RFA recently learned of the death of Walter F. Reynolds, Line Coordinator for Robert and Mary of Boston.

Walter Florus Reynolds, retired research chemist, died Friday 10 Jan 1977 at his home in Stamford CT. He was 79. He died of cancer.

Born in Nutley NJ 10 Oct 1917, he was son of the late Walter F. and Arlie Bryan Reynolds. A Stamford resident for the past 52 years, he worked for American Cyanamid for 37 years until his retirement in 1980. He

received his bachelor of science degree in pulp and paper from Syracuse University in 1939.

Mr. Reynolds is survived by his wife, Frances Winter Reynolds of Stamford [now of Tucker GA], two daughters, Frances R. Mullaney of Shelby NC and Gwendolyn R. Cordner of Tucker GA, a brother Malcolm B. Reynolds of Levitown PA, and four grandsons.

Services were held 14 January in St. John's Episcopal Church in Stamford CT.

Walter F. Reynolds had been a member of RFA since 1987.

To Name The Fallen The Memorial Wall Black Horse Chapter United Daughters of the Confederacy Warrenton, Virginia Cemetery

For more than 130 years, one of the great remaining mysteries surrounding the War Between the States lay buried beneath a mound in a cemetery in Warrenton VA.

Six hundred Confederate soldiers from AL, FL, GA, LA, MS, NC, SC, TN, TX and VA, died in makeshift hospitals following the Battles of First and Second Manassas, and were buried in individual graves and given simple wooden markers made by the schoolchildren of Warrenton.

The cruelty of the winter of 1863 visited an especially tragic fate on the 600 fallen men: Union forces desecrated the graves by burning the wooden markers for firewood.

At the request of the Memorial Association, the unidentifiable bodies were moved to a common grave and a tall, simple monument was erected and dedicated in 1877. The names of those who rested in the graves seemed lost forever.

Until a family history researcher, Robert E. Smith, of Carpentersville IL, began the search for his ancestors' service in the CSA. For more than 13 years, he cross-checked surgeon's records, hospital data and regimental histories to account for the unnamed casualties. His successful search now has yielded the identities of 520

of the unknown soldiers whose bodies lie beneath the Confederate Memorial and Mound.

Members of Warrenton's Black Horse Chapter of the UDC undertook the responsibility of permanently recording the names of soldiers newly identified by Mr. Smith by inscribing them on a permanent addition to the present Memorial.

Among these 520 are:

Mississippi: **Reynolds, Thomas G.**, Co A, 2 Regmt, d 10/11/1861.

South Carolina: **Reynolds, Ransom**, Co I, 6 Regmt, died 18 Oct 1861.

Confusing Terms

There are many terms used in the old records whose meanings were somewhat different than today's. Don't be misled.

What Made A Child An Orphan. Frequently the court records refer to children as "orphans" of [the father's name], particularly when someone applied for guardianship, or the children were apprenticed to adults to be raised and schooled. Today we consider an orphan to be a child who has lost both parents. Not true in those days. Only the death of the father was necessary to make the child a "legal" orphan. The mother could be alive and rearing the child!

When Was A Child An Infant. A child whose age was believed to be less than 14 years was referred to in court records as an "infant" and this child was not allowed to have any part in the selection of its guardian. The court records will tell you when the child passed the age 14 milestone, as they were then able to go into court and express a choice of guardian. If the court agreed, and the newly named adult was willing and could give bond to the court, the child "14 and upward" could "make the choice of his guardian."

What Was A Son- Or Daughter-In-Law. From the 1600s to the early 1800s these terms described a step-child, related to you through marriage to the child's parent. Adoption was infrequent, but it was not unusual to find that a child using the surname of their step-parent without any visible court action to change their name.

The Reynolds-Lanham Bible by William L. King

Our editor has included the "Reynolds-Lanham Family Bible" data provided by Mary F. Long, in two issues of *Reynolds Recollections*, Feb 1997 and Jan-Feb 1998 [Gee, it took a lot to get his attention! - Ed.]

When this item was first printed in *Recollections*, she was unaware that this was for my family. Joshua J. and Susanna (**Lanham**) **Reynolds** are my great grandparents and Osburn and Margaret (**Jackson**) **Lanham**, Jr. are my great-great grandparents.

On examination of the data in the Bible it would appear that Mary Ann (**Reynolds**) **Christian** had the Bible for a period of time after her parents died. This would make sense as she was the eldest daughter. Later, our family always knew that Margaret **Troutman** (a granddaughter) had the Bible. I have never seen this Bible. I always wanted to see it and get a copy of the info in it. Apparently, someone had the info placed in *Kentucky Family Records, Vol I*, and for this I am thankful. Joshua J. and Susanna **Reynolds** and 9 of their 12 children are buried in the Red Hill Baptist Church cemetery in Daviess Co. KY. Two of these, Henry L. and William M. **Reynolds** were Union soldiers in the Civil War. Daughters, Margaret J. **Gordon** and Sarah E. **Heavrin** are buried in the Red Hill Baptist Church cemetery, Owensboro KY, and son Thomas J. **Reynolds** is buried at Bethel Baptist Church cemetery, Beech Grove KY.

