William, Catherine, and Elizabeth. Later he had additional children: Thomas, John, Alice and Lucy.
- He was on the Tax Lists in Caroline Co VA until 1795 when he apparently died. His estate land was transferred to his wife Sallie in 1798 and in 1800 the land was sold.
- In 1801 Chancery suits were started for Sallie and her children.
- The suits continued through 1812 when it was said that Sallie Sale and all her children, except James, were in Kentucky. Ch: James; William; Catherine m 1st Ezekiel **Talbot** and 2d Robert **Owens**; Elizabeth m Jesse **Owen**; Thomas; John; Alice; and Lucy.

Thus, this William **Rennolds** is not a candidate for

Project William. The important thing to us is that we know who this family is and that most of them went to KY by 1812.

3) There is a William **Reynolds** b ca 176_-1765 in Caroline Co VA who appears to be an older son of a Cornelius and Molly **Reynolds**. This Cornelius Reynolds died ca 1793 when his "estate" was listed on the Tax Lists.

- He was listed on the Tax Lists in 1791 and was still on the Lists in 1812 (the last List I read).

- I know nothing about this William **Reynolds** family. This William should be a candidate for 5908 William **Reynolds**. The pension papers say that he was born 24 Sep 1760 in Caroline Co. and that he always lived there except for 1785 and 1786 when he was in Culpeper Co VA. This matches with the Tax List records. His children, also listed by **Tillman**, need to be verified; some of the names are identical to other Reynolds names of the Caroline Co area. His estate settlement should be looked at, if there is one.

Reynoldses in Western New York

By 1797 the Holland Land Company had purchased 3.3 million acres in New York, west of the Genesee River. They established an office on the Purchase, and Joseph **Ellicott** was hired to survey it and divide it into townships and ranges. The ranges were numbered 1 to 15, east to west, and were divided into townships numbered from south to north. Each township was about 6 miles square, and were further divided into lots. Lots were laid out starting with number 1 in the southeast corner of the township and going north, then back to the southern boundary and going north again.

By late 1800, the survey was complete and the first land was opened to settlement. Deeds were not given until the account was paid in full. Payments in cattle, wheat and other commodities was accepted because of the lack of hard money. By 1839 all land in the Holland Purchase had been sold.

The records of the Company remained in Amsterdam, & Holland until the 1970s when a project to microfilm them was funded. The original microfilms are housed at Reed Library, SUNY, College at Fredonia, Fredonia NY. Copies are also located at the Library of Congress, New York State Library, New York Public Library and the Family History Library in Salt Lake City.

The following entries have been "decoded" from the published index of extracts. They provide only basic

information, and associate a person with a location in a given time period. A list of townships in the various counties was taken from Orasmus **Turner's Pioneer History of the Holland Purchase of Western New York**, 1849, and are accurate as of that publication date. Changes in town boundaries have occurred since then.

Honorable John Merriman Reynolds

Born near Quarryville, Lancaster Co. 5 Mar 1848, died 14 Sep 1933, Bedford PA, buried Bedford cemetery, Bedford PA. The son of Patrick II and Ann (Barnett) Reynolds. The father was a native of Ireland but eight years of age when the family came to America. He

became a dealer in livestock and operated a grist mill on his farm. John M. Reynolds attended the State Normal School, Millersville PA, then located in Bedford to assume his duties as principal of public schools. While thus engaged, he began the study of law, and, on 15 Feb 1870, was duly admitted to practice in Bedford Co. He was subsequently admitted to the higher courts of the State and of the United States. He was a profound student of the fundamental principles of law and was diligent in his application of these principles. In 1895, Columbia University, Washington DC, conferred upon him the degree of Master Arts. For many years he held great interest in the Hartley Bank. In public life, Mr. Reynolds enjoyed the highest respect and esteem of the citizens of the County, State and National, having served in the House of Representatives at Harrisburg and as District Attorney of Bedford Co. Later, he was honored with the appointment of Assistant Secretary of the Interior at Washington and served a four year term. In 1904, he was chosen as a member of Congress, serving three terms, and before the conclusion his last term, was elected Lieutenant Governor of PA. All these offices he filled with credit to himself and to the best interests of his constituents. A Sunday school superintendent vestryman in St. James Episcopal Church, a Mason and member of the RFA. In 1877 Mr. Reynolds married Miss Ella **Hartley**, daughter of William and Margaret (**Metzger**) **Hartley**. Mrs Reynolds was born 6 Sep 1851, Bedford PA; died there 6 Jul 1920. Survived by a son, William H. Reynolds of Cincinnati OH, and two daughters, Margaret, wife of Shirley C. Hulse, and Judith, widow of Col. George Goodrich, both of Bedford PA, ad several grandchildren. [1932-33-34 *RFA Annual*, p50.]

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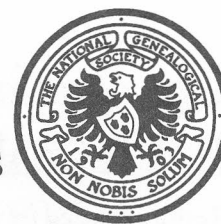
