**MORE ABOUT
JAMES OREMANDEL REYNOLDS**
Contributed by Susan Rogers Clement

In the March-April issue of *Reynolds Recollections* Susan Phaneuf contributed an article about the town of Pittsburg, New Hampshire. At the end of her delightful article she mentioned that the first Reynolds family in Pittsburg was an import from Maine, named James O. Reynolds. She noted that it appeared that James was the son of Nathan Perry Reynolds and Flora Staples. However, James O. Reynolds was actually the son of Lewis Lincoln Reynolds and Sarah Meserve (Braley) Reynolds.

I have known James O[remandel] for many years through my work on the Election Reynolds line. However, it is not unusual or unlikely that any one of the multiple "Mainiac" Reynolds is ascribed to the incorrect family. When Maine was wilderness and part of Massachusetts, right after the Revolutionary War, many Massachusetts soldier-pioneers claimed stakes to cheap land in Maine and moved their families north. I am sure that I can name at least 5 such Reynolds family lines, including several brothers and cousins from the Election line. But, thanks to Susan, I can now add a little more information about James Oremandel's family to my files.

The information on James Oremandel and his family has been compiled through the efforts of several Election Reynolds family researchers. Besides the work that I have personally done, contributions were also made by Arthur Ward Reynolds and Linda T. Cloutier. Some information was taken from George L. Randall, *Braley Genealogy*, New Bedford MA, 1913 and from Millicent B. Reynolds, "Election Reynolds of Salem and Middleboro, MA," *RFA Centennial Collection*, 1992.

James' birth date was recorded in the Family Bible that belonged originally to Joseph and Thankful (Wadleigh) Huff, which was in possession of Arthur W. Reynolds (now deceased). His marriage was found in *RFA Centennial Collection*, "Miscellaneous Records of New Hampshire," p.107, marriage record of "James O. Reynolds, 26, farmer, b. Maine, s. of Lewis and Sarah Reynolds, and Eliza L. Gault, 15, b. Pittsburg, d. of William H. and Sarah (Day) Gault, by E.C. Sawyer, J. of P., Pittsburg".

James was a hunter and sporting camp operator in the Rangely area. He was nicknamed "Old Rawhide."

BION, SON OF THOMAS, REYNOLDS
From Glenn G. Reynolds, M.D.

Bion Orville Reynolds, son of Thomas and Paulina

(Cobb) **Reynolds**, was born 12 October in Lena, Stephenson Co. IL, and died 13 Jul 1937 in Riverside, Riverside Co. CA. He married 25 Apr 1885 in Makoketa, Jackson County, IA, **Lucy Ellen Streeter**. They are both buried in the Olive View Cemetery, in Riverside, California.

Bion was a Pattern Maker, by profession. He worked in Dubuque, Iowa for a firm of **Conker and Schrieber**. It is stated that while in their employ he designed and invented "The Backspace" principle and key for the typewriter. Subsequently he turned to farming, at least on a part time basis. The family subsequently moved to Stuart, Guthrie County, Iowa, so that his children could have a Christian Education in the Adventist School there. This was followed by a move for similar reasons to The Oak Park Academy, School, and The Iowa Sanitarium and Hospital, in Nevada, Story County, Iowa. During the later time he became a licensed Minister for the church, and worked as a Chaplin in the Sanitarium.

He lost his wife **Lucy Streeter Reynolds**, in the mid 1915's. He subsequently remarried **Emma Heim**. In 1929, when his second son **Harry Clyde Reynolds** graduated from Medical School, his son **Earl** and Earl's son **Glenn**, took the train from California to Chicago, and Nevada, Story Co., Iowa.

They then took Bion and Emma's car, and drove them out to Riverside, California, via Texas, New Mexico and Arizona, often on gravel roads. They lived until their death, near **Harry Reynolds'** medical office in Arlington, California. they are both buried in the Olive View Cemetery, in Riverside, California.

Earl studied for the ministry at Emanuel Missionary College, (now An6, then went to the college of Medical Evangelists (Now Loma Linda University) in late 1916 and 1917 and graduated as Physician's Assistant, subsequently worked as a clergy intern, where he met **Maude Lower**. They were in 1919 appointed as Missionaries to North India. His career led him back to the USA in 1926, with service in Southern CA and HI. Here Maude died in 1932. He returned to So. CA, where he met and married **Opal Haworth**. Further service was in So and No CA, India (now Pakistan), AZ, CA, MI, CA; toward the end of his career he became a Chaplain at Loma Linda University.

