An Apology to Steve Roth And the Other Descendants of James Reynolds of North Kingstown RI

In 1990, Steve Roth of Omaha NE became the Vice President (Membership) of RFA. Before that time, he had been working diligently on a compilation of the descendants of James and Deborah Reynolds of North Kingstown RI. During his tenure as VP, he continued this project, working with many of the RFA members, to complete this project and have a book ready to publish; a book which he donated to RFA. The paper manuscript was sent to RFA in late September of 1994, all 1,739 pages of text and an annotated index of 636 pages! It was to have been proofread and necessary suggestions sent back to Steve to change the computer manuscript.

The fact that it has not yet been published is an incredible error on the part of RFA. RFA goofed! The first several proofed pages were mailed to Steve; Steve did not receive them. While waiting for his response the project slipped to the back burner and there it remained until August 1998 when I obtained the copy of the paper manuscript. This article will be mailed out to all those descendants who are no longer members of RFA, with deepest apologies.

As VP for Publications, I am responsible for this debacle. I am so sorry. I wish there were something I could do to undo the neglect. I can only apologize to Steve and the members of RFA for this situation.

JOHN J. **REYNOLDS**, the developer of the
MasterCard, died of heart failure Thursday October
19, 1993 in New York. He was 70. Mr. **Reynolds**
was a senior vice president for Citibank in 1967 when
he developed the bank's "Everything Card," later
renamed the MasterCharge Card. After leaving the

Matilda **Reynolds**, mother of W. H. Atteberry, was born in Green county, Kentucky, and is now living in Munfordville. She is a daughter of Daniel T. and Cassandra Jane (**McCubbin**) Reynolds. Her father was born at Pittsylvania Court House, Virginia, in 1830, and died in Hart county, Kentucky, in March, 1908. He became a shoemaker, which trade he followed many years. He served in the Federal army during the Civil war and was wounded in battle, from the effects of which he was an invalid throughout his life. He was an active member of the Grand Army of the Republic, gave his support to the republican party and was an earnest member of the Baptist church. His parents, Joseph and Polly (**Seymore**) Reynolds, were natives of Virginia and died in Hart county, the mother at the advanced age of ninety-six years. Joseph Reynolds was a whig in politics and a member of the Baptist church. Jane McCubbin was born in Green county, Kentucky, and died in Munfordville in March, 1907.
