Reynolds Family Association 74th Annual Reunion Boston/Braintree MA 27 & 28 Aug 1999 By Susan Clement

When I volunteered to be the local host for this year's reunion in Boston, I was very excited. Boston is very rich in genealogical research facilities, as well as historical sites, and our members were eager to visit both. My original plan was to locate the reunion somewhere near downtown Boston, near to the primary research facilities and all the amenities that Boston has to offer. My visions quickly faded, however, as I began to contact the area hotels and conference centers. Much to my dismay, I quickly learned a thing or two about planning a function in Boston! Some hotels actually refused to even talk to me because I could not promise them revenues with at least 5 digits. Others were at least civil or even friendly, with offers of a room rate of almost \$200 per night, a function room at \$600 per day, or banquet dinners starting at \$75 per person. Needless to say, this is far beyond the means of the RFA, and most of our members.

So, the next best plan was to look just outside Boston in the suburbs, with close proximity to public transportation to get us downtown. When I spoke to the sales staff at the Sheraton Hotel in Braintree, I was convinced that this was the way to go! The **Sheraton Braintree** is a full service hotel, with all the amenities. For those of you who attended the 1992 Centennial Celebration in Warwick RI, you may recall the hotel there and what a good job they did for us. The same company owns and runs the Sheraton Braintree, and the two hotels are very similar. They have given us terrific rates, and have been very accommodating for what I had in mind.

A room rate of \$99 per night is good for the Friday and Saturday nights of the reunion, as well as two days before and two days after. There are restaurants in the hotel or nearby. The rooms are spacious, and have such amenities as coffeepots and irons. [Just one note here... I know that some of you

look for alternative hotels when attending the RFA reunion. You can certainly do this, but I would suggest that you will not find a better value for this rate. Please keep in mind that the discounts that RFA receives when contracting with the hotel are due in large part to a guarantee of a certain number of guests and reserved rooms at the hotel. If that guarantee is not met, the RFA may have to pay additional fees that are not covered by the registrations. Please support your association, and enjoy a first-rate hotel at a reasonable cost. -- SCJ

Although the actual agenda has not been completely planned, some of the usual events can be expected. The RFA archives will be available on Friday and Saturday, and hopefully, we will have many of the line and family coordinators on hand to assist. Since I will be able to transport a good deal of material, I hope to have more of the RFA archives available. We will have a banquet on Saturday night. The plan at this point is to have a couple days of guided research trips into Boston.

The Sheraton Braintree is situated across from the **South Shore Plaza**, a very large shopping mall, with a number of restaurants. It is about 2 miles from the "T" or subway station. Next door is the terminal for the "Logan Express" bus that runs between Logan International Airport in Boston and Braintree. The hotel provides free shuttle service, on request, between all three sites and the hotel. For those of you driving, there is ample free parking in a large lot directly in front of the hotel.

Most researchers will find Boston a treasure trove of information, and there will never be enough time to do everything! The primary research facilities include:

New England Historic Genealogical Society – located in Boston's Back Bay/Copley area, easily accessible by "T", but not easy to drive to and find parking! NEHGS is one of the country's largest genealogical libraries, and has material covering all areas of the country and many parts of the world. The collection is open to users. Unfortunately, it is expensive; for non-members, the fee for one day of research is \$15. Members can use the library free of charge. Annual membership is \$50, and if you are going to spend any amount of time there, you may want to consider joining.

Boston Public Library – located two blocks from NEHGS. The BPL has an extensive genealogical collection with a strong focus on New England, but also the British Isles and other parts of the country. They have an extensive newspaper collection. There is no fee. There is a good amount of open material; however, the majority of the collection is in closed stacks.

Mass. State Archives – located at the JFK Library, near UMass-Boston. Accessible by car, or

by the "T" and a shuttle bus from the station. Material includes all non-current records of the Commonwealth of Mass., including vital records, state census returns, military documents, colonial and revolutionary documents, etc. Many of the county court records are housed there as well.

You may also be interested in visiting the *Mass. State Library, Mass. Historical Society, the Mass. Chapter of the Mayflower Society and the Boston branch of the Immigration and Naturalization Service*. If you are going to have a car, other possibilities include *The Mayflower Society Library in Plymouth, the Essex Institute in Salem, The New Bedford Public Library Genealogical Collection, The New Bedford Whaling Museum, the National Archives Branch in Waltham* and any number of local town libraries and historical societies.

I cannot possibly begin to do justice to all of the historical sites and tourist spots in and around Boston, so I won't even begin to try. If you are going to spend more than just a couple days, you might want to pick up an AAA, or similar, guide. Once the agenda is in place, information packets will be sent as you register. I am very proud to be a native New Englander, and I am looking forward to welcoming you to visit us for the RFA reunion and enjoy the family and the area!