Dr. Earl Robert Reynolds, Jr. or Bob, as he prefers to be called, was born 1 Dec 1933, King Edward VII Hospital, Lahore, Punjab, India; m. **Betty Evelyn Whitaker**, 27 May 1945 La Sierra, Riverside CA, who was b. 5 Dec 1925 at Loma Linda. He did ministerial work for several years in CA. He and Betty took up education for the Seventh Day Adventist Church, in Pakistan. Bob sustained a gunshot wound to the head, while teaching at Chuharkhana Mandi, Shekupurra District, Pakistan, in Oct 1966, and has been retired since that time. He lives with his wife Betty, in Norman (West Central) AR.

Glenn George Reynolds, M.D., b. 28 Nov 1925, Najibabad, Binjor Dist., United Provinces, British India; m. (1st) **Lois Ruth Mills**, Aug 1948, who was born 7 Nov 1924 Los Angeles CA; (2nd) **Margaret Ann Lee**, 31 Jan 1959 Annapolis, Anne Arundel Co. MD; (3rd) **Barbara Jane Martin Niews**, 8 Oct 2005 San Marin, Los Angeles Co. CA, who was b. 24 Aug 1928 Glendale, Los Angeles Co. CA.

Glenn was born in the village of Najibabad, in the United Provinces of Agra and Oudh, near the site where the Ganges River flows out of the Milalayan Mountains. Glenn is retired from the medical practice of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, and Electro-diagnostic Medicine. He is a Veteran of WW II,

where as a St. First Class, he managed the Discharge and Separation Center for the Enemy to Camp Beale, Marysville, CA. He took his medical degree at Loma Linda U; his post graduate work in Rehab Medicine was done at NY U, Bellevue Medical center.

He subsequently practiced and taught in or about Washington DC. He was Assoc. Professor at Georgetown U. Then appointed to same post as Chair person of the PM&R at Stanford U. and Santa Clara Valley Medical Center.

It was at the latter that he became one of the seven founders of the American Spinal Injury Assoc. and developed the Center for Brain Trauma Rehabilitation, as well as the Birth Defects Clinic, and the Amputee and Burn Rehab Programs. He was president of the Reynolds Family Association 1990-1995.

Gerald Mervale Reynolds, D.D.S., b 7 Mar 1929 Los Angeles CA. He m. (1st) **Beverly Ann Marsh**, 30 May 1955 Lincoln NE who was b. 16 Jun 1930 Lincoln NE. (2nd) **Roma Carolyn Evens**, 21 Mar 1970 in CA, who was b. 23 Aug 1930, Ilo Ilo, Panay, Territory of the Philippines.

He is a practicing Dental Surgeon in Yuba City and South Lake Tahoe CA. His undergrad education was completed at La Sierra U., Arlington CA in 1951. He subsequently taught High School Science courses in suburban Washington DC, where he also took a Masters in research and industrial pharmacology. He then worked for Hazelton Labs, Vienna VA.

He completed the degree Doctor of Dental Science at Loma Linda U., College of Dentistry, in 1970. For several years he served in the U.S. Naval Reserve at rank of Lt. Commander. He became interested in forensic dentistry, putting the scientific focus on a mass murder suspect, that led to the conviction of **Juan Corona**. He took post graduate course in Forensic Dental Pathology at the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology at Walter Reed Hospital-Armed Forces School of Medicine, in Washington DC.

He has since been a visiting Professor of Forensic Dentistry at the U. of CA, San Francisco and is past president of the American Society of Forensic Odontology. He and his wife, **Carolyn Evens Reynolds, R.N., M.S.** live and work in and from Penn Valley, CA.

Letter to Mrs. Jellinghaus of RFA 21 Jun 1983:

The information I have is that three Reynolds brothers, John, Thomas and another sailed from a port in South Scotland and arrived in Norfolk VA in the early 1700s.

John was in Cecil Co. MD in 1723/4 as a witness to the will of Isaac Van Bibber. The migration to Western VA is sketchy, however, I did find a John Reynolds in Orange and Augusta Co. Apparently he was an official of some sort since his name is given in connection with a number of deeds and wills.

