Cornelius Reynolds
Old Rappahannock Co., VA
Bill King

[Ed. Note: Numbers in []'s are from Tillman's 2nd
book of 1959]

Tillman has Cornelius Reynolds as a son of Thomas Reynolds [5571], Isle of Wight; Tillman appears to be incorrect.

A Cornelius Reynolds, who appears to be an immigrant & progenitor, acquired 640 acres in New Kent Co., VA on 6 June 1664. His transports include: Cornelius Reynolds, Margaret Reynolds, William Reynolds, Anne Reynolds, Cornelius Reynolds, Jr. and Susanna Reynolds. Cornelius apparently never used his 640 acres and they were picked up by others. He may have acquired other land on both sides of the Rappahannock River. One reference called him "Doctor." He ended up in Old Rappahannock Co. His will was dated November 1685; his wife was Margery; his sons, William & John, were to have of his plantation, etc.

Daughter Susanna Reynolds married Thomas Meades as her 2nd husband; Anne may have married a Graves or a Williams. I have not seen any evidence of Cornelius, Jr., and John must have been born after 1664.

On page 124 of Virginia Colonial Abstracts by Beverly Fleet, it says: "14 Dec 1705. Thomas Meades [sic] and Susanna Meades, dau of Cornelius Reynolds, dec'd, sell to John Talioferro for 6 negroes, 300 acres in the Freshes of the Rappahannock which was granted to Mr. Cornelius Reynolds 16 Apr 1683 and by him given to said Susanna as an assignment on 14 June 1683.

Summary for Cornelius Reynolds, I

1. This family always spelled their name "REYNOLDS."
2. I believe that Cornelius Reynolds is an immigrant & progenitor. He leaves a very large family line that is waiting for descendants willing to conduct research & develop their individual branch family lines.
3. Before daughter Susanna was married to Thomas Meades, she was married to a Goss and had at least one [1] child. I have been in contact with one descendant of this line.
4. This family had a tendency to marry Beazleys and Longs.

William Reynolds [5764], son of Cornelius and Margery [Margaret] Reynolds died ca 1699 in

Richmond Co., VA; his will was dated 22 Oct 1699 and was recorded 1 Jan 1700. He lists his children as Cornelius, John, William & Elizabeth. [Ed. Note: since no wife was mentioned it could be assumed that she had died by 1700.] His brother, John, was to be the executor of his will.

Tillman has this William Reynolds [5764] confused; he assigned other children to William Reynolds, including descendants of James Rennolds, Line # 35. He has William as being a son of Thomas & Mary Reynolds, Isle of Wight. Tillman was in error on these matters. Tillman also assign Cornelius Reynolds [5766] to this family. I doubt this: the dates don't seem right. I believe that Cornelius Reynolds [5766] to be a descendant of William Reynolds' [5764] brother, John Reynolds. I do not know what became of William's sons, John & William; I have been unable to track them.

Recorded transactions:

William Reynolds, 25 Jan 1682, "unto Anne Williams, being a gift from subscriber."

William Reynolds received 900 acres from Edwin Conway which was in the County of Rappahannock or the north side of the Rappahannock River above Chengeteague Creek and beginning of Pacopescon Springs - 5 May 1692.

John Reynolds, Parish of St. Mary's, to Richard Talioferro, county of Essex, lands containing approx. 200 acres, being part of a patent of 500 acres granted to William Reynolds, deceased, and the said John Reynolds from the Proprietor of Northern Neck—15 Oct 1697; starts on Robert Payne's line - dwelling house of William Reynolds - down to the River, the river being the natural boundary. 4 July 1704.

John Reynolds, carpenter, St. Mary's, Essex Co., to Brumfield Long of Parish of St. Mary's of Richmond Co., land formally in occupation of Cornelius Reynolds, 52 acres next to Richard Talioferro's land, land in Richmond Co. - sealed in the presence of Cornelius Reynolds - 14 Apr 1713.

Cornelius Reynolds, Parish of St. Anne of Essex Co. and John Reynolds the Younger the same parish and county, to Henry Long, Parish of St. Mary, Richmond Co., land running into Cingateag Creek, along Simon Miller's, Henry Long & Brumfield Long, which he had by his late marriage with Elizabeth his now wife, being a pact of land granted by Proprietor Northern Neck [500] acres unto John

Reynolds and William Reynolds – 166 acres given by their late father, William Reynolds, deceased – 6 Apr 1713.

