**Rappahannock River Reynolds Series – Part IV
James Rennolds of Gloucester & Essex Co.'s, VA
Submitted by Bill King**

James Reynolds first shows up in Petsal Parish, Gloucester Co., VA in 1676/76 when he is a land-owner. A James and Thomas Reynolds are head-rights of William Young in Stafford Co., VA in 1669. A James Reynolds was to give Richard Dempster 6 years [Virginia] in 1662, per Peter Wilson Coldham. William & Ann Reynolds of Northumberland Co., VA had a son, James, who died abt. 1677/78. These are the only James Reynolds' that I have seen referenced to in the VA colony before 1675; thus, the first two are candidates for being James Reynolds.

James Reynolds used the spelling "Rennolds" as early as 1687 & almost always used this spelling after 1703. This branch of the family still uses this version.

In 1675, James Reynolds married Sarah [?] and may have had one or two children by then. He bought & sold land. He was married to Susannah [?] in 1703, and they gave his sons, James II & Thomas, 500 acres of land each. After that, he was in Essex Co., VA.

In 1712, Thomas Rennolds, son of James & Sarah, died and by his will gave his estate to his brother, James, and sisters, Sarah & Elizabeth.

In his will of 8 Feb 1723/24, James Reynolds 1st left one-third of his estate to his wife, Susanna, and both land & property to each of his living children: James, Jr., and Elizabeth Barnes of his first marriage, and Violetta, Benjamin, Hannah, Susanna and Joseph of his second. He left land to grandson, William, son of James, Jr.; and property to a Gordon Andrew Rennolds [At present, I do not any information on who Gordon Reynolds is.]

Tillman calls James Rennolds, William Reynolds [T2-5964] the son of Thomas Reynolds of the Isle of Wight Co., VA. Tillman is incorrect on both issues;

he also has William Reynolds' children mixed up between at least two different families. Tillman should be ignored as the book relates to this James Rennolds family.

Second Generation of James Rennolds 1st

James Rennolds II was married to Sarah by 1703 and the family was in So. Farnham Parish in Essex Co. until at least 1743. After that, it appears that the family moved to St. Ann's Parish. This James Rennolds had a single estate; his will was written 20 Oct 1750 and was recorded 1 Oct 1751. He left land and/or property to children: William, James III, John, Robert, Elizabeth and Mary. James II left dowers rights to his wife, Sarah, and appointed her, with sons William & James III, his executors.

Sarah Rennolds died abt. 1774 and in her will, she left ½ of her estate to her daughter, Mary Sales, wife of Leonard Sales; and ¼ estate to each of her sons, James & Robert.

Tillman has many mistakes in this James Rennolds family. Please see his T2-5904 through T2-5930 and note the differences [in particular, the names of spouses]. Where Tillman is wrong, mistaken or has missing information, ignore Tillman.

Sarah Rennolds. I found no evidence that Sarah ever married, and so have assumed that she died between 1712 and 1723 without heirs.

Thomas Rennolds was a witness in Gloucester Co., VA in 1698; in 1707, Thomas Rennolds' land was adjacent to John Parker's. In Thomas' will of 25 Sept 1712, he gave his estate to his brother James, and his sisters, Sarah & Elizabeth. From this one may assume that he had probably not married, had no children & was a child of the marriage of James & Sarah Rennolds and that James II, Sarah & Elizabeth were his only living siblings.

Tillman shows this Thomas as being Thomas Reynolds [T2-6091], a son of Thomas & Mary Reynolds of Isle of Wight Co., VA; Tillman is wrong. Who the descendants, as shown by Tillman for Thomas [T2-6091] are is not known; the information shown should be used with caution.

Elizabeth Rennolds. Apparently Elizabeth Rennolds, the dtr of James & Sarah, married a [??] Barnes; I could find no evidence of Barnes in Essex Co., VA.

3rd Generation of James 1st First Family

William Reynolds, son of James Rennolds III, died in 1761. He left his wife & Ann Rennolds, the dtr. Of Simon Miller, property. His wife, Elizabeth, did not contest the will.

James Reynolds, son of James Rennolds III, was married to Catherine & he died in 1771; she died in 1777. In his will, he asked that his children finish building his house [this house is very likely the one in Essex Co., VA near Roxburg called the 'Greenway'.]

In his will, he named his wife and most of his children:

1. **Robert Rennolds**, who married Anne. This Robert Rennolds was born 1740/45 and disappeared from Essex Co.;
2. **James Rennolds**, who married Sukey, was still living in 1803. he & Sukey had children: James, Lindsey & Richard, who married Ann Clift;
3. **William Rennolds** who married Sally & had: James, William, Catherine [m. (1) Ezekiel Talbot; (2) Robert Owen], Elizabeth [m. Jesse Owen], Thomas, John, Alicey & Lucy. The last four children were born after 1783. After William died there was a chancery suit to settle his estate. Sally remarried to Anthony Sales. Sally, Anthony Sales and all of her children [except James] were in KY in 1812;
4. **John Rennolds** married Mary. He died in 1797; she abt. 1813. Their children were: Mary [m. John Willer], Sally [m. Richard Rennolds], Margaret [m. David Dishman (?)], Sydney [m. Phillip Rennolds (?)], Nancy [m. a Gray], James, Andrew, Daniel & Lewis;
5. **Catherine Rennolds** married Thomas Hawkins; their children were William, Elizabeth [m. Henry Gray] & Caty [m. William Hord].

