General Summary of 1998 Reunion by Susan Clement, Swansea MA

The RFA Annual Membership Business Meeting was held on Saturday morning.

On Saturday evening the annual banquet started with a reception and cocktail hour. The banquet room was beautifully decorated by the hotel staff, and the buffet dinner was excellent. After dinner, President Bill King recognized some of the members in attendance, i.e. those attending first reunion; most reunions attended; longest membership; newest member; longest distance travelled. RFA Annual Membership Meeting 8/15/98**President's Report**

Minutes of last year's meeting were published in newsletter following. Audit committee completed review of books, and approved. Treasurer's report presented to Board and accepted.

Finances have been reviewed by Board and will be monitored over the coming year. We have some anticipated future expenses which require a cash reserve, including publication of the Millenium/1850 Project. This year's expenses exceeded revenue by about \$1000, although there were some unusual expenses, particularly for computer hardware. The Board is monitoring the situation and also considering options, which may include raising annual dues in the near future. The Board has decided to put an article in

the newsletter encouraging contributions to defray the costs of equipment.

Membership is gradually decreasing. Need to encourage new members, especially those who will stay with the association. We must keep membership stabilized above 400.

Discussion of current RFA projects: 1850 census project and "Project William." Status of the 1850 census project will be in the Nov-Dec 1998 issue of *Recollections*.

Discussion of Line Coordinators. Board is beginning to start re-organization of process, and Pat Daniels will be the coordinator.

Re-organization of RFA administration over past year. Condensed some jobs. Appointed additional Directors to the Board. Introduced new people into the administration of RFA.

Archiving process has been continuing with Sue and Lee bearing almost all of the load. Board is considering what to do with all the paper that has accumulated over the years.

There were many very good suggestions from the members, which will be considered by the Board, but until there are volunteers to do these projects, they very likely will remain on the back burner!

The 1999 RFA Reunion is to be held in Boston MA, with Sue Clement as host, with other members in the area assisting her.

The Tillman Project

Jacob Reynolds, 1824-1879
Connersville (Fayette) IN
From Judy Reynolds, Kenosha WI

The focus of this article is T2-455, Jacob **Reynolds**. In 1960, Jacob's grandson, John "Johnny" Reynolds of Minneapolis received the following letter from Stephen Tillman.

"Dear Mr. Reynolds:

The 1959 Reynolds book is complete to the following par. on your line. 455 Jacob Reynolds, son of John and Elizabeth **Reynolds**, b 1824... The outline you have so kindly sent me will add much additional data for which I thank you... Hope you will be able to interest some of your family in the 1959 book which is \$5 per copy..."

Family story is that Johnny did not purchase a copy of the book. This writer, who has seen only three pages (1, 18, and 20) of T-2, assumes that no separate paragraphs were added for Jacob's sons; therefore, this update is not a correction, but an addition.

The 1850 census of Fayette Co IN shows a household with 26-year-old Jacob **Runnels**, wife Nancy and sons John W. and Thomas D., of ages fitting Tillman's entry.

In 1860, the household of Jacob and Nancy includes Thomas D. plus his younger siblings, William, Sarah, Mary and George. John W., age 12 is enumerated with grandparents John and Elizabeth in nearby household.

A search through records of Fayette Co has not led to a marriage record for Jacob and Nancy. However, Jacob's Civil War papers include a decree indicating they were divorced in Oct 1873.

In 1879, Nancy married John Rhinehart, informant, lists Nancy's father's last name as Delphry with no given name. Since Jacob and Nancy's son Thomas had Dolphe for a middle name, his living descendants assume that Nancy's maiden name was Dolphe.

John Reynolds, Delaware to Indiana Born 1778 or 1788?

The focus of this article is T2-454, John Reynolds. Tillman listed his date of birth as 1788. The 1850 and 1860 censuses for Fayette Co IN place this man's birth in DE between 1776-1778.

The 1850 census for Fayette Co shows John **Runnels**, age 72, farmer, born DE; Elizabeth age 59, born PA; Sarah, age 21, born IN. The head of the adjacent household is 26-year-old Jacob **Runnels**, wife Nancy and sons John W. and Thomas D.