Cornelius Reynolds of Essex Co., will of 15 Apr 1734, cites his wife, Martha, daughters Sarah, Anne, Margaret, Mary & Elizabeth; sons William & Cornelius; William is to have his land.

Martha Rennolds of Essex Co, will of 10 Mar 1753, cites children: Cornelius Reynolds, Elizabeth Rucker, Ann Beazley, Margaret Scandall and Mary Goode; also a grandson, Cornelius, son of William, deceased.

**Summary for William Reynolds,
son of Cornelius Reynolds, I**

1. William died ca 1699 having 4 young children: Cornelius, who has a traceable family and died ca 1734, his wife, Martha, died 1753 [at that time they had moved to Essex Co., VA]; John, the Younger, was around in Richmond Co. until 1713; William disappears and Elizabeth was probably married to Brumfield Long by 1713 in Richmond Co.
2. Descendants of William Reynolds are traceable: positively through his son Cornelius [wife Martha]. Children of Cornelius & Martha Reynolds:
 - a. William; was married & had a son, Cornelius. Could this Cornelius be the one who chose Catharine Reynolds as his guardian [1652]?
 - b. Anne married James Beazley;
 - c. Sarah married ca 1742/45 probably Peter Dishman*;
 - d. Margaret married a Mr. Scandall;
 - e. Mary married a Mr. Goode;
 - f. Elizabeth married Thomas Rucker*;
 - g. Cornelius?

- RFA has/had members who descend from these lines; I would like to see them change their lineages to this, the Cornelius Reynolds Line.

John Reynolds, son of Cornelius Reynolds, I

John Reynolds, son of Cornelius & Margaret Reynolds, died in St. Mary's Parish, Essex Co., VA ca 1716. His will was dated 4 Nov 1716; his wife was not mentioned in his will. He left property to his three eldest sons: John, Joseph & Thomas; and his 2 younger, underage sons, Richard & Cornelius. His son John was designated to be his Executor. I have always assumed that there were daughters but none were mentioned in his will.

John received land with his brother William on the north side of the Rappahannock River [see above]. However, early in the 1700's, he removed himself to Essex Co. where he died. Most of John Reynolds' sons are identifiable in Essex & Caroline Counties, VA. Thomas [wife Mary] died in 1732; Joseph [with his wife, Mary] went her bond. The brothers had a tendency to name sons after their brothers. Thus there are many Cornelius', Joseph's and Thomases; there are a number of Johns and Williams as well. A number of these Reynolds' died without wills. Caroline Co. is a burnt out county; research of these families is not easy. However, there are still facts to be found if one works at the research of the existing county records.

**Summary of John Reynolds,
son of Cornelius Reynolds, I**

Eventually, we will find that the descendants of John Reynolds will outnumber any of the other branches of this family.

Comments on some of his children are as follows:

- a. I have commented above on Joseph, Thomas & Richard.
- b. I believe that Cornelius Reynolds, married to Rachel, who died in Orange Co., is the son of John. Cornelius, with wife Rachel, was in Caroline Co. in 1739. This is the earliest Cornelius I saw [other than the Cornelius who married Martha]; thus, it makes sense that this Cornelius is the son of John Reynolds.
- c. There were two John Reynolds' who died 1754/55 – they could have been the sons or grandsons of either William or John Reynolds. One married an Eliza; the other a Sarah. At any rate, in 1755 a Thomas, son of John, chose Robert Pickett the Younger as guardian and

in 1756 John Boutwell was appointed guardian for Francis Reynolds.