There are at least three mistakes in the data in the Bible:

- My grandparents, John W. (Wesley) and Lydia (**Littler**) **Reynolds**: His name is John W, not John N.
- The fourth child, fourth son, Thomas J. **Reynolds** born 12 Dec 1848 is not listed under "Births."
- The third child, third son, William M. **Reynolds**, born 26 Apr 1847: birth listed incorrectly.

To demonstrate how family data can be misrepresented, some good soul placed all of this family's info from the Bible on family group sheets, etc., and entered it in the LDS records system. The data entered is incorrect because the submitter said that all these family members were born, married, died, etc. in Livermore and McLean Counties KY. There were all of Daviess Co. KY. One day these records will have to be corrected.

I have more info on this family and the individuals listed in the Bible if anyone is interested.

Biography

William Edward Reynolds Rear Admiral, U.S. Coast Guard

Admiral Reynolds was born in Montgomery Co MD, 11 Jan 1860, the third son of Greenbury and Naomi (**Fawcett**) **Reynolds**. His father died in 1861, and his mother in 1875.

He lived in MD until 1875, when the family moved to Washington DC. He attended public schools in MD and DC. In spring 1878 he was successful in a competitive examination for a cadetship in the U.S. Revenue-cutter Service (now the U.S. Coast Guard) and joined the practice cutter *S.P. Chase*, a bark-rigged sailing vessel, at New Bedford MA, in the summer of

that year. Two years later he graduated number one in his class and was commissioned a third Lieutenant. He served on a number of vessels on various stations; his last regular sea duty was in command of the *Seneca* at New York. This vessel had just been constructed as a derelict destroyer, the first vessel ever built by any country for such work. He passed through the several grades, attaining his present rank of Rear Admiral, U.S. Coast Guard, on 12 Jan 1923.

In the spring of 1881, he joined the *Corwin* at San Francisco just prior to the sailing of that vessel on the *Jeannette* Relief Expedition. The *Corwin* also searched the Arctic Ocean that season for the missing whaling ships *Mt. Wollaston* and *Vigilant*. He was one of the party of three sent out from the *Corwin* to proceed along the coast of Siberia in search of the missing vessels. This trip was made by dog sleds on the north coast of Siberia and on the Arctic ice adjacent thereto; the party was absent a month. Information was obtained regarding the fate of the whaling ships, and some rumors concerning the *Jeannette*. In August of the same season he was one of the boat's crew from the *Corwin* that made a landing on Wrangell land, this being the first known landing on that Island; he planted the flag, taking possession in the name of the USA. This was 12 Aug 1881. He cruised in the Alaskan and Arctic waters the following two seasons also.

He served several tours of duty at the Coast Guard Academy, the last being for approximately five years as its Superintendent and as the commanding officer of the practice ship. A number of cruises were made to European waters.

During the years 1890-1893, while on duty at Washington, he attended Georgetown University Law School night classes, receiving the degrees of LL.B. and LL.M. He was a special student at Cornell University, taking the course in naval architecture and shipbuilding, during the college year 1893-1894. In the summer of 1894, he attended the Naval War College at Newport RI. He served as Superintendent of Construction and Repair of the Coast Guard during the period 1902-1912. In 1912 he was assigned to duty in command of the Southern Division, at San Francisco CA. In 1912 he was assigned to duty in command three summer seasons of 1912, 1913, and 1914 he had charge of the patrol force in the North Pacific Ocean and Bering Sea, with headquarters at Unalaska.

When war was declared with Spain in 1898, he was in command of a cutter with headquarters at Key West FL, and was directed to report to Admiral **Sampson**, U.S. Navy, for duty. He served actively throughout the war. Upon entry of the U.S. in the World War, the Coast Guard (Revenue-Cutter Service and Life-Saving

Service having been combined in 1915 to form the Coast Guard) automatically became a part of the Navy, and he was made Chief of Staff, Twelfth Naval District, with headquarters at San Francisco. Early in the fall of 1919 he was ordered to Coast Guard Headquarters, Washington DC, and in October of that year was commissioned as Commandant of the Coast Guard by the President, which office he now holds.

In 1885 he married (1st) to Minnie G. **Collins** of Washington DC, who died in 1910. In 1912 he married (2nd) Nellie **Groome Bates**, whose maternal grandmother before her marriage to Francis **Bates** in 1837 at Steubenville OH, was Catherine Anne **Reynolds**. When R.S. Reynolds Jr was injured in the Civil War at Fair Oaks VA (1862), he was finally treated by his brother Horace at Castleton NY. This was notarized in his war records. Curiously, my grandfather's brother Algernon Sidney Reynolds, M.D. also was interested in the RFA as there is a letter in the family Bible to him from them dated 12-21-1903 requesting him to continue his interest in the Assoc.
