The Autobiography of John Reynolds

Read on his 88th birthday, 18 June 1870 -

Compiled by R. Inskip - Part I

My paternal grandfather, John **Reynolds**, of Elmly, Worcestershire, England, inherited an entailed estate of great value. He married Miss Sarah Fox [I think of London]. The issue of the marriage were John [heir to the estate]; James [who had a large wholesale & retail woolen & linen draper shop in Birmingham; and left a large estate to his children]; William (my father); Henry [an attorney who died in early manhood, leaving a son and a daughter who were dependent on their uncles]; Edward [who was for a time partner with his brother James, afterward went into business with his nephew] and daughters Sarah [married John **Harwood**, a grocer]; Mary [married John **Guest**, a manufacturer of Japanned ware]; Anne [married a farmer named **Moule**]; & Elizabeth (Betsey) [married a farmer named **Edwards**].

Of my father's family, I am the oldest. I was born 18 June 1782, Colchester, England. My siblings [all b. in England] are as follows:

My father first settled in Colchester in 1782, and removed to Birmingham in 1784 where he resided on Deritend St. His was a grocer. He was not successful in business and lost much during the political riots in 1793. Being a dissenter, his house was marked for destruction.

I have heard my parents say that one evening, about 9 o'clock, they were sitting at their supperwhen an old woman of the neighborhood rushed in...and exclaimed, "Mr. Reynolds, the mob are about to burn your house! For God's sake take your children out!" A pie was on the table, of which the old woman took possession, and ...began to eat with relish. The front door was opened and the mob had free access to the house. The house was not burned. The leaders of the mob were invited to the Castle Inn to drink by some family friends & were told that they [the mob] had made a mistake. That William was a brother of James Reynolds, whom all knew to be a staunch churchman & loyal to his King & government. Much combustible material [gunpowder, salt petre, brimstone, etc] was in the warehouse connected to the house and the burning of it would have put in jeopardy the entire block...

This event determined by father to emigrate to the United States. [to be continued...]

Deaths

5 May 1835. At Alburgh, VT, 29th April, Miss Phebe Reynolds, daughter of John Reynolds, about 20 years of age.

26 May 1835. On Friday the 22nd inst., after 26 hours of intense illness, **Benjamin Reynolds**, of the Eastern Parish of St. Armand, aged 19. A post mortem was requested by the family. Benjamin died suddenly at 6 P. M., after many hours of intense pain. The newspaper gave a detailed account of Benjamin's insides, concluding that the cause of death was not cholera, which residents of the area had feared.

Biographical and Historical Record of Ringgold and Union Counties, IA Submitted by Jean Donahue, IA

Isaac Reynolds, farmer and miller, resided on section 36, Pleasant Twp, where he owned a farm of 217 acres and also a gristmill. Postoffice, Hopeville, Clarke County. He was born in Hendricks Co, IND., and reared on a farm in Morgan Co, that State, until he became a young man. In the last-named county, his parents, Henry and Mary (**Jones**) **Reynolds** died. He immigrated west to Keokuk IA in 1848, and a short time afterward removed to Mahaska Co where he managed a mill one year; next he was in Keokuk again a short time, then two years in Jasper Co, then in Keokuk the third time, then, in 1854, he settled in Ringgold Co IA, where he resided 9 years. Being a self-made man and starting his life without a dollar, he exhibited marvelous talent in his lines of business, meeting with the losses he had and yet had his head far above the waves of vicissitude. The mill which he bought when he came to Union Co. burned down, leaving him \$11,000 in debt. He held the office of road supervisor, and other town-ship and school offices; was a member of the order of Freemasons, of Concordia Lodge No. 215, and both himself and wife were members of the Methodist Episcopal Church. She related that in pioneer times she had to "paddle" the Indians out of her house. She can talk in the language of two different tribes - the Pottawattamie and one other. Her maiden name was Lavina **Costeel**, being the

daughter of John and Mary (**Hardesty**) **Costeel**, natives of OH. She was born in the State of IND. in 1829 and her parents subsequently moved from there to MO in 1840, then to IA in 1842. Her marriage to Mr. **Reynolds** took place in 1848, in Mahaska Co IA, where the marriage license was No. 150 for that county. Their 10 children:
