**Robert & Frances Reynolds - Richmond Co., VA
Henry Pannell Reynolds - Old Rappahannock,
Richmond Co., VA

Tillman has Robert Reynolds [5586], who m. Frances LNU, as being the son of John Reynolds & Sara Grimes; this is incorrect. Robert is the son of Henry Pannell Reynolds.

Henry Reynolds was in evidence for 10 - 15 years in Old Rappahannock, Richmond Co., VA; the only child I could identify as his was Robert. Tillman has more than 1 sibling shown for Robert & is incorrect. Henry d. abt. 1680.

Robert Reynolds was m. to Frances by 1699 & had: 2 sons named Daniel, Rebecca, Wilmarth [?], Grenier & Robert, Jr. [most of these children d. young]. Robert, Jr. was b. abt. 1720; he & wife, Ann, moved to Westmoreland Co., VA where Robert d. 1744 & Ann in 1746. They had 3 children: Wilmarth [1738 - 1746], Betty [1740 - 1746] & John [d. 1746]. The male heirs of Henry Reynolds' line appear to have died out at this time.

Tillman shows additional children for Robert, Jr.: William Archelius, Benjamin [5747], Jane [5747],

Vincent, Mary & Sally. While these individuals existed, they are not the children of this Robert & Ann Reynolds; some may be the children of John Reynolds & Betty Brickley.

Summary

Henry Reynolds seems to be a progenitor; his male line ends with his grandson Robert Reynolds' children dying in 1746. Robert may have had a dtr who lived long enough to marry.

John Reynolds & Elizabeth 'Betty' Brickley - Richmond Co., VA

A John Reynolds m. Elizabeth Brickley [d. 1796], the dtr of John & Sara Brickley. John Reynolds lived in the Lunenburg Parish area of Richmond Co., VA & I could not find a relationship with this John and the Jeffery/John/George Reynolds family line. Thus, I assume him to be of the Cornelius Reynolds line. [Note: Some of Cornelius' line lived in the Lunenburg Parish area earlier].

John & Elizabeth Betty Brickley had the following children: George [b. 1752], John [b. 1754], William [b. 1755], James, Elizabeth Davis, Joseph, Reuben, Vincent, Sally [m. Brown Robinson 1789] & Fanny. Some likely families of John & Elizabeth's children: George: m. Ann [her 2nd husband was a Robert Reynolds] and had Jane.

William: m. Ann Thornton, dtr of Thomas & Elizabeth, and had Thomas T., William, Vincent, John & Betty T.

James: m., as his 1st wife, Elizabeth Sisson, & had: Winney, Joseph, Henry, Conner & Elizabeth.

Conclusions:

[1] 1 Dec 1800, Robert & Ann Reynolds, his wife, & Jane, his dtr., & only heir of George Reynolds' sell 38.75 acres formerly belonging to John Reynolds, dec'd, to Thomas T. Reynolds.

[2] Tillman has William Reynolds [5635] as a Rev. War soldier; this meshes with the information above, with the exception that he adds another son, Henry. My judgment is that most of Tillman's information on this William Reynolds extended family is believable.

[3] Mar 1823, deed of gift by James Reynolds to the children listed above. My guess is that James Reynolds remarried about this time.

[4] The records show that on 3 Aug 1818, Alice Reynolds is appointed guardian to her son, Edwin James Reynolds. Who is Alice? Probably the wife of Vincent Reynolds, who Tillman has m. to Elizabeth Alloway, with 1 of their sons being Edwin J. Reynolds.

[5] In her will [7 Oct 1796] Betty Reynolds names her children in the following manner: dtr, Fanny Reynolds, son Vincent, Jane Reynolds, dtr of George Reynolds; sons of John, William & James; dtr Elizabeth Davis; 5 children: Joseph, Reuben, Vincent, Sally Robinson & Fanny Reynolds. There appear to have been 10 children.

Summary

John Reynolds m. to Betty Brickley appears to be of the Cornelius Reynolds line [but must be proven]; most of their children are traceable to Richmond or Westmoreland Co., VA.

Jeffery Reynolds – Old Rappahannock, Richmond Co., VA

Jeffery Reynolds is claimed by Tillman to be a son of John Reynolds & Sara Grimes. This does not appear to be correct. Jeffery was a boy servant of James Claughter and judged to be age 13 [Northumberland Co. records 31 Jul 1780], which makes his birth date abt. 1667 or some 7 years before John & Sara married.

Jeffery m. Ann LNU & had at least 3 children: Elizabeth, b. 1697, John, b~1700 & Susannah. Jeffery died abt. 1728.

Jeffery & Ann's son, John, also m. an Ann & they had at least 1 son, George. At this point, Tillman has this family so mixed up that I am unable to make a reasonable analysis of what the facts support. John Reynolds' widow, Ann, m. [2] Richard Neale 4 Mar 1762; Tillman has Neale marrying Ann, the dtr of Robert Reynolds Sr. [5586]. It has been suggested that the John Reynolds, who m. Betty Brinkley, may also be a son of John & Ann & a brother to George. I can find no facts to support this relationship; & have thus assumed that he is of another family [probably that of the Cornelius family line].

George Reynolds, the son of John & Ann, was borne bef. 1735 & died abt. 1778. He m. a Frances, who d. 1782; their children were: John [b.~1760], William, George, Eprophrodites, Frances, Ann,

Elizabeth [b. 1777] & one other [1779?]. These children are named in his will; & it would appear that many of these children left the Richmond Co., VA area.

