The Exeter, New Hampshire News-Letter
23 June 1845

Deaths: In Lowell, MA June 13th, Mr. Thomas Reynolds, of Derry, aged 65. Mr. Reynolds was on a visit to a daughter living in that place. He was found

dead upon the sidewalk early in the morning. The Lowell Advertiser says that he had complained of ill health for several days; and probability is that he got up from his sleep, and stepped out, or fell out of the window of his room, which was on the third floor. His body was still warm at the time of discovery.

Jeremiah Colton Reynolds, b. 8 Feb 1820, Canada; son of J. C. Reynolds and Polly Mooney, both of NH. In 1835, moved to Pierrepont, settled on a farm, where they died. Joseph Reynolds, Jeremiah's grandfather, was from MA and died in

Canada. His wife was Mary **Reynolds**, by whom he had twelve children. In 1848, Jeremiah married Mary J., dau of George W. and Mary E (**Reynolds**) **Marden**. They had the following children: Milton E., Charles, Hector, Ernest, Minnie, Nellie B. and William W. Moving to Colton in 1853, Jeremiah built a hotel, the Empire Exchange, sold it and removed to Plains in 1877. Jeremiah died at age 95y 5m on 8 July 1914.

William W. **Reynolds**, son of Jeremiah and Mary (**Marden**) **Reynolds**, m. Amanda **Rodwell** and died at age 72 on 28 June 1942.

Died at the home of **William Reynolds** in Atkins, Tuesday, 12 January 1897, **Willie Halliburton** with pneumonia aged 14.

William Reynolds died at his home in Atkins Sunday evening 14 March 1897, after a long illness, age 70 years. The deceased was the founder of Atkins and well and favorably known through this and adjoining

Robert W. Reynolds was born at Fowler, Illinois, January 6, 1882. His parents were Dr. **Emory Eugene** and **Virginia (Pursley) Reynolds**, the former of whom, one of three brothers, all physicians, for a number of years practiced medicine, after graduating from Rush Medical College, in Illinois and Colorado. The paternal grandfather of Dr. Robert W. Reynolds was Robert G. Reynolds, a native of Ohio and once a man of political prominence there,

whose mother was a first cousin of John Quincy Adams, President of the United States. In later years Robert G. Reynolds went to Illinois, locating near Jacksonville, where he engaged in agricultural pursuits during the rest of his life. The mother of Dr. Robert W. Reynolds was born in Illinois, a daughter of John **Pursley** and a granddaughter of Jacob Pursley, who was a pioneer settler from Pennsylvania in Illinois. The Pursley family is of English extraction, and according to family annals its founder in Pennsylvania was the great-great-grandfather of Mrs. Virginia Reynolds, and who had been captured on the open sea by pirates, who destroyed his vessel but spared his life and left him at a point on the Atlantic coast as that time inhabited by warlike Indians. He succeeded in eluding this new danger, made his way toward the interior and finally found a home in the Quaker settlements of Pennsylvania

George Reynolds was born January 1, 1842, in Marylebone, London, England, the son of George Reynolds and Julia Ann Tautz. At the age of fourteen, he was baptized a member of the Church. In 1863, he became emigration and chief clerk in the Liverpool office.

He arrived in Utah, July 5, 1865, and soon became secretary to President Brigham Young. He was a member of the Territorial militia; was a member of the Board of Regents of the University of Deseret; was treasurer and afterwards manager of the Salt Lake Theatre; was a member of the municipal council of Salt Lake City.

Joseph Darnbrough Reynolds was born February 3, 1833 in Campsall, Yorkshire, England. He was the son of Mark Reynolds and Martha Darnbrough. On March 9, 1846, when thirteen years of age, he was apprenticed to a tailor with whom he remained seven years to learn the art of tailoring. He was baptized into the Latter-day Saint Church when he was sixteen against the wishes of his parents. The Russian Crimean War was on when he was released from his apprenticeship and there was a great demand for uniforms and wearing apparel. He worked in eight different shops and in one year had saved enough

money to bring him to Utah. Joseph Darnbrough Reynolds passed away on March 2, 1913.

From the proceeds, 1/3 to be paid to my wife (not named) and the rest to my sons, Richardson, Jassy (Jesse), and John. I make my brothers Robert and John Runnels, executors. "Signed, being legally Stampd, and pronounced," in presence of Isaac Seaman, Robert Davenport, James Runnels. Proved, April 4, 1765.