For the benefit of new members, RFA is planning to publish the RFA Millennium Collection. A special project for this publication is abstracts of all Reynolds (all spellings) from the 1850 Federal Census. Those of you who are willing to abstract just one county in one state (more, if you can) should contact W.O. "Bill" Reynolds, 2002 Gasparilla Rd, G-18, Placida FL 33946; e-mail: reynolds@ewol.com. He will provide instructions and forms to use. It will be "first come, first served" on the county/state availability. Your name will be

included as a contributor if you provide only one county census record.

The census on microfilm is available at the Federal Regional National Archives, the LDS Family History Center in Salt Lake City, most likely the area genealogical/historical society for your county/state.

As a reminder, please include the census page number, township (if any) and microfilm roll number on each report. Generally, the page numbering starts anew with a new census district and/or township. Also, please identify all counties you researched, even if there were no McReynolds, Rannels, Rennels, Rinnels, Runnels, Reynolds or Wreynolds, etc.

Please send completed abstracts to Sybil R. Taylor, Vice-President of Publications, 4004 Javins Drive, Alexandria VA 22310 (e-mail address: RFALEE@AOL.COM). While we have not yet set a deadline for sending Millennium to the printers, we probably should aim for the year 2000, don't you think?

In addition to the 1850 Millennium Collection, we anticipate including only material that is documented. We will not include published family history material from the RFA Centennial Collection. See Recollections, Jan-Feb 1998 for more information.

Queries Bring Answers

FA and the Owen and Clay Co. IN Genealogical Societies published my queries about Adam Reynolds in late 1997. There were a number of responses... I thank you for publishing the query that helped make it possible.

The lineage shown on the enclosed for Richard Reynolds is very well documented. I now have a copy of Richard's probate record, which lists all the children, and I have various census, marriage, and cemetery records for Clay and Owen Counties which support the dates in the enclosure. I am confident about the lineage back to Richard.

Obviously, this raises the question as to who were Richard's parents. So, I went back through all the Recollections issues that I had kept since I joined in 1994. Regretfully, I didn't have all of them but I did find the article in Vol. 11, No. 6 about Gillium Reynolds, which was submitted by Richard Lasell, New Hope MN. The article written by Lasell mentioned that Gillium Reynolds was born in NC and had lived in Owen Co. IN before moving to Guthrie Co. IA. The article also indicated that Gillium's parents might have been James Reynolds and Sarah Green.

I never received a reply from Lasell but it turns out that the Guthrie Co. WebGen Coordinator,

Shannon Moore, is also a descendant of Gillium Reynolds. She has researched this family extensively in IA and IN. She believes Gillium and Richard were brothers, sons of James Reynolds. Thus, the enclosed about James Reynolds may be correct although there is a question as to whether this James Reynolds is the one who married Sarah Green.

There are a number of individuals on the Internet who are actively researching various lines of the Reynolds Family. It seems to be generally accepted that:

- All of the Reynolds in Owen and Clay Counties IN, ca 1840-1850 were related.
- They moved to IN from Montgomery NC after 1820. (There is no written proof about the Reynolds Family moving from Montgomery Co. but there is a written contemporary account of the Beamon and Stevens families' move. Members of these families married members of the Reynolds families.

We were able to visit Montgomery Co. NC this year and found:

- A James entered land in Montgomery Co. in 1772. He was in the 1884 State Census as Jas Runels. He was also in the 1790 census (James Raynolds) along with an Anderson Raynolds. In 1810, the Census for Montgomery Co. included A. Runnels, Henry Runnels, James Runnels, James Runnels Sr., Jacob Runnels, Jno Runnels, and William Runnels.
- There was a Richard Reynolds in Montgomery Co. ca. 1820. His name appears in reference to a land entry in the same area as the original entry by James Reynolds. Regretfully, the 1820 census for Montgomery Co. is missing.
- Modern day Reynolds in Montgomery Co. claim descendance from Christopher Reynolds b 1530, Kent, Eng. Information on the Internet indicates that James Reynolds, born 1757 in Nansemond Co., VA, married Sarah Green, died 1833 in Gates Co. NC, is a descendant of this line (Christopher, George, Thomas, John, Robert, William, James). Also according to information on the Internet, James' brothers were Jacob, Richard, William, Hamilton and Thomas, which is quite similar to the names showing up in the 1810 census.

[*Note from Sybil R. Taylor:* What is the documentation to support the Christopher, George, Thomas generations? RFA has been pleading for years for documentation to support these generations, but all roads seem to lead back to the Reynolds Families of VA 1530-1948, by Stephen F. Tillman, who gave no documentation for them.]

Although he would have only been 15 when the land was entered in Montgomery County, it seems quite possible these James Reynolds are the same person. Thus, my question -- Has anyone conclusively connected the James Reynolds in

Montgomery County in 1772 and the James Reynolds born in VA in 1757.
