Tillman says that John Reynolds is a son of Thomas & Mary Reynolds of Isle of Wright Co., VA. I have seen no facts to support his position.

A John Reynolds did marry Sara Grimes, 5 Aug 1674, in No. Farnham Parish [Old Rappahannock Co.], Richmond Co., VA. I have checked all VA counties near this area [except Stafford Co., VA] and do not find this family. There is no evidence to support Tillman's position that this couple had children or that the children [as stated by Tillman] are

in fact their children. If anyone has a family line that goes through John & Sara [Grimes] Reynolds as stated by Tillman, I would suggest that they do research to try to determine where their Reynolds line fits in.

There was a John & Sarah Reynolds in St. Mary's & Calvert Counties [Maryland] following 1675. This Sarah was, however, a daughter of a Henry Robinson, Jr. If it could be proven that she was a widow of a Grimes before marrying John Reynolds then it might be possible to identify who their children were/
Summary: The information as shown by Tillman on the children of John Reynolds & Sara Grimes is not correct. I suggest that those members of RFA claiming these lines do additional research on their family lines.

Page: 3 Great Train Robbers Ronnie Biggs and **Bruce Reynolds** are being paid to help re-create their famous heist in a video game, it emerged today. The pair have been recruited as advisers to produce computer games for a company which describes exile Biggs' life as "the ultimate action adventure". His new role emerged as reports claimed 70-year-old Biggs had suffered his third stroke in recent days which had left him paralysed and unable to speak. Biggs, who escaped from a London prison in 1965 after serving 15 months of a 30-year sentence for his part in the GBP 2.6 million mail train heist, suffered his first stroke in March 1998. **Reynolds**, who masterminded the heist in which train driver Jack Mills was "coshed" and later died of his injuries, served ten years in prison. In the video game, the player will be able to take on the role of either Biggs or the detectives. The company behind the game, SCi Entertainment, has also secured film rights to Biggs' book, *Odd Man Out*, and is in talks with a major studio so that a film can be released at the same time as the games. Biggs, who has lived in Brazil since 1970 and faces jail if he returns to Britain, created a storm of protest last month after he appeared in advertisements for a hair-replacement treatment. SCi, which two years ago produced a controversial game in which players won points for crashing into cars and running over people, said the train robbery games would be launched in the run-up to the heist's 40th anniversary.

On Thursday of last week at the home of Allen H. Reynolds, of this place, there being an even one hundred present, and a most enjoyable time was had, and it was organized into an annual affair. Allen H. Reynolds was made President, and C. Burgess, Secretary and place a meeting next year will be in Jasper Reynolds' grove. In 1852, Gullium Reynolds and family, consisting of wife and thirteen children* left Owen Co., IND, with team of horses, wagon and

a yoke of oxen for Iowa. and settled on the hill just south of town, now owned by S. H. Britton, and was one of the earliest settlers and a good citizen, and raised a family of valuable service to the community all of which have passed to their reward, except five, Sarah M. Moons, Matilda Morris, Wealthy E. McClaran, Allen H. Reynolds and Jasper W. Reynolds, all living in or near Panora except Mrs. Matilda Morris who lives in Washington, and had not visited her old home in forty-one years. The picnic was in honor of her visit here that she might meet all her relatives. We are told they were not all present, so the family of thirteen must have followed the command of the Master, to "Multiply and Replenish the Earth." Judging from the number of relatives present. Of the six girls in the family, four married Morris brothers, one a Burgess, and the other, a McClaren. Of the Reynolds boys, two brothers married the two Anderson sisters. The oldest living of the Reynolds family is Sarah M. Morris. who is past 86 years of age. She and her husband was the fourth couple married in Guthrie County. [*According to the 1850 Census for Owen Co., IND, some of the 13 children were: Nancy J, Sarah M., Elijah, Matilda E., Isum, Welthen E., Linno A., Allen H., Willis W., Jasper W.]

Chapter LXIV.

Little Britain Township

It may be instructive to glance at these various possessions and see what has become of them. One of the first was one hundred and twenty-five acres on Octorara Creek, taken up in 1737, and sold to David Reynolds in 1771. David sold to Samuel Reynolds in 1773, who sold to Roger Teague in 1793, he to Samuel Carter in 1801, who sold to John, Abel, and Seth Kinsey in 1811. It now belongs to Samuel Connard and others, and is intersected by Raccoon Run. The village of Kinseyville is on this tract, the Kinseys having erected an extensive blacksmith-shop and tilt-hammer on the run, and built a number of houses there. Since Abel Kinsey's death it was converted into a spoke-factory, and is now used as a saw-mill. This tract was located as being in Drumore township. Two hundred and thirty acres he took up by warrant in February, 1748, and had the survey of Malcolm Fisher, of December, 1748, transferred to him, both confirmed by patent of April 14, 1752. These properties now belong to Abner C. Wood, Samuel Fite, heirs of Nathan Haines, deceased, heirs of William Hilton, deceased, and others. A tract of 145 acres was patented to Henry Reynolds, March 22, 1741, adjoining his first 300 acres. This is partly included in the

