Westchester County, December 1, 1764. All my lands and goods to be sold. From the proceeds, 1/3 to be paid to my wife (not named) and the rest to my sons, Richardson, Jassy (Jesse), and John. I make my brothers Robert and John Runnels, executors. "Signed, being legally Stampd, and pronounced," in presence of Isaac Seaman, Robert Davenport, James Runnels. Proved, April 4, 1765