[Note: A James Rennolds m. Betsey Beagley in 1803 and a James Rennolds m. Frances Thorp abt. 1815. Who are they?]

John Rennolds, son of James Rennolds II, married Elizabeth [Scheshley] Lason; they had considerable property. Their children were:

1. **Sarah**, who m. a Mr. Hipkins; their children were Elizabeth, Lucy, Alice, Leroy, John Otway, Battram & Griffin;

2. **John** married Lady Ashley and lived in London, UK, dying in 1831;
3. **Scheshley** married Martha Daingerfield Beale. Their children were Martha, Mary, John, William D., Albert, Henry S., Otway, Arthur F., Robert, Susan, Emily & Louisa. Several died young.

Robert Rennolds, son of James II married, some say, to Ann; although I have never seen his wife's name mentioned. His will of 8 Dec 1780 [rec. 20 Aug 1781], gave slaves to dtr Ann, wife of Reuben Chapman, grandson Robert Chapman; dtr Sally Rennolds; dtr. Martha; son Robert; son Reuben; grandson Robert Coleman Miller Scott and his land in Essex Co. to son Robert; the land in Caroline Co., VA to son Reuben. Son Reuben, and possibly dtr's Sally & Martha, were all underage at the time of Robert's will. Son Robert Rennolds was to manage his brother's [Reuben's] property until he came of age.

Robert's children:

1. **Ann Rennolds** m. Reuben Chapman and had at least one son, Robert, who m. Betsey Sutton, dtr. Of William Sutton [her paternal grandfather was John Carter]. Robert & Betsey had the following children: William, John, James, Martha, Elsey, Sarah, Ann, Lucy, Carter, Joseph & Robert Reynolds Chapman;
2. **Sally**, born by 1760;
3. **Martha**, born aft. 1760;
4. **Robert Rennolds, Jr.**, b. 1750/55 was in the area until his brother Reuben became of age. After this time, he disappeared. This Robert Rennolds then becomes a candidate for having moved elsewhere between 1790-1795;
5. **Mary** m. James Scott [I believe] and they at least one son: Robert Coleman Miller Scott;
6. **Reuben** received his father's land in Caroline Co., by 1795; he paid taxes on this land through 1803, at which time he sold it to Thomas Broadus. After this time, I saw no evidence of Reuben Rennolds in Caroline Co.; I believe he moved elsewhere.

Elizabeth Rennolds, daughter of James Rennolds II, died in 1760. In her will, she left parts of

her estate to various female members of her family who were still living at the time. She named: Sister Mary Rennolds; Sarah, dtr of John Rennolds; Catherine, dtr. Of James Rennolds; Mary, Ann & Sarah, dtr.'s of Robert Rennolds; brother John Rennolds' dtr Sarah; brother James' dtr. Catherine & Robert Rennolds wife [unnamed].

Mary Rennolds, daughter of James Rennolds II, married Leonard Sales. Leonard was the son of Anthony Sales of Caroline Co., VA and the grandson of Cornelius Sales. Mary & Leonard had the following children:

1. William Brooklyn Sales m. Nancy [Ann];
2. Capt. Leonard Sales m. Mildred;
3. Elizabeth Sales;
4. Sally Sales;
5. Suca Sales.

[Note: Many of James Rennolds' descendants by his first marriage still remain in the Essex Co., VA area and still go by the 'Rennolds' spelling.]

Reynolds of South Carolina
Dorothy W. Smith

To all those using the Reynolds Family book by Col. S.F. Tillman, published 1959: The SC connection on page 282, #6096 William Reynolds and #6097 Harriet Reynolds, his daughter who married first William Otis Prentiss and second William Fripp, has **NO CONNECTION** to the VA line Tillman is tracing. In fact, #6096 William Reynolds (born 1751), father of Sarah Harriet, is the only known son of William Reynolds (Will dated 1754) and Eleanor Ireland Scott the widow of Joseph Scott (her will dated 1771).

William Reynolds' (#6096, father of Harriet) gravestone is on private property just off Seaside Rd. on St. Helena's Island, SC. He died 27 August 1798. His wife, Sarah Harriet Reynolds Prentiss Fripp's mother was Ann Capers (1710-1854).

This SC Colonial Reynolds' family appeared first in SC just previous to 1700 and married their cousins forming a web of relationships as they married into many other Low Country SC families. St. Helena's Parish records Doc. them through several generations. This Reynolds' family appears to have no connection to any other Reynolds' family from New England or VA as implied by Tillman.

In 1986, Descendants of Benjamin Reynolds And

Richard Reynolds of SC was published by Reynolds & Day and traced this family with many wills, Doc.s, etc. In 2000, the second edition of this book was published by Annie Day & Dorothy W. Smith (this writer) & is available in SC Libraries as well as many others.

My advice is to beware of Col. Tillman's information.
