The following were indentured to John **Reynolds** and his assigns of Frederick co., Va., within 6 miles of Winchester, as servants: Murdoch **Campbell**, of Scotland, 23 Sept 1773 for 4 years, and , same date, for 2 years, James **Hancy**.
To John **Reynolds** and his assigns, of Philadelphia, PA, as servants: 13 Apr 1773 William **May** for 1 year and 7 mos and 25 May 1773 Judith **Goir**, of Ireland, for 4 years.

March 24, 1899: Mrs. Malinda Reynolds, residing at the distillery, was afflicted with a paralytic stroke last evening and died near Grangeville, On March 19, 1899. Mrs. Reynolds, a native of Virginia, and the wife of W.S. Reynolds, aged 35 years. The funeral took place at Mt. Idaho.

October 6, 1899: Bertha **Reynolds**, daughter of A.T. Reynolds, of Grangeville, was last night joined in the bonds of matrimony to G.V. Herrington, of Elk City, by Pastor Knox.

March 28, 1901: Married at the residence of Harrison Johnson on Sunday, March 24, W.M. Mouck and Miss Viola **Reynolds**, Rev. Huff officiating.

July 24, 1902: The remains of Alva Reynolds, eldest son of Mr. Reynolds who resided in the Tolo district, were interred in the Denver cemetery on Saturday, July 19. He died on the 17th.