The 1860 census for the same county shows adjacent households of John **Reynolds** and Jacob **Reynolds**. John is now listed as 84 years old. Sarah is still a part of the household but with her husband Isaac Cook plus two Cook children. Also listed in 12-year-old John, absent from Jacob's household. The household of Jacob and Nancy includes Thomas D. and his younger siblings: William, Sarah, Mary and George.

Two earlier censuses of Fayette County show a probable listing for T2-254. The 1840 census shows the following household headed by John Reynolds: 1 male 15 under 20; 1 male 60 under 70; 2 female 10 under 15; 1 female 50 under 60.

These descriptions fit previously discussed John, Elizabeth, Jacob, Sarah, plus one female born between 1825 and 1830, who could have been married before 1850. This unnamed female could have been born before or after Jacob.

The same county's 1830 census lists the following John **Reynolds** household: 1 male 5 under 10, 1 male 50 under 60, 2 female under 5; 1 female 10 under 15; 1 female 40 under 50. The female 10 under 15, definitely born before Jacob, leaves the household by 1840.

This writer is not aware of Tillman's source for the 1788 date of birth of T2-454 John Reynolds. If four census enumerations can be a decade off in his date of birth, the 1788 date is possible for a man who had a child born between 1815 and 1820.

Bill Marshall wrote to RFA:

"... I have only gone back to my great grandfather, Jahu **Reynolds**. I have had no one to assist with the Reynolds line which is one of the reasons I want to become a member of RFA. I have been in Grey's Branch KY several times, and in Ironton, but the only contacts there are Long relatives. Since Mary Elizabeth **Long Reynolds** has been dead well over 100 years,

and died a young woman, there is very little information about her.

Jahu **Reynolds'** gravestone states that he was a member of Company F, 54th KY Mounted Infantry in the War Between the States. I have a death certificate which gives his age at death in 1910 as 63. This information was provided by a second wife who had only been married to him 10 years or so when he died, and who I think knew little of his early life. If in fact he was 63 in 1910, he was born in 1847, and only 14 in 1861, and 18 in 1865 at the end of the War. Although these ages do not make it impossible for him to have been in the Mounted Infantry, they raise questions. He could of course have inflated his age when he was younger, as many did, and then reverted to his real age when he was older. I strongly suspect that Jahu has a military record as some evidence suggests he was receiving a pension when he died, and that his widow continued to receive it.

I have twice visited that area of OH and KY. Ironton and Grey's Branch are both county seats. The records before 1920 are very scant and in poor condition. I was fortunate enough to be able to obtain a death record for Jahu **Reynolds**, and thus able to locate his grave in the main cemetery in Ironton. The Cemetery record contains no information that is not in the death record. All of this is complicated because people moved back and forth across the River in that area as if it were a dirt road, and not a major river which divided two separate states. People apparently often lived in Greenup County, Kentucky but worked in Ironton, and died there.

It is also complicated by the fact that apparently the **Long** family did not want Mary Elizabeth to marry Jahu **Reynolds**. I could not find a marriage record; however, they had six living children when she died just short of her 36th birthday; she died of childbed fever. The baby, my grandmother's younger sister, was born in late April and died the following year.

Would like to know their Reynolds family connection to **Enoch Reynolds** who married their daughter **Margaret Reynolds** (4 Mar 1809-25 Dec 1885). He was b ca 1806, d 3 Apr 1863, s/o **Elisha Reynolds** of Monmouth Co NJ whose will 3 Aug 1809 names a daughter **Moriah Reynolds** (sic) and son **Hiram Reynolds**. Was Enoch a nephew of Margaret Reynolds **Chambers**?

Also Enoch and Margaret (**Chambers**) **Reynolds** had at least sons James d 31 Aug 1864 in Civil War (don't have any more) and Enoch d 2 Dec 1864, age 15 y. 2 m. 15 da. (This from Mrs. Elaine **Treby** of Allentown PA.)