There were three brothers, at that time, John, Silas and Morris. They were all in Kanawha Co. 1791-1795+ at the same time as Daniel Boone, and traded at his Trading Post as well as being on personal tax lists. John Reynolds was in Kanawha Co. in the Charleston area and was a prominent citizen being the Clerk and later Representative from Kanawha Co. on the State Legislature. He married Miriam Van Bibber in 1806. Morris/Maurice was at Point Pleasant and was on the first court in Mason Co. in 1804. The Van Bibbers were also there near Point Pleasant. Morris died in 1826. He had 11 children.

Randolph, my great great grandfather, had six children, the oldest of which was John Morris Reynolds. They lived at

Thirteen-Mile Creek. John Morris Reynolds was a Captain, Co. D., 7th W.Va. Cavalry during the Civil War leading the engagement on the Kanawha River at Winfield, WV. I have his military record from Nat. Archives. After the Civil War..[remainder of letter not in files].

From letter to Mrs. Jellinghaus 7 Jun 1983: My great grandfather, John Morris Reynolds, born 1833, Mason Co. (W) VA near Point Pleasant, my great great grandfather, Randolph Reynolds b ca 1810, Mason Co., and my great-great-great-grandfather, Morris (Maurice) Reynolds b ca 1785, county unknown. They were in Kanawha Co. (W) VA and my great grandfather removed to Ottawa KS in about 1885.

In (Henry) VA, 12 Jun 1779, **George Reynolds** was issued a mar. bond with **Susanna**, dau **Catherine Lansford** (or **Lunceford**) of (Pittsylvania) VA. **Spencer Reynolds** was also a resident of (Henry) that year (Will Book I, p 43, estate of **Thomas Garner**).

In 1782 **Bartlett, Jesse, George, Richard** and **Susannah Reynolds** were on the (Henry) tax list, while **Spencer, John** and **Richard** were polled in (Pittsylvania) VA. But by 1785, only **Hugh** and **Joseph** were on the (Pittsylvania) tax list, and **Spencer** was again found in (Henry), signing a petition (resulting in the formation of (Franklin) the following year). **David** was dead in (Henry) by 26 Jan 1788 (Book I, pps 161, 181) and another **David**, probably a son, was mentioned; **Moses Reynolds** was administrator. **Archelaus Reynolds** was dead by 4 Oct 1791, (ibid, p199) and at the sale of his estate, purchasers included **Bartemas, Jesse, Moses** and another **Archelaus Reynolds**, and **Abraham Penn**, from (Amherst).

This probably indicates the latter **Archelaus** was related to, or was the man of the same name who mar in (Amherst) 9 Sep 1797, **Elizabeth Rucker**, with **Obediah Reynolds** as surety. **Bartemus Reynolds** 00010-10100-2, **Millenton** 20100-10100-0, **John** 20010-20010-0, **John** 00100-20100-0, and **Archelaus Mc Reynolds** 20010-20010-0 all were enumerated in Pendleton Dist SC in 1800

and **Bartemus** was enumerated in (Hall) GA in 1820.

In (Pittsylvania) VA where **William Reynolds** d 1791, there were a number of marriages: **Joseph** wed **Margaret Devin** 21 Aug 1780; **Richard** wed **Nancy Grisham** 2 Mar 1785, etc. [that is how the paragraph ended.] **Spencer** and **Harmon Runnals** were in Capt **Hagan's** Dist in 1785 (Wilkes) GA tax list, an area part of which became (Taliaferro) GA; and in Capt **McCain's** district (Wilkes) where **Richard, Charles** and another **George Runnals**, their neighbors including a number of families later in (Jackson) GA. **Richard Reynolds** was granted (Wilkes) GA land in 1784 and he died before 20 Oct 1787, when **George Reed** sold the tract. **Richard's** will

was lost with Book DD; his heir **Hambleton Reynolds** sold 178, a small tract granted 1785 with **George Reynolds'** improvements to **Margaret, David Calhoun's** widow. (The name **Hamilton** is found variously in (Caswell) NC ca 1790, and in the records of (Isle of Wight) VA, **Reynolds** families allied with **Nevilles**.

