A Challenge to Members!

Stephen F. Tillman, author of **Reynolds Family** [1948] and **Christopher Reynolds and His Descendants**, has his family line going through William Reynolds [7078] and his wife, Margaret Harris. Tillman then traces back to a Thomas Reynolds [7077] and further back to Christopher Reynolds [6292], Isle of Wight Co., VA. I have always doubted this analysis and, the more I learn from records, the more doubts I have. I have written the following Case Study, which I believe illustrates what the county records tell us: that William Reynolds [Tillman's #7078] is actually the son of Benjamin Reynolds [189] and his wife, Sarah [190], and the grandson of James Rennolds [185] and his 2nd wife, Susannah [200] [Ancestral Line # 35 - RFA]. I also believe that Thomas Reynolds [7235] m. to Nancy Harris is likewise the son of Benjamin [189] and Susannah [190] Rennolds. I challenge the above members to enter into a debate, after analyzing the facts, among one another & myself to determine if Stephen F. Tillman or myself is correct about Tillman's family line!

CASE STUDY

Benjamin Rennolds (193) died in Spotsylvania Co, VA in 1811. At that time he was married to Elizabeth; he may have been married to her for at least 12 years. All of his children were by his first wife Anne Reynolds, daughter of a Cornelius Reynolds; she may have died as early as 1787. In hi. In his will he names his children as: Patsey McKenny, Betsey Reynolds, Lucy Reynolds (m. James Akers), Benjamin Reynolds, William Reynolds and orphans of Larkin Reynolds, Sandra Bouchner testified that Larkin's children were: John V., Benjamin, Caswell and Mahala.

Larkin Reynolds may have been the Larkin who was on the tax rolls in Caroline Co in 1787. Be was in evidence in Spotsylvania Co 1792-99 with his wife Elizabeth. Be and they had a number of dealings with members of the Arnold family. Thus it is possible that Elizabeth, his wife, was an Arnold.

Tillman has William Reynolds (70781, Thomas Reynolds (7235) and Robert Reynolds (7386) as sons of a Thomas Reynolds, (7077). I doubt that any of these three are sons of such a Thomas Reynolds; I saw no Thomas Reynolds (7077), as described by Tillman, in Caroline Co, Vi. Robert lost likely was Robert Rennolds (213), son of James Rennolds (196).

William Reynolds (7078) and Thomas Reynolds (7235) could be brothers William Rennolds (191) and Thomas Rennolds (194), sons of Benjamin Rennolds (1B9). They were born in Caroline Co., VA (according to Tillman) at the right time and also appear to have arrived

in South Carolina at the approximately the same time that they disappeared from Caroline Co., VA. Tillman has William married to Margaret Harris and Thomas to a Nancy Harris. If he is right, could they be sisters?

Tillman has one son of William Reynolds (7078) as Larkin (7152). Tillman has for Larkin Reynolds (7152): d. 1809 Abbeville, S.C. His will designated his brother Benjamin as executor of the estate. Issue: Benjamin, Beven, Caswell b. 1799, Nancy, Mahala, and Larkin, b. 23 April 1807. Another son of William Reynolds (7077) is Benjamin (7137). This Benjamin is shown as married to Barbara Arnold and settled in Abbeville S.C. Among their issue are: John V.b. 1790, Caswell, Bennett b. 16 Jan 1804, and Larkin b. 23 March 1807. It is interesting that Larkin's (7152) children are some of the same names that Benjamin (7137) has listed as his children and that they are the same names of the orphans at Larkin, the son of Benjamin Reynolds (193) who died in Spotsylvania Ca, VA in 1811. I believe this so because Benjamin and Larkin, sons of Benjamin Reynolds (193), took their families to South Carolina to be near their Uncles, William Reynolds (191) and Thomas Reynolds (194). Somehow Tillman got some of Benjamin Reynolds (193) sons listed as sons of his brother William Reynolds (191). Note that both Benjamin and Larkin, sons of Benjamin Reynolds (193), may have been married to Arnold women (maybe sisters).

Conclusion; It is my belief that William Reynolds (7078), Tillman's ancestor, is actually William Rennolds (191), the son of Benjamin (189) and Sarah (1901 Rennolds and the grandson of James (185) and Susannah (200) Rennolds, of Line 35.

Note: The 4 digit numbers are from Tillman's numbering system in **Christopher Reynolds and His Descendants**; the 3 digit numbers are my numbering system for Line 35.