- d. More than one William Reynolds died in the 1750's & 1760's.
- e. In 1738, Cornelius Reynolds was adjudged to be 14 years old.
- f. In 1752, a Cornelius Reynolds chose Catherine Reynolds to be his guardian. This Cornelius Reynolds married a Molly and had 15 children [William, Fanny, Tabitha, Sally, Martha, Catherine, John, Charles, Robert, Richard, Nancy, Molly, Spencer, Thomas and Cornelius {the last 7 were underage in 1793 when Cornelius the father died.}].
- g. Cindy Thomas [RFA Member] says that Cornelius Reynolds' wife Rachel most likely had children Richard, Joseph B., Tabitha, Sarah & Aaron [this is a tentative list of their children].
- h. The Cornelius Reynolds [may have died 1760] whose family was in Spotsylvania Co., VA, had children: Joseph, Cornelius, John, Richard, Robert, Ann & Martha.
- i. The Cornelius Reynolds who died in Harrison Co., VA/WVA in 1810 had children Cornelius, Jr., John, Anne, Patty & Elizabeth by his first wife; Sarah and Silas by his second wife. Both wives were named Elizabeth.
- j. Then there was Joseph Reynolds of Caroline Co. [who Tillman says was married to Elizabeth Herndon] who died 1772. Before he died, Joseph gave his sons William, Joseph & Benjamin property in Orange Co.; I will address him in a separate article.
- k. The John Reynolds who married Elizabeth Brickley in Richmond Co., VA might be of this family. I will also address this in a separate article.

As I have mentioned before, this is a work in progress and no one should consider what has been presented as the final word. This line is waiting for individuals to step forward and finish this research.

[Ed. Note: First date = Date Written; Second date = Prove Date]

Mary Brown. Widow of Jeremiah. West Nottingham. 11/9/1769. Nov. 30, 1769. To step-grandson Stephen son of Isaac Brown £20 being the payment coming to me from Esther Brown, at interest until he is 21. Best wearing apparel to be sent to my 3 sisters Elizabeth, Abigail and Catherine in Ireland. To cousin Elizabeth Thornton now living in Carolina £20. To Mary wife of Henry Reynolds case of drawers which was her mother's. To Sarah daughter of Isaac Brown riding mare and saddle. To Mary Lockland, my maid, bed at 18. All remainder to Elisha, Mary, Jeremiah and Saml., children of Joshua Brown, and George, Jeremiah, Isaac and Elisha, children of Isaac Brown. Executors: Elisah son of Joshua and Jeremiah son of Isaac Brown.

John Day. Nottingham (or so reputed). May 18, 1774. Mar. 28, 1775. Provides for wife Lydia. To eldest son John my plantation in York Co. which he now lives on. To second son Joseph my land and tanyard in Virginia bought of Stephen Ross. To eldest daughter Rebecca wife of Jacob Reynolds £10. To daughter Catharine wife of Jos. Wood £10. To youngest son George plantation I now live on in East Nottingham with tanyard. To grandson John Day son of John £25 at 21. Executors: Wife Lydia and son George.

Margery Baker. Widow. Chichester. 6/3/1773. Dec. 11, 1776. To daughter Mary Dickey the cow and to son Richard Baker the large Bible. My slave Adam to be free at my decease and £20 given for his

maintenance if he should become incapable. All remainder to be divided among my children, viz., Mary Dickey, Sarah **Reynolds**, Richard, Robert and Wm. Baker and Lydia Grubb. Executors: Son Richard Baker and Benj. **Reynolds**.

Thomas Withers of Chichester. March 29, 1720. 2/15/1720. A. 90. To son Robert, all my right to my improvement on tract of land in Nottingham near Octararo Creek and moveables on the same. To son Ralph, my plantation in Chichester containing 232 acres, subject to life int of wife Jane. To daughters Mary Hughs, Jane and Elizabeth Withers £16 each. Mentions that Jeremiah Collet Sr. late of Chichester devised into his 5 children above named, £15 each which had not all been paid, evidently their grandfather. Remainder to wife, also executor. Witnesses: Wm. Brown Sr., Henry **Reynolds**, Wm. **Reynolds**.

Henry **Reynolds** of Chichester. April 12, 1720. 8/16/1724. A. 164. To son Francis the plantation where I live in Chichester containing 290 acres, he paying his brother William when 21, £20. To son John, tract of land in Chichester, containing 210 acres, paying his brother Wm. £20. To son Henry tract of land in Nottingham containing 490 acres. To son Wm, tract in Nottingham [being a south lott], containing 490 acres. To each of my daughters, viz Margaret, Prudence, Deborah and Hannah 1 shilling each. To wife Prudence all personal estate, also executrix. Witnesses: William Clayton, John Hanby.

William **Reynolds** of Hopewell. Prove Date: 26 Feb 1769. Wife. Children, Mary, Agness and Margaret **Reynolds**, all minors. An unborn child. Bro. James **Reynolds**. Exs., Francis Campbell and Benjamin Blyth.