Thomas Reynolds was apptd administrator of **Richard's** estate 14 Feb 1793, with **Spencer Reynolds** as his security, but **Thomas'** accounts ran from 20 Feb 1788, including payments directed by the will to **George, Joseph, Richard, Betsy, John, Benjamin** and **Spencer Reynolds** and **Jacob Reiger** or **Reiser** (perhaps same as **Reasor, Reeser, Rasor**, in VA's Valley and (Culpepper) VA); in 1802 **Dolly Reynolds** and **Thomas Matthews** (married **Rachel Runnals**) 11 Nov 1799 (Wilkes) GA; **Mary Reynolds, Matthew orphan of Richard Reynolds**. **Joseph Henderson** was admr in 1803. **Saran Ann Reynolds**, sole exectx of **Richard's** estate, was noted as dead by **Thomas** in 1793. **Thomas** was apptd gdn of **Matthew Reynolds**, and **Joseph Henderson Jr** gdn of **Richard Reynolds**, both orphans of **Richard Reynolds**, 23 Feb 1801. Several of **Richard's** sons, including **Spencer**, were in the list drawn up in 1803 for a lottery, and much other data may be found in the (Wilkes) GA records.

One **George Reynolds**, with wife **Mary**, was granted land on **Beaverdam** (Wilkes) GA 2 Aug 1785, which he subsequently sold to **John Smith**. The **George** who appears to the be son of **Richard** was dead by 5 Jul 1813, leaving a will dtd 16 Jun, in which he mentioned his wife **Rachel** (he married **Rachel Johnson** 4 Nov 1809), and children **Hamilton, Hugh, Betsey** (Autry?), **Janie Reynolds** and **Phoebe Dickens**. **Joseph Henderson** was exctr. (A **Reynolds Autry m** (Greene) 1820). on 6 Aug 1804, **Henderson** and **Richard Sappington** were sec when **George Runnals** was apptd gdn of **George Washington Runnals**, orphan of **Phebe Runnals**, evidently wife of an older **Reynolds**.

Some of the **Reynoldses** went to (Jackson) GA, some remained in (Wilkes) and are found in (Taliaferro, cut off 1825). **James Reynolds**, two men of 18 and 45, and seven under 18, was in **Alford's** Dist 608 in **Taliaferro** in the 1827 militia list. One of the younger men appears to have been **Harmon Reynolds**, who m **Sarah Wynn** 27 Dec 1826, and was in **Alford's** dist for the 1827 lottery. **Richard Reynolds** of that dist was a sol in War

of 1812 and he, widow **Susannah Reynolds** and **William A. Reynolds** were listed in the 1832 lottery, as were **James Reynolds Sr** and **James Reynolds Jr** in the gold lottery.

William A. Runnels m **Elizabeth Jarrell** in (Wilkes) GA 26 Dec 1808 and Major **Henderson** stood by during one unfortunate occurrence in the **Jarrell** family. (This name is confused with **Jarrett**; in **John Callaway's** 1819 (Wilkes) will he refers to his dau **Betsy Jarrell**, and his son **Isaac's** land adjacent to **George Jarrell** or **Jarrett** in (Madison) GA where **George** was enumerated in 1820 as **Jarrel...**)

In (Jackson) GA, **John Reynolds** was on the first jury in Jan 1797. **Harmon Reynolds** in 1799 paid taxes on 920 acres originally granted to **Joseph Carson**, in Capt **John Strong's** company, which appears to have included some land at least that was later in the part of (Jackson) cut off to (Clarke). Nearby was Capt **Preston Reynolds'** company and Capt **Joseph Reynolds'** company (Sandy Creek). In the 1805 lottery were the names of **Joseph Reynolds** and **Thomas Reynolds**, and the orphans **Aaron Reynolds** and **Moses Reynolds**.

Only the younger **John Runnels** was enumerated in (Jackson) in 1820; in (Clarke) were **William Runnalds** and **Grinsberry Reynolds**; in (Walton), **Thomas Reynolds**; in Gwinnett, **Galland** or **Gallant Reynolds** (No. 624) and **Jemima Reynolds** No. 625); and numerous others over the state.

In 1826, **William H Reynolds** was in (Clarke), **Thomas Reynolds** in (Hall); **George W Reynolds** in (Henry); **David Reynolds'** orphans in (Washington); and **William Sr and Jr Reynolds** in **Millers'** dist in (Jackson), among various others over the state. **William Runnels Sr** drew (Carroll) land granted 17 Nov 1830.

The origin of **Preston** and **Harmon Reynolds** has not been traced by the compiler; the names have a sound of old Botetourt, Montgomery and Tazewell counties in VA and the nearness of **Harmon** and **Spencer** in 1785 (Wilkes) GA would argue some connection with (Henry) VA. The numerous Rev War pension applications by members of the **Reynolds** family, have not been consulted, might shed some light. One **William Reynolds** left a will in (Jackson) GA