The Jeffery/John/George Reynolds family line all lived in the No. Farnham Parish area of Richmond Co., VA.

Tillman has George Reynolds [5673] as a son of Robert Reynolds Sr. [5586], which is incorrect. He also has George marrying Frances Barber 12 Dec 1757, which may be correct. Their children, as shown by Tillman, were: John Burtinwell [b. 1760], Anthony [b. 1761 & Bartemous [b. 1769]. John Burtinwell Reynolds may be John's son, if only it could be proven [I have seen a reference to John Burtinwell Reynolds in Northumberland Co., VA]. I have no idea who Anthony Reynolds is, but Tillman has an extended family shown for him. Tillman shows Bartemous Reynolds [5753] as a son of William Archelius Reynolds [5753] & grandson & great-grandson of Robert Reynolds' Jr. [5747] & Sr. [5672], respectively. I believe that Bartemous is a son of William Archelius Reynolds but that William Archelius Reynolds is not a son of Robert Reynolds, Jr. [5742]. I believe that William Archelius Reynolds is a descendent of the Thomas Reynolds & Susan Snead line of York/Kent Co., VA. I believe that this can be proved: some of the unaccounted for children whom Tillman has shown as being Robert Reynolds, Sr.'s look a lot more like some of the children of John Reynolds 7 Elizabeth/Betty Brickley.

Summary

Jeffery Reynolds appears to be a progenitor & has a traceable family in Richmond Co., VA. Anthony & Bartemous are not children of George Reynolds; John Burtinwell may or may not be.

Bernard Reynolds – Caroline & Russell Co.'s, VA

Tillman has Bernard Reynolds [6916] from Caroline Co., VA as having been a Revolutionary war soldier. The personal information listed by Tillman for Bernard is very good. Unfortunately, Tillman has Bernard as being a son of James Reynolds [6508] & Sukie Lindsay; this is incorrect. Also, I see no evidence of this James & Sukie Reynolds ever being in Caroline Co., VA.

Bernard Reynolds is the son of John & Elizabeth Rennolds, the grandson of Benjamin & Sarah Rennolds and the great grand son of James and Susannah Rennolds of Essex & Caroline Co.'s, VA [Line 35].

Bernard and his, Robert [my ancestor] joined the same military unit at the same time; both leave DAR papers on them.

In a chancery suit for the settlement of the estates of John Rennolds and his brother, James, in Caroline Co., Robert and Bernard are named as children of John Reynolds.

Summary

Bernard Reynolds/Rennolds is a son of John & Elizabeth Rennolds & is of the James & Susannah Rennolds line [Line 35].

John & Elizabeth Rennolds' children were: Robert, Bernard, Jacob & Lucy.

There are RFA members who list Bernard as their ancestor. I would like to see them correct their lineage records to show Bernard Reynolds' correct ancestry.

Cornelius Reynolds – Caroline Co., VA/Lincoln Co., KY/Saline Co., MO

Tillman shows Cornelius Reynolds [5929] as the son of William Rennolds [5905] of Caroline Co., VA; this information is incorrect. The remaining information for Cornelius Reynolds, as shown by Tillman, is for his second wife & their children [1 son, William M., b. 1840, is missing from the listing].

Cornelius Reynolds/Rennolds was born in Caroline Co., VA abt. 1800, the son of Robert Rennolds-/Reynolds & Dolly Robinson. He moved with his parents to Lincoln Co., KY ca 1806. He was one of the administrators of his brother's, Larkin Reynolds', nuncupative will [18 Dec 1823]. Cornelius married Angelina Hocker in Lincoln Co. on 9 Sept 1821.

Recent information from Penny Jalbert says that Cornelius' family consisted of: his 1st wife, Angelina Hocker; children: Margaret Ann [b.~1822], Manerva [b.~1824]; his 2nd wife, Evalina Thornton [m. 1827], children: Robert b. 1828, Peter Thornton b 1830, Larkin R. b. 1831, Cornelius b. 1832, Sophia b. 1839, William M. b. 1840 & Mary Virginia b. 1842.

The chancery suit documents for the settlement of Robert & Dolly Reynolds' estate beginning in 1847 in Lincoln Co., KY, indicated that their son, Cornelius, was deceased and that they did not know if he had any heirs. The chancery records were later corrected by input from Robert Reynolds, Jr., of Howard Co., MO [his brother] who knew who Cornelius's children were.

Biographical records of this Reynolds family of Saline Co., MO say that Cornelius came from VA to

MO & took up land in Howard Co. About 1830, he removed to Saline Co. where he purchased a farm and spent the remainder of his life. Most of these records are about members of his son Peter Thornton Reynolds' family. Peter married Martha Gilmor and their children were: John, Robert Major, Mollie Malard, Peter, William A. [Alexander?] & Esma Grube. Cornelius' son, Cornelius, was married to Sarah Hancock and their children were: Evalina A., John F., Elizabeth F., J. I., Ernst, Cordia & Cornelius.

Summary

Cornelius Reynolds is the son of Robert Rennolds/Reynolds & Dolly Robinson; and is of the James & Susannah Rennolds family line [line 35].

Cornelius Reynolds died in Saline Co., MO 2 Nov 1842 & left an extensive family in MO.