Page 511.--"Be it remembered that on the 14 of June, 1764, I, John Runels, of North Castle, in Westchester County, being sick and weak." I leave to my wife Hannah so long as she remains my widow the best room in my dwelling house and a horse and

side saddle and my best bed and my cupboard. I leave to my daughter, Margaret Purdy, $\text{c}10$. To my son Robert $\text{c}50$. To my son John $\text{c}35$. To my son Joseph $\text{c}35$. To my son Richeson 5 shillings. To my son James $\text{c}50$. To my son Sutton $\text{c}50$. I leave to my wife Hannah the use of all my real estate during her widowhood. I make my son Robert and my son-in-law, Andrew Purdy, executors. My executors are to sell all personal estate, and the real estate after the death of my wife, and after paying debts and legacies, I leave $\text{c}5$ to my grandson Richeson (son of my son Richeson) when he is 21. "If the money shall exceed the legacies then each is to be paid more in proportion, and if less a diminution to be made." Witnesses, Benjamin Smith, Isaac Cook, George Cooch. Proved, October 2, 1764.

Page 556.--In the name of God, Amen, January 15, 174 8/9. I, **Jonathan Reynolds**, of North Castle, in Westchester County, being sick in body. I leave to my brother, John Reynolds, my part of the lot that lies joining to Matranous meadows. My part contains about 5 acres, and also my right of 50 acres that my brother John and I bought of our honored father, John

Reynolds. I leave to my brother Robert, whom I make executor, all that the rest of my lands and tenements, and he is to pay to my sister, Deborah Reynolds, $\text{c}20$, and pay all debts, and I leave him all movable estate.  parents of Simeon Goff **Reynolds** (1798-after 1873).
 According to census returns he was born in
 Massachusetts, but went to Mississippi as a young
 man, where, in 1823 in Monroe County, he married
Florinda Sullivant, whose family came from SC. The
 family subsequently moved to Coffeetown, (Yalobusha
 County), MS, shortly after the Chickasaw Indians
 ceded their lands.

Simeon and Florinda were said to have had eight
 children: the fifth child, Seaborn **Reynolds**
 (1834-1905), was the great grandfather of the author
 of this query.

Florinda died about 1842, and the family apparently
 fell apart, and the children dispersed. Seaborn went to
 Texas as a teenager and then to California where he
 settled and raised a family of eleven children. We
 don't know whether he maintained any communication
 with his father or his siblings. After Florinda's death,
 Simeon married three more times: to Caroline **Rogers**,
 then to Rebecka **Thackson**, and finally to Julia
Randolph. Apparently he had no more children. He
 remained in Coffeetown MS, where he was a baker and
 a candy-maker, until sometime after his fourth
 marriage in 1873. We don't know when he died.

Although we are uncertain as to the names of
 Simeon and Florinda's children, our research suggests

that the names of six of the eight children may have
 been the following: John Calvin **Reynolds**, b. about
 1824 in SC; William C. **Reynolds**, b. about 1828;
 Oliver Perry **Reynolds**, b. about 1831; Seaborn;
 Charles, b. about 1837 in MS; and Mary, b. about 1840
 in MS. Mary married William **Melton** in MS.

The Stephen Tillman book states that Simeon's father
 was Ezekiel **Reynolds**, a Revolutionary War soldier
 from NC. We reject this ancestry, because it is clear
 from his pension application that Ezekiel never got
 further north than Virginia, while it is equally clear
 that Simeon was originally from New England,
 probably from the Massachusetts-Rhode Island border
 area. The absence of an identifiable birth record for
 him from this area suggests that Simeon may have
 come from a broken home, or was born out of
 wedlock.

We would very much like to correspond with any of
 the descendants of Simeon and Florinda. Although
 John Calvin **Reynolds** may have died in the Civil War,
 we believe that William C. **Reynolds** may have had a
 number of children, and Oliver Perry **Reynolds** is
 believed to have had at least fourteen children by four
 wives. Surely, some Reynolds descendant must be out
 there who can tell us more about Simeon and Florinda!

In any event, we would like to hear from anyone
 who might be able to tell us about this Reynolds line.