land held by Josiah Reynolds, and devised to his children, and partly held by William King, William Griffith's heirs, and others. Henry Reynolds sold 233 acres to Samuel Reynolds, 1st mo. 3, 1745, and to Henry Reynolds, Jr., 1st mo. 10, 1747-48. Samuel Reynolds took up 120 acres adjoining, and sold to his two sons, Samuel and Reuben, and now owned by the heirs of William N. Griffith, James Wood, Abner Carter, and others. Henry Reynolds took up 88 acres and allowances additional by warrant of 1745, now belonging to James Wright. In 1766 he entered an application, No. 2104, on which 102 acres was surveyed to him, and patented by the name of "Reynoldstown," now owned by heirs of John Reynolds and others.

Jackson V. Reynolds, a prominent farmer and fruit grower of White County, was born in Tennessee in 1844, and is a son of Samuel and Margaret (Maderis) Reynolds, natives of Alabama. Mr. Samuel Reynolds was born in 1808, and was married in 1831, after which he moved to Tennessee, and in 1851 came to Arkansas, settling in White County, where he bought a farm of 160 acres, on which he lived until his death, which occurred in 1861. His wife survived him some twenty years, and was the mother of nine children, three of whom are living: Jackson V. (our subject), Samuel T. and Marquis L. Jackson V. Reynolds was reared on a farm, educated in this county, and was married, in 1866, to Margaret **Thompson**, a daughter of James and Martha Thompson of Tennessee origin, and who came to Arkansas at an early day. Mrs. Reynolds died in 1880, leaving five children, four of whom are still living: Edward, Minnie, Mary and Florence. After the death of his first wife, Mr. Reynolds married Mrs. Mitchell (*nee* **McMurtry**), a widow, and by this marriage became the mother of three children: Willie, Effie and Van. In 1862 he enlisted in the Confederate army, serving in Capt. Hick's regiment, but was wounded at the battle of Helens, and received his discharge. Mr. Reynolds has a farm of 237 acres, with 140 acres under cultivation, and devotes the most of his attention to fruit growing.

[p.795] S. M. Reynolds, one of the prominent farmers and stock growers of Marion Township, is the sixth of a family of eight children born to the union of Thomas and Elizabeth (**Winters**) Reynolds, natives of Tennessee. Thomas Reynolds was a farmer

by occupation and continued this pursuit in his native State until about 1848, when he moved to Franklin County, Ark. He purchased land near Ozark, Ark., continued his former pursuit, and was among the first to settle in that county. He died in 1854 and the mother the year previous. Of their eight children, four are now living: Christopher Clolumbus (resides in Kansas), S.M., Zach (resides in Missouri), and Robert C. (who resides at Plano, Tex.). W. D. (deceased) was in the war with Mexico, and was in the battles of Buena Vists, Marengo and at the City of Mexico at the sur-render. S. M. Reynolds was born in Greene Co., Tenn., in 1846, and was reared by his brother W. D., and received his education in the common schools of Phillips and Lee Counties, Ark., as his brother moved to this State in 1859. The latter entered land and S. M. worked on the same until twenty-two years of age. In 1868 he married Miss Mary J. McGrew, of Phillips County, and the daughter of William and Sallie (Clabough) McGrew, natives of Tennessee and North Carolina, respectively. Mr. and Mrs. Reynolds are the parents of eight children: W. T., Henry L., James P., Marion F., Mary E. (deceased), Carrie A., Minnie G. and Octavus (deceased). After his marriage S. M. Reynolds moved to Sharp County, Ark., where he followed the trade of blacksmithing for about one year and then returned to Phillips County. He settled on his present property, which was owned by his wife and which consisted of 120 acres with fifty acres under cultivation. In 1802 Mr. Reynolds joined the boys in gray, Anderson's company, commanded by Dobbins, and was in the battle of Helena, July 4, 1863. He was at the surrender of Little Bock, and was also in a number of skirmishes, etc. He was captured in Phillips County, was sent to Helena and there remained for two weeks when he was paroled. This was the latter part of 1864. Mr. Reynolds was a member of the County Wheel and Farmers' Alliance, and was Vice-President of the Subordinate Wheel. He was a member of the K. of H., Spring Creek Lodge No. 2643, and was also Vice-President of this. He and Mrs. Reynolds and three of the children were members of the Christiau Church. William Reynolds, the paternal grandfather of our subject, was in the War of 1812, and the maternal grandfather, Christopher Winters, was a German, from Pennsylvania, and last resided at Charleston, Tenn.