Reynolds, His Honor James, Co. Ct. Judge, of Irish origin, is the son of the late Samuel Reynolds, by his wife, Frances Brandon, and was b. at Brockville, Ont., Aug. 20, 1837. Ed. there, he was called to the bar, 1859, and practiced at Toronto, Brockville and Prescott. He was prominent as a politician, and held high rank in the Masonic body. He was app. Junior Judge of the courts of Leeds and Grenville, May 31, 1888. His Honor was elected Pres. of the Leeds & Grenville Law Assn., 1896~' He is a mem. of the Ch. of Eng., and is a del to the Gen'l. Synod. He m. Marie Therese, dtr of Roger Le Levre, P.Q. (she d. 1878); and 2ndly, Annie M., dan. of l)r. John Barnhardt, Owen Sound, ONT

Reynolds, William Kilby, author and journalist, is descended on father's side from New England ancestry, the first of whom in Am; was Robt. Reynolds, a freeman of Boston, 1634. His father was the projector and builder of the St. John Suspension Bridge, 1852-53, and also constructed the first street in St. John, 1870. B. in St' John, N.W. June 19, 1848, he 'was ed. in a private sch., studied law, but, in 1872, embarked in journalism, in which he has remained. He was

successively on the ed. staff of the New Dominion, Daily News, Daily Tribune, and Daily Telegraph, in St. John, N.B., and, in 1878, became ed. of the Sackville Borderer. Later, he was on the ed. staff of the Moncton Times. He joined the Am. newspaper press, 1883, and was staff correspondent of the Boston Globe, and night ed. of the Boston Post. Afterwards, he wrote for the St. John Progress. He was engaged in general journalistic work. He is the author of various official tourist guidebooks, and wrote "The Great Issues" (1891), and "Old-Time Tragedies" framing No. 1 of the "Annals of the Provinces" (1895). Never married.

In **Reynolds**, we have an example of a fine old Gaelic Irish surname which has been given as its usual anglicized form a common English one. In Irish it is **MacRaghnaill**, **Raghnaill** being the Gaelic equivalent of **Randal** or **Reginald**. The forms **MacRannal** and **Grannell**, also used in English, are of course, nearer the original. The sept belongs to Co. Leitrim: their territory was **Muintir Eolais** in the southern half of that county. They remained influential as long as the Gaelic order survived and indeed up to the end of the seventeenth century, in spite of continual rivalry and feuds with their powerful **Breffny** neighbors the **O'Rourkes** 9with whom, how-ever, they were at times allied). The "Com-position Book of Connacht" calls the Chief of the Name **Magnaill** of **Moynish** (Co. Leitrim) and thirty years later **Camden**, writings of Counties **Leitrim** and **Longford** in 1617, includes them, under the name of **MacGrannell**, with the **O'Rourkes** as "downright Irish". **O'Dugan's** fourteenth century "Topographical Poem" shows that they were equally prominent in the medieval period. Modern statistics indicate that Co. **Lei-trim** is still the principal stronghold of the name, nearly half the people in Ireland so called hailing from that area. an excellent memoir on the **Mac-Rannals** in the **Journal of the Royal Society of Antiquaries** (vol. xxxv) gives much valuable information, particularly about the family of **Lough Scur Castle**, whence came several notable members of parliament as well as **James Reynolds**, whose diary (1658-1660) is of great interest. The Elizabethan **mac Rannal** of this line who was the first to change the name to **Reynolds** was known in consequence as **Mac Raghnaill Gallda** (i.e. the English **MacRannal**). their estates were very extensive: after the Restoration and the Act of Settlement they were in possession of no less than 6,660 acres in Co. **Lei-trim** and 1,000 acres in Co. **Roscommon**. quite a number of Irishmen called **Reynolds** have distinguished themselves in various fields of activity. To the Church they have given **Most Rev. Christopher Augustine Reynolds** (1834-1893),

first Catholic Archbishop of South Australia. (Richard Reynolds, Catholic martyr, was not Irish). In science there were Osborne Reynolds (1842-1912), famous for his original investigations on mechanical and physical subjects, and James Emerson Reynolds (1842-1920), discoverer of various chemical substances. In literature the father of the last named, Dr. James Reynolds (d. 1866), was a novelist and playwright, while George Nugent Reynolds (1770-1802) was a noted ballad writer and probably the author of "The Exile of Erin". We must also mention Thomas Reynolds (1771-1832), brother-in-law of Wolfe Tone, whose betrayal of the United Irishman was largely responsible for the failure of their plans to free Ireland from British domination. On the other hand it should be mentioned that the Reynoldses, especially those of Lough Scure, were strong supporters of James II and figured largely in the attainders and forfeitures that followed his defeat.
